



## Genesis Chapter 11 Nimrod in Our Time

Last week we spoke about a lot of different things that we had found within the pages of the 11<sup>th</sup> chapter of the book of Genesis. We spoke about who it was that built the Tower of Babel and we spoke about why they built it. We looked at several historical documents that gave us some insight on just how large the Tower of Babel was, and the monumental effort it took to build it. But this week I want to spend some time talking about the parallels between what Nimrod was doing in his day and age, and what we are now doing in our day and age.

Nimrod really wasn't doing anything any different than what we see men doing today in our time. Nimrod was portraying himself as a god. What Nimrod was telling God, was that he didn't need God's silly moral directives, and that he was smarter than God. We can produce life on our own and manufacture it to our specifications. What Nimrod was doing is nothing different than what our secular humanistic culture is leading us to do today. It's called "Rebellion" ... plan and simple. We don't need God in our schools anymore, we don't need to teach these things diligently to our children. Just let the public-school system run amuck and do as it pleases while we indulge in earning another dollar so we can buy a bigger "big screen TV" so that we can watch the Emmy's and become even more indoctrinated.

Soon we'll be creating "designer babies" with whatever eye color we want them to have. We'll be able to decide how tall they will be, and how intelligent they will be, and what color hair they will, or will not have all before they're even born. We'll be able to create an army of "Super Soldiers" to go to war to annihilate our enemies, and when we've used up this earth's resources and have sufficiently trashed it... we'll simply move to another planet and begin to ravage it as well... or at least... that seems to be the plan.

The rebellious spirit of Nimrod is most assuredly alive and well in our time, and like a cancer it's spreading throughout our culture and our society like a wildfire that cannot be stopped, and the truth is... that man won't be able to stop it. But there is one who is coming... one who is already on his way... that will stop it... dead in its tracks. The great physician is coming and he will destroy the cancer that plagues mankind with the sword of his mouth, and the light of truth that comes from the armies of Heaven that follow with him. Although we see the rebellious nature of Nimrod in our school systems, and in our halls of justice, and all throughout the political landscape... the head of this rebellious spirit of Nimrod will be crushed, and literally destroyed forever. Revelation 20:1-10:

*Rev 20:1 Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, holding in his hand the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain.*

*Rev 20:2 And he seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years,*

*Rev 20:3 and threw him into the pit, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he might not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were ended. After that he must be released for a little while.*

*Rev 20:4 Then I saw thrones, and seated on them were those to whom the authority to judge was committed. Also I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for the testimony of Jesus and for the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.*

*Rev 20:5 The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended. This is the first resurrection.*

*Rev 20:6 Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection! Over such the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him for a thousand years.*

*Rev 20:7 And when the thousand years are ended, Satan will be released from his prison*

*Rev 20:8 and will come out to deceive the nations that are at the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them for battle; their number is like the sand of the sea.*

*Rev 20:9 And they marched up over the broad plain of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city, but fire came down from heaven and consumed them,*

*Rev 20:10 and the devil who had deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur where the beast and the false prophet were, and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.*

And so, as we look back into the hour glass of history, we can see where the beginning of this rebellion first took place, and we can clearly see who it was that started the rebellion against God. I would submit to you that the serpent in the Garden of Eden had manifested himself in the body of Nimrod to finish what he had initially started. It has always been the objective of the serpent to sit in the throne of God and to rule over his creation. Although he dresses himself up to be an angel of light, he is indeed full of darkness and deceit. He is a thief who comes to steal what does not belong to him, and to take what is not his. He is starved for power and authority. He prowls around like a lion in the tall grass just waiting for the right moment to pounce. He loves to sift the righteous, and to tempt the elect. He is a smooth talker, and a convincing opponent, and there is no end to the amount of tricks that he has to choose from. And this is exactly why we need to put on the full armor of God and follow after our Messiah.

Our Messiah was tempted by him in the desert, and if we will remember correctly... our Messiah never rebuked this powerful opponent on his own or with his own words. He rebuked him with scripture, and the word of his Father. To many would be professing Christians today believe in men who say that they cast out demons by their own word, and who proclaim to cast demons out of people by their own power, but nothing could be farther from the truth. Even

Michael the Archangel did not speak out of line to the Devil when fighting over the body of Moses. Let's read a little bit more about these same people that were alive and well in Nimrod's time, and who are to this day alive and well in our time. We can find them in Jude 1:8-9:

*Jud 1:8 Yet in like manner these people also, relying on their dreams, defile the flesh, reject authority, and blaspheme the glorious ones.*

*Jud 1:9 But when the archangel Michael, contending with the devil, was disputing about the body of Moses, he did not presume to pronounce a blasphemous judgment, but said, "The Lord rebuke you."*

Once again we see Michael the Archangel disputing over the body of Moses with the Devil himself, and even Michael the Archangel did not rebuke the Devil with his own words, or his own righteousness... he simply did the same thing that our Messiah did. He rebuked him through the Father and by the Father's authority over him, not his own.

And so, when we see these false prophets ever so proudly proclaiming to have the power to cast out demons... we should know better. The only one who can cast out demons is the Father and his only begotten Son who has been given all authority in Heaven and on Earth by his Father. We as human beings have no power within ourselves without God. Let's continue Jude 1:10-19:

*Jud 1:10 But these people blaspheme all that they do not understand, and they are destroyed by all that they, like unreasoning animals, understand instinctively.*

*Jud 1:11 Woe to them! For they walked in the way of Cain and abandoned themselves for the sake of gain to Balaam's error and perished in Korah's rebellion.*

*Jud 1:12 These are hidden reefs at your love feasts, as they feast with you without fear, shepherds feeding themselves; waterless clouds, swept along by winds; fruitless trees in late autumn, twice dead, uprooted;*

*Jud 1:13 wild waves of the sea, casting up the foam of their own shame; wandering stars, for whom the gloom of utter darkness has been reserved forever.*

*Jud 1:14 It was also about these that Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied, saying, "Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of his holy ones,*

*Jud 1:15 to execute judgment on all and to convict all the ungodly of all their deeds of ungodliness that they have committed in such an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things that ungodly sinners have spoken against him."*

*Jud 1:16 These are grumblers, malcontents, following their own sinful desires; they are loud-mouthed boasters, showing favoritism to gain advantage.*

*Jud 1:17 But you must remember, beloved, the predictions of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ.*

*Jud 1:18 They said to you, "In the last time there will be scoffers, following their own ungodly passions."*

*Jud 1:19 It is these who cause divisions, worldly people, devoid of the Spirit.*

And so, the spirit of Nimrod has not died. In fact... it could be said that it only grows stronger

throughout each generation. Today, men are not just building a tower that will reach into the heavens. Man is now building rockets that far exceed the clouds of the heavens, and man to this very day has been known to have a heart of rebellion. Many men here on earth today have already destroyed the existence of the one true God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, in their own minds. They've kicked him out of our Schools and pushed him away from our children. They've ignored his Feast Days and appointments, and profaned his Sabbaths by creating their own sabbaths, and their own feast days and appointments. They've hidden the true anniversary of his Sons death on Passover Day from his people, and they've kicked dirt over the truth of his word, and twisted it and turned it into their own religions, traditions, and manmade myths. They have made void the word of God in order to hold onto their own traditions.

And so, my point in all of this is that Nimrod still lives today. Nimrod is thriving and not only thriving... but expanding in our world and in our time. And if we're not careful, the Spirit of Nimrod may even find its way into us... and worse yet... our children. He lies dormant in our children's video games and in their music videos. He hides himself in today's epic Hollywood movies, and entertainment awards. He masquerades as a painted lady, and a musclebound shirtless soap opera star. To this day he mocks the truth of light, and continues to dress himself up as an angle of light to deceive even the very elect, using words like "legalism", and "conspiracy theorist", and "Islamaphobe", and "homophobe", to scare Gods people into submission.

I could go on and on and on... but I think you get the picture. Nimrod is not dead. Nimrod is a master of disguises. He is often times covert, and works in cogneito. You'll never see his horns or his tail... but what you will see is a beautiful angel of light speaking great things against the one true God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. You'll see him preform many miracles and signs, and wonders, and even watch as he brings fire down from the sky, but he will indeed be nothing more than a fraud... a fake... an impersonator, and this is the one that we must watch for. This Nimrod Spirit will return to the earth in the form of a beast that will be worshiped on the earth by those whose names are not written in the book of life, and he will have a helper that will pave the way for his coming, and cause him to be exulted upon the earth much like John the Baptist paved the way for our Messiah. Revelation 13:1-18:

*Rev 13:1 And I saw a beast rising out of the sea, with ten horns and seven heads, with ten diadems on its horns and blasphemous names on its heads.*

*Rev 13:2 And the beast that I saw was like a leopard; its feet were like a bear's, and its mouth was like a lion's mouth. And to it the dragon gave his power and his throne and great authority.*

*Rev 13:3 One of its heads seemed to have a mortal wound, but its mortal wound was healed, and the whole earth marveled as they followed the beast.*

*Rev 13:4 And they worshiped the dragon, for he had given his authority to the beast, and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast, and who can fight against it?"*

*Rev 13:5 And the beast was given a mouth uttering haughty and blasphemous words, and it was allowed to exercise authority for forty-two months.*

*Rev 13:6 It opened its mouth to utter blasphemies against God, blaspheming his name and his*

*dwelling, that is, those who dwell in heaven.*

*Rev 13:7 Also it was allowed to make war on the saints and to conquer them. And authority was given it over every tribe and people and language and nation,*

*Rev 13:8 and all who dwell on earth will worship it, everyone whose name has not been written before the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb who was slain.*

*Rev 13:9 If anyone has an ear, let him hear:*

*Rev 13:10 If anyone is to be taken captive, to captivity he goes; if anyone is to be slain with the sword, with the sword must he be slain. Here is a call for the endurance and faith of the saints.*

*Rev 13:11 Then I saw another beast rising out of the earth. It had two horns like a lamb and it spoke like a dragon.*

*Rev 13:12 It exercises all the authority of the first beast in its presence, and makes the earth and its inhabitants worship the first beast, whose mortal wound was healed.*

*Rev 13:13 It performs great signs, even making fire come down from heaven to earth in front of people,*

*Rev 13:14 and by the signs that it is allowed to work in the presence of the beast it deceives those who dwell on earth, telling them to make an image for the beast that was wounded by the sword and yet lived.*

*Rev 13:15 And it was allowed to give breath to the image of the beast, so that the image of the beast might even speak and might cause those who would not worship the image of the beast to be slain.*

*Rev 13:16 Also it causes all, both small and great, both rich and poor, both free and slave, to be marked on the right hand or the forehead,*

*Rev 13:17 so that no one can buy or sell unless he has the mark, that is, the name of the beast or the number of its name.*

*Rev 13:18 This calls for wisdom: let the one who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man, and his number is 666.*

What is this “Beast”? Who is its helper? The dragon itself has given this beast its authority, much like our Father in Heaven has given his authority to his only begotten Son. This Beast that has been brought forth by the dragon, will ultimately do battle with our Father in Heaven and his Son that he has brought forth. And just like God took away Nimrod's power in the beginning, so too will God take away the power of the Beast of the future. The day is soon coming when the power of the Spirit of Nimrod will be cast into the fiery pit never to be heard of again, but before this takes place... the body of our Messiah will once again be persecuted. Some of us will lose loved ones. Some of us will be called to give our lives for the sake of our Messiah. Some of us will be forced to watch and to witness it all play out before our eyes. Some of us will be taken captive, and some of us will even shrink back and submit to the Beast and the Spirit of Nimrod himself.

Here is what the angel of our Messiah tells John about the beast that is to come: Rev 17:8:

*Rev 17:8 The beast that you saw was, and is not, and is about to rise from the bottomless pit and go to destruction. And the dwellers on earth whose names have not been written in the book*

*of life from the foundation of the world will marvel to see the beast, because it was and is not and is to come.*

So, this “Beast” is someone who was... but is not now... and is about to rise from the bottomless pit. Could it be as so many of us suspect... that this very same Nimrod who was, and is not now... will be the one to rise from the bottomless pit to once again make war with God? For now, we see through a glass darkly. Speculation and scripture are all we have to navigate us to the truth of what may or may not happen in the future. But I would submit to you my friends that the important thing to remember... is that we have been called to watch. When we see these things coming upon us... we will know. We will know them when we see them because we do not walk in darkness. We are children of the light. Even our Messiah tells us that his return will not be a surprise to us! 1<sup>st</sup> Thessalonians 5:1-6:

*1Th 5:1 Now concerning the times and the seasons, brothers, you have no need to have anything written to you.*

*1Th 5:2 For you yourselves are fully aware that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night.*

*1Th 5:3 While people are saying, "There is peace and security," then sudden destruction will come upon them as labor pains come upon a pregnant woman, and they will not escape.*

*1Th 5:4 **But you are not in darkness, brothers, for that day to surprise you like a thief.***

*1Th 5:5 For you are all children of light, children of the day. We are not of the night or of the darkness.*

*1Th 5:6 So then let us not sleep, as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober.*

There is another very dangerous concept that needs to be brought to light that we find in Genesis chapter 11 verse 6 that I would like to share with you. Let’s revisit Gen 11:6:

*Gen 11:6 And the LORD said, "Behold, they **are one people**, and they have all one language, and this is only the beginning of what they will do. And nothing that they propose to do will now be impossible for them.*

If we go to the “King James Numbered Version” and look up the Hebrew word for “are one people” we find that it is the Hebrew word “echad”, which means that they were all together... as in one... singing “Kumbaya” if you will. They were “echad”... they were “unified”. In other words, they had all made themselves friends of the world, and their worldly king.... “Nimrod”.

I want us to think for just a moment. Is it good for a Christian to be “echad” or “unified” with the world? James 4:4:

*Jas 4:4 You adulterous people! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.*

What is the Pope of Rome trying to do today? Is he not trying to bring “echad” “unity” among

the religions of the world?

### CLIP 1 (F9)

What the spirit of Nimrod here is not telling you is that there were no other churches other than the Roman Catholic Church for the first thousand years, because the Roman Catholic Church would murder you if you were anything other than Catholic! Whole families and societies of people like the Waldenses and the Albigenses were murdered for even owning or reading a Bible, and the Roman Catholic churches “inquisitions” were nothing more than blood baths for true Christians, or anyone else who challenged the authority of the Roman Catholic Church. This is a totally dishonest, and misleading statement, because he knows that if he tells you the truth... he’ll be showing the losing hand that he’s trying to pass off as a “royal flush”. What he is proclaiming here is nothing more than the same black deception that the Vatican has been selling since its inception. If he told the truth... no one would listen to another word he ever said!

### CLIP 2

Division is diabolical? Did you hear that? What is he preaching here? He’s preaching the same unity that Nimrod had cast over his followers! If “division” is indeed diabolical, then God himself is diabolical. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 6:14-18:

*2Co 6:14 Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? Or what fellowship has light with darkness?*

*2Co 6:15 What accord has Christ with Belial? Or what portion does a believer share with an unbeliever?*

*2Co 6:16 What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; as God said, "I will make my dwelling among them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.*

*2Co 6:17 Therefore go out from their midst, and be separate from them, says the Lord, and touch no unclean thing; then I will welcome you,*

*2Co 6:18 and I will be a father to you, and you shall be sons and daughters to me, says the Lord Almighty."*

What is God doing here in 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians through his servant Paul? He is “dividing, electing, and separating”, that’s what God does. And so according to what we’ve just here from the spirit of Nimrod... God is now diabolical! Let me ask you my friends... what did our Messiah come to bring... unity or division? Luke 12:51:

*Luk 12:51 Do you think that I have come to give peace on earth? No, I tell you, but rather division.*

*Luk 12:52 For from now on in one house there will be five divided, three against two and two against three.*

*Luk 12:53 They will be divided, father against son and son against father, mother against daughter and daughter against mother, mother-in-law against her daughter-in-law and daughter-in-law against mother-in-law."*

So now according to the spirit of Nimrod here... our Messiah is diabolical as well. Worldly unity is never preached or taught anywhere in our scripture. Godly unity is found only within the body... not in the world. The last thing that our Father in Heaven wants, is for us to join forces and unify ourselves and our children with a tyrannical false religion who follows after a false pagan god who calls himself the "Vicar (or replacement) of our Messiah!" The tyrannical whore of Babylon who has the blood of the martyrs of our Messiah on her hands, and the gall to change the times and the laws of the one true God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob knows no bounds! Unify with this whore of Babylon... and we unify ourselves with the Spirit of Nimrod himself. Be ready my friends... because as we divide ourselves from those who teach and preach another Jesus... we need to be ready for the world to call us... diabolical. We will be seen as divisionists, and they will call us anything and everything but "holy". And I tell you the truth my friends... that day has already come for Christians of the past, and it is soon to come for us in the very near future as well. It has already begun. Let's continue:

## **CLIP 3 (F9)**

The scriptures tell us that we will know them by their fruits... not by what they say. We do not know them by what they say they believe.... We know them by their actions and by what they produce, and the gospel message that they speak. Yes... division does indeed destroy the credibility of the Roman Catholic Church because our Messiah clearly tells us not to be yoked with them. They are a pagan religion that stands on the foundations of their man made, man created, man fabricated pagan religion. They preach and teach "another Jesus" other than the Jesus that Paul and the apostles taught. I tell you the truth my friends there will be droves of professing Christians who will not make it into the kingdom of Heaven. They will profess with their mouths that he is the Messiah, and they will profess with their mouths that they are believers, but they will not get into his coming kingdom. We know what this spirit of Nimrod that you see here believes because of that white collar that he wears.

You see the spirit of Nimrod is using this man as a dog on a leash who serves his master the Pope, not the one true God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. He speaks, what his father tells him, and his father is a liar, and is indeed the father of all lies. It is written in Luke 16:13 that you cannot serve two masters, you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. George Bergoglio has blasphemed and profaned the word of the one true God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and we have seen his fruit and its rotten stench reaches into the heavens to the throne of God, and the lies he speaks and the lies that he stands for will not go unaccounted for. You can profess with your tongue all day long that you are a Christian but if you are not doing the will of the true Father... then we need to be clear... you're not getting into the coming kingdom of his only begotten Son, according to... his only begotten Son. Matthew 7:21-27:

*Mat 7:21 "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.*

*Mat 7:22 On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?'*

*Mat 7:23 And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.'*

*Mat 7:24 "Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock.*

*Mat 7:25 And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on the rock.*

*Mat 7:26 And everyone who hears these words of mine and does not do them will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand.*

*Mat 7:27 And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell, and great was the fall of it."*

According to this “spirit of Nimrod” that we’ve been listening to... **“The world will not believe until we are one with the Roman Catholic Church”** Do you hear what this man is saying? The only way to get the world to believe... is if you submit yourselves to the Roman Catholic church and become one with her “Anti-Christ” Pope. I ask you plainly ... where is this found within our scripture... exactly? And what does our Messiah have to say about who it is that he left in charge to teach us his word, according to his own red letter words? Who is it that our Messiah says teaches us? John 14:20-28:

*Joh 14:20 In that day you will know that **I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you.***

*Joh 14:21 Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, **he it is who loves me.** And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him.”*

*Joh 14:22 Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, “Lord, how is it that you will manifest yourself to us, and not to the world?”*

*Joh 14:23 Jesus answered him, “**If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.***

*Joh 14:24 **Whoever does not love me does not keep my words.** And the word that you **hear is not mine but the Father's who sent me.***

*Joh 14:25 “These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you.*

*Joh 14:26 But the Helper, **the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.***

*Joh 14:27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.*

*Joh 14:28 You heard me say to you, ‘I am going away, and I will come to you.’ If you loved me, you would have rejoiced, because I am going to the Father, **for the Father is greater than I.***

Again... the red letter words of our Messiah, and the double edged sword that protrudes from his mouth has just slain the “unity doctrine” of this spirit of Nimrod. Let’s continue:

**CLIP 4: (F9)**

Yes, indeed it is “fear” that keeps us separated! It is the fear of God that keeps us separated from the false doctrines of Nimrod, and it is written that the fear of God is the beginning of wisdom! Proverbs 9:10-12:

*Pro 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is insight.*

*Pro 9:11 For by me your days will be multiplied, and years will be added to your life.*

*Pro 9:12 If you are wise, you are wise for yourself; if you scoff, you alone will bear it.*

**CLIP 5: (F9)**

No, our protest is not over, not by a long shot! First and foremost, the argument between Faith vs Works is NOT, AND I REPEAT...NOT... the only objection to Roman Catholicism! We not only object to what you say that you believe... we object to the fact that you are standing right here in front of us bald face lying!!!! This cheap imitation of Nimrod says that he believes in the one true God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and his only begotten Son, and yet they propagate the pagan “Lent” and the pagan “Easter” and the pagan “Good Friday” and the pagan “Christmas” and the pagan “1<sup>st</sup> day of the week Sunday Sabbath” and the pagan “Halloween (also known as “All Saints Day” when they pray to the old dead dried up bones of their saints)”. They have thought to change the times and the laws of the one true God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and they have profaned not only his Sabbaths, but the very anniversary of the death of our Messiah who died on “Passover Day” according to Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John! Faith vs Works is not and was not, and will never be... the only objection held against you! Once again... “LIAR!”. And it was not just Martin Luther that believed in salvation through grace... it was tens of thousands of faithful Christians... Wycliff, believed it, Huss believed it, Tyndale believed it, and all the historical reformers believed it, not just the Roman Catholic Martin Luther, and by the way... many of these men were tied to a post and strangled to death while being set on fire by your Roman Catholic Popes... and so one again as I have said before so now I say again... “LIAR”.

And what is this nonsense about not worrying about doctrine, and that our Father will sort out all of our doctrinal differences when we get upstairs? You bet he’s going to sort out all of our doctrinal differences when we get upstairs... and if your doctrines have not aligned with his doctrines... let’s just say... “I wouldn’t want to be standing in your shoes”. Don’t worry about our Fathers doctrines folks... let’s just love each other” they will wrongly tell you... but the truth is... that without understanding his doctrines... we have no idea what true love even is. Deuteronomy 30: 16-20:

*Deu 30:16 If you obey the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you today, by loving the LORD your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, then you shall live and multiply, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it.*

*Deu 30:17 But if your heart turns away, and you will not hear, but are drawn away to worship other gods and serve them,*

*Deu 30:18 I declare to you today, that you shall surely perish. You shall not live long in the land that you are going over the Jordan to enter and possess.*

*Deu 30:19 I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live,*

*Deu 30:20 loving the LORD your God, obeying his voice and holding fast to him, for he is your life and length of days, that you may dwell in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them."*

Once again as I have said before so now I say again.. "LIAR"... there is a "Protestant Church"... and a Protestant movement that is alive and well today... it is called "The Body of Christ". We who have picked up our crosses and have made the conscious decision to follow after our Messiah do indeed protest against you and the black oil that drips thick from your lips. The Spirit of Nimrod and his rebellious rant against the one true God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and his call for unity lives on in places like the Roman Catholic Vatican, and all throughout the four corners of the earth. Yahovah is our shepherd; that we shall not want. He makes us lie down in green pastures. He leads us beside still waters. He restores our souls. He leads us in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Even though we walk through the valley of the shadow of death, we will fear no evil, for he is indeed with us; his rod and his staff, they comfort us. He prepares a table before us in the presence of our enemies; he anoints our heads with oil; our cup surly does overflow. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow us all the days of our lives, and we shall dwell in the house of Yahovah forever.
