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Revelation 21b The Beginning of The End.

Before we ever even get into our study this morning, I'd like to go back over some of the things that we've already touched on concerning Revelation chapter 21 during our last study. And because it's been a couple of weeks since we've taken a look at Revelation chapter 21, we'll also be re-reading it once again here this morning in just a couple of minutes.

But before we do that, I'd like to just touch on some of the things that we've already covered during our study into Revelation chapter 21 over the past few weeks.

The book of Revelation is a book that I've really grown to love and appreciate. Not because of its heads, horns, and beasts, or because I believe that we can rub it like a crystal ball in order to know the future as some do, but because it's a book that grounds us in the here and now. It grounds us in the gospel message given to us by our Father in Heaven clear back in the beginning of the book. And at the same time, it grounds us in that very same message that our Messiah came to give us in the middle of the book.

The book of Revelation completely destroys the "*once saved always saved, do as thou wilt is now the whole of the law*" doctrine of demons that so many of our modern-day denominational charters wrongfully and shamefully teach and preach.

The book of Revelation completely destroys the "*replacement theology*" doctrine of demons that says that man's newfound "*church*" is now the apple of God's eye, and that the house of Israel has been done away with. It completely and utterly destroys the "*dispensational grace*" doctrine of demons that claims that Yah cared about his law in the beginning... does not care about his law today.. and yet will care about his law again at the end of the age... while they completely black out the Scripture that tells us that our Father is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow.

The book of Revelation completely destroys the Catholic created pagan philosophy of a trinitarian triune god who is no longer one God... but now three gods in one... which turns modern-day Christianity into a polytheistic religion that believes that three co-equal gods created the heavens and the earth instead of one creator of the heavens and the earth who is completely capable of manifesting himself through his creation

You simply cannot read the book of Revelation and come away believing in a "once saved

always saved, do as thou wilt is now the whole of the law” doctrine of demons.

You simply cannot read the book of Revelation and come away believing that a modern-day Christian can return like a dog to its vomit, or like a pig to its mire after accepting the truth about who their Messiah is.

You simply cannot read the book of Revelation and come away believing that a modern-day Christian can continue to dabble in the teachings of Catholicism that are found nowhere within the confines of the 66 books of our Bibles.

There is no such thing as a first day of the week Sunday Sabbath that has been commanded by anyone, anywhere within the 66 books of our Bibles. There is no such thing as a Good Friday. Our Messiah is called our Passover Lamb for a reason, because he died on Passover day according to all four Gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John not on some Catholic created Good Friday. Our Messiah was not raised up on some pagan Easter morning, our Messiah is known as the first fruit of the new harvest because he was raised up on first fruits to wave the sheave offering before his Father signaling the new incoming harvest.

We see in the book of Revelation the importance of conquering over sin, setting the wicked person outside of the assembly, we see the importance of standing up for the truth that our Messiah came to give us and the importance of standing against every wind of doctrine and human cunning and craftiness and deceitful scheme, we see the Son always being subservient to the Father and never do we see the Father becoming subservient to the Son. We see over, and over, and over again the “*if equals then*” pattern that we see all throughout the Scripture from the beginning of the book in the book of Genesis all the way through right here to the book of Revelation. I

Deuteronomy chapter 11 says “*If you will indeed obey my commandments that I command you today, to love Yahovah your God, and to serve him with all of your heart and with all of your soul, then... he will give rain for your land in its season.*”

Our Father in Heaven tells us in Deuteronomy chapter 30, that his commandment is not too hard for us to keep, neither is it far off. He tells us that the word is very near us, it is even in our mouths and in our hearts so that we can do it.

In John chapter 14 verse 15, our Messiah tells us in his own red-letter words that if we love him... then we are to keep his commandments. The “*if equals then*” pattern is seen all throughout the Bible. And yet today’s modern-day denominational charters completely ignore the “*if equals then*” pattern as though it doesn’t even exist.

In Deuteronomy chapter 30 verse 19 our Father in Heaven tells us and I quote, “*I call Heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curses. Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live, loving Yahovah your God,*

obeying his voice, and holding fast to him, for he is your life and length of days, that you may dwell in the land that Yahovah swore to your fathers, to Abraham to Isaac and to Jacob to give them”.

And our Messiah says the exact same thing in Matthew chapter 7 versus 21 through 23 when he tells us that not everyone who calls on him is going to enter the kingdom of Heaven. Not everyone who calls on our Messiah is going to enter the kingdom of Heaven. Not says I, but says the very red-letter words of our very own Messiah found in Matthew chapter 7 verse 21 through 23.


He goes on to tell us that the only one who is going to enter the kingdom of Heaven is the one who does the will of his Father who is in Heaven. And he tells us that many people are going to come and brag about prophesying in his name, the they’re going to brag about casting out demons in his name, and they’re going to brag about how many mighty works that they have done in his name, and our Messiah tells us very clearly that he will look them dead in the eye and tell them that he never knew them, and that they never knew him, upon which time he will command them to get away from him because they are workers of lawlessness.

The book of Revelation is chalked full of the evidence of Scripture that has been laid out before us from the very beginning of the book of Genesis, to the end of the book here in the book of Revelation. (scrn 1)



During our last study, we warned against the wisdom of men, and the dangers of putting our hope in what men call their so-called “*early church fathers*” and their prestigious “*Bible commentators*”. Their “*doctors*” who are nothing short of modern-day philosophers. Our

“*councils of men*”, priests, bishops, pastors, and popes have all failed miserably in being careful to keep the commandments of our Father in Heaven. And just as King Solomon once said, there is nothing new under the sun. What will be, has already been done. **Jeremiah chapter 8 versus eight through 12 (scrn 2)**



And so, just as King Solomon once said, there is nothing new under the sun, what will be has already been done, and these I would submit to you are indeed the signs of the times that we are now living in.

The good news is that here in Revelation chapter 21 we find the ultimate... new beginning. Our Messiah tells us very clearly in Matthew chapter 5 versus 17 through 20, that not an iota, nor a dot, would pass from his Father's law until Heaven and earth pass away, and all things are accomplished. And as we read through Revelation chapter 21 and 22, we can see right here clear at the back of the book in the last two chapters of our Bibles, heaven and earth finally does pass away, and all things are finally accomplished... but not before.

Nowhere else in the 66 books of your Bible will you find Heaven and earth passing away, or all things being accomplished. It only happens at the end of the book right here in Revelation chapter 21 and 22. And yet... what do today's modern-day denominational churches tell us? Do they not teach that the law is done away with? Do they not teach that "do as thou wilt is now the whole of the law" as long as you proclaim with your lips to believe? I would submit to you that that's a whole lot of iota's and dots that they have removed from our Fathers word.

You see for them, "*do as thou wilt is now the whole of the law*". For them, it's okay to return like a dog to your vomit, and like a pig to its mire. For them, it's okay to add too, and take away

from our Fathers word. For them, their own vanity has replaced the house of Israel by what they call “*the church*”. And it is this demonically inspired “*church*” that is now the Apple of Yah’s eye. And therefore, the promise that Yah made to Abraham Isaac and Jacob becomes null and void. According to them God is a liar and he will never bring the house of Israel back into the promise land. To them, the church is all that matters. The Old Testament has been done away with because they claim that our Messiah nailed it to the cross (even though that’s not written anywhere within the confines of the 66 books of their Bibles). And so, all of the Old Testament laws have been done away with... except for that one old Levitical law of tithing 10% of your income to them, because that’s just one law that they can’t live without. Why? Because they honor him with their lips, but their hearts are far from him. They have no idea how to conceptualize the love of God. They have made void the word of God in order to hold onto their own traditions. First John chapter 5 verse three means nothing to them, because they do not have the eyes to see nor the ears to hear.

But I would submit to you my friends that you cannot read the book of Revelation and come away with any of that horseradish! The book of Revelation is clear and it sets the record straight. The seven letters to the seven assemblies describes in great detail the things that they are doing right, as well as the things that they are doing wrong. And each one of these letters that has been written to the seven assemblies in the book of Revelation is a warning to today’s modern-day denominational charters of men.

And I would be remiss if I did not once again point out where it was that modern-day Christianity has gone wrong. Where did modern-day Christianity go wrong? Why are there over 50,000 different Christian denominational charters around the world today all claiming to be preaching and teaching the same thing out of the same book?

Let there be no mistake about it my friends, they come from the beast himself. The beast of Catholicism is their mother church. She created the first day of the week Sunday Sabbath. She created Good Friday. She created Easter. She created Christ mass. Today’s protestant churches protest against nothing. They have become dumb, deaf, and blind to the very Scriptures that they hold in their very hands. Today’s protestant churches are nothing more than the daughters of Catholicism who follow after her first day the week Sunday Sabbath, and her Good Friday, and her pagan Easter celebration, as well as her demonically inspired “*Halloween*” which is a day that they practiced divination and praying to the dead dried up bones of those who sleep in the dust of the earth and know nothing according to Scripture. “*All Saints day*” is nothing more than a pagan throwback from the days of Babylon itself!

First John chapter 2 tells us that whoever says that they know him, but does not keep his commandments is a liar and that the truth is not in him. John goes on to tell us that whoever **does** keep his word, in him truly the love of God is perfected and it’s by this that we may know that we are in him. John continues on to tell us that whoever says that he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked. And John continues on to tell us that he is not writing us a new commandment but an old commandment that we had already heard from the

very beginning. That old commandment that we have heard from the very beginning has just been made new by our Messiah who came to once again renew those things for those of us who believe. And that my friends is from the New Testament not the old. The book of Revelation once again confirms everything that we see from the beginning of what we know as our Bibles today to the end.

And this is exactly why I love the book of Revelation. Many modern-day Christians don't bother to read the book of Revelation because they can't understand it. It confuses them. And I would submit to you that they are right. They can't understand it. Why? Because they haven't read the beginning of the book! They've been preprogrammed by their denominational charters that the beginning of the book doesn't even exist!

Even today in our study into the 21st chapter of the book of Revelation we will see what is being written here in the book of Revelation has already been written and spoken of through the prophets long ago. But if you've never read the prophets, then you're not going to know that, and this is exactly why today's modern day professing Christian can't understand the book of Revelation (or more than three quarters of the New Testament, because three quarters of the New Testament is nothing more than quotes from the Old Testament). But once again, if you have been duped, and lied to, and preprogrammed not to read the book from the beginning, you're not going to know that.

And so, today we are going to once again take everyone by the hand, and walk them through not just the book of Revelation, and what the book of Revelation speaks of concerning the end times, but also what the book of Revelation speaks of concerning what the prophets have already declared to us thousands of years ago.

With that being said, let's go back and refresh our memories concerning exactly what Revelation chapter 21 says, and just as importantly, exactly what Revelation chapter 21 does not say. **Revelation chapter 21: E1**

Rev 21:1 Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more.

Rev 21:2 And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

Rev 21:3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God.

Rev 21:4 He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away."

Rev 21:5 And he who was seated on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." Also he said, "Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true."

Rev 21:6 And he said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. To the thirsty I will give from the spring of the water of life without payment.

Rev 21:7 The one who conquers will have this heritage, and I will be his God and he will be my son.

Rev 21:8 But as for the cowardly, the faithless, the detestable, as for murderers, the sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars, their portion will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulfur, which is the second death."

Rev 21:9 Then came one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls full of the seven last plagues and spoke to me, saying, "Come, I will show you the Bride, the wife of the Lamb."

Rev 21:10 And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great, high mountain, and showed me the holy city Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God,

Rev 21:11 having the glory of God, its radiance like a most rare jewel, like a jasper, clear as crystal.

Rev 21:12 It had a great, high wall, with twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and on the gates the names of the twelve tribes of the sons of Israel were inscribed—

Rev 21:13 on the east three gates, on the north three gates, on the south three gates, and on the west three gates.

Rev 21:14 And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the twelve names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

Rev 21:15 And the one who spoke with me had a measuring rod of gold to measure the city and its gates and walls.

Rev 21:16 The city lies foursquare, its length the same as its width. And he measured the city with his rod, 12,000 stadia. Its length and width and height are equal.

Rev 21:17 He also measured its wall, 144 cubits by human measurement, which is also an angel's measurement.

Rev 21:18 The wall was built of jasper, while the city was pure gold, like clear glass.

Rev 21:19 The foundations of the wall of the city were adorned with every kind of jewel. The first was jasper, the second sapphire, the third agate, the fourth emerald,

Rev 21:20 the fifth onyx, the sixth carnelian, the seventh chrysolite, the eighth beryl, the ninth topaz, the tenth chrysoprase, the eleventh jacinth, the twelfth amethyst.

Rev 21:21 And the twelve gates were twelve pearls, each of the gates made of a single pearl, and the street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass.

Rev 21:22 And I saw no temple in the city, for its temple is the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb.

Rev 21:23 And the city has no need of sun or moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and its lamp is the Lamb.

Rev 21:24 By its light will the nations walk, and the kings of the earth will bring their


glory into it,

Rev 21:25 and its gates will never be shut by day—and there will be no night there.

Rev 21:26 They will bring into it the glory and the honor of the nations.

Rev 21:27 But nothing unclean will ever enter it, nor anyone who does what is detestable or false, but **only those who are written in the Lamb's book of life.**

(scrn 3)



Once again, it's important that we compare Genesis chapter 1 verse one with Revelation chapter 21 verse one. Both at the beginning of the book, as well as at the end of the book, we find a new beginning. We find a new Heaven and a new earth. And I want us to understand that what is going to be taking place in this new Heaven and this new earth has already been proclaimed through the prophets long ago.

Let's take just a moment to read about how this new Heaven and this new earth is going to come about in even more detail. We can find that in **Isaiah chapter 65 E2**

Isa 65:1 I was ready to be sought by those who did not ask for me; I was ready to be found by those who did not seek me. I said, "Here I am, here I am," to a nation that was not called by my name.

Isa 65:2 I spread out my hands all the day to a rebellious people, who walk in a way that is not good, following their own devices;

Isa 65:3 a people who provoke me to my face continually, sacrificing in gardens and making offerings on bricks;

Isa 65:4 who sit in tombs, and spend the night in secret places; who eat pig's flesh, and broth of tainted meat is in their vessels;

Isa 65:5 who say, "Keep to yourself, do not come near me, for I am too holy for you." These are a smoke in my nostrils, a fire that burns all the day.

Isa 65:6 Behold, it is written before me: "I will not keep silent, but I will repay; I will indeed repay into their lap

Isa 65:7 both your iniquities and your fathers' iniquities together, says the LORD; because they made offerings on the mountains and insulted me on the hills, I will measure into their lap payment for their former deeds."

Isa 65:8 Thus says the LORD: "As the new wine is found in the cluster, and they say, 'Do not destroy it, for there is a blessing in it,' so I will do for my servants' sake, and not destroy them all.

Isa 65:9 I will bring forth offspring from Jacob, and from Judah possessors of my mountains; my chosen shall possess it, and my servants shall dwell there.

Isa 65:10 Sharon shall become a pasture for flocks, and the Valley of Achor a place for herds to lie down, for my people who have sought me.

Isa 65:11 But you who forsake the LORD, who forget my holy mountain, who set a table for Fortune and fill cups of mixed wine for Destiny,

Isa 65:12 I will destine you to the sword, and all of you shall bow down to the slaughter, because, when I called, you did not answer; when I spoke, you did not listen, but you did what was evil in my eyes and chose what I did not delight in."

Isa 65:13 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: "Behold, my servants shall eat, but you shall be hungry; behold, my servants shall drink, but you shall be thirsty; behold, my servants shall rejoice, but you shall be put to shame;

Isa 65:14 behold, my servants shall sing for gladness of heart, but you shall cry out for pain of heart and shall wail for breaking of spirit.

Isa 65:15 You shall leave your name to my chosen for a curse, and the Lord GOD will put you to death, but his servants he will call by another name,

Isa 65:16 so that he who blesses himself in the land shall bless himself by the God of truth, and he who takes an oath in the land shall swear by the God of truth; because the former troubles are forgotten and are hidden from my eyes.

Isa 65:17 "For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth, and the former things shall not be remembered or come into mind.

Isa 65:18 But be glad and rejoice forever in that which I create; for behold, I create Jerusalem to be a joy, and her people to be a gladness.

Isa 65:19 I will rejoice in Jerusalem and be glad in my people; no more shall be heard in it the sound of weeping and the cry of distress.

Isa 65:20 No more shall there be in it an infant who lives but a few days, or an old man who does not fill out his days, for the young man shall die a hundred years old, and the sinner a hundred years old shall be accursed.

Isa 65:21 They shall build houses and inhabit them; they shall plant vineyards and eat their fruit.

Isa 65:22 They shall not build and another inhabit; they shall not plant and another eat; for like the days of a tree shall the days of my people be, and my chosen shall long enjoy the work of their hands.

Isa 65:23 They shall not labor in vain or bear children for calamity, for they shall be the offspring of the blessed of the LORD, and their descendants with them.

Isa 65:24 Before they call I will answer; while they are yet speaking I will hear.

Isa 65:25 The wolf and the lamb shall graze together; the lion shall eat straw like the ox, and dust shall be the serpent's food. They shall not hurt or destroy in all my holy mountain," says the LORD.

And so here, we see what is written in the book of Revelation coming to fruition according to the prophet Isaiah thousands of years before the apostle John, or the book of Revelation was ever even penned. Why? Because our Father in Heaven does not change. He is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow. Our Father in Heaven does not change hats, and he does not change throughout different dispensations of time. He did not care about his laws in the beginning, not care about them today, and then care about them again in the end when he returns. He has always cared about his laws, and just as our Messiah has already told us, not one crossing of a "t" or dotting of an "i" will pass from his Father's law until Heaven and earth pass away clear at the back of the book in the book of Revelation which is exactly what Isaiah is prophesying about here in the 65th chapter of the book of Isaiah.

And with that being said, I'd like to also turn to second Peter so that we can see exactly what the apostle Peter had to say about this time. We can find that in **second Peter chapter 3 versus one through 14: E3**

2Pe 3:1 This is now the second letter that I am writing to you, beloved. In both of them I am stirring up your sincere mind by way of reminder,

2Pe 3:2 that you should remember the predictions of the holy prophets and the commandment of the Lord and Savior through your apostles,

2Pe 3:3 knowing this first of all, that scoffers will come in the last days with scoffing, following their own sinful desires.

2Pe 3:4 They will say, "Where is the promise of his coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all things are continuing as they were from the beginning of creation."

2Pe 3:5 For they deliberately overlook this fact, that the heavens existed long ago, and the earth was formed out of water and through water by the word of God,

2Pe 3:6 and that by means of these the world that then existed was deluged with water and perished.

2Pe 3:7 But by the same word the heavens and earth that now exist are stored up for fire, being kept until the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly.

2Pe 3:8 But do not overlook this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

2Pe 3:9 The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.

2Pe 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed.

2Pe 3:11 Since all these things are thus to be dissolved, what sort of people ought you to be in lives of holiness and godliness,

2Pe 3:12 waiting for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be set on fire and dissolved, and the heavenly bodies will melt as they burn!

2Pe 3:13 But according to his promise we are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

2Pe 3:14 Therefore, beloved, since you are waiting for these, be diligent to be found by him without spot or blemish, and at peace.

Knowing this, and understanding what Peter is telling us... do you think that we should be concerned about global warming? Think about that for just a moment.

Is man going to be able to fix global warming according to the Scripture? Does the Scripture not tell us that the world will be destroyed by fire? What did we just read in second Peter chapter 3 verse seven? Peter just got done telling us that just as the world was deluged with water and perished in the beginning, by the same word, the heavens and earth that now exist are stored up for fire, being kept until the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly.

Do we really think that man is going to be able to stop global warming? Do you really think that the government taking money out of the wallets of ranchers and farmers because their cows are farting... is going to stop the will of Yah? That my friends is laughable on its face. Not to mention borderline blasphemous, knowing that our Father in Heaven has already told us that the world is being stored up for fire until the day of judgment. What global warming tells me... is just how close we are to the day of judgment. But as always, man continues to write off the warnings of his Father in Heaven because man thinks that he knows best, and man thinks in his own vanity that he is greater than his Father in Heaven. And I would submit to you my friends that this is exactly how we have gotten to where we are today.

And just so that we can know a little bit more about exactly what will take place here in Revelation chapter 21, I'd like us to also turn to **Isaiah chapter 52: E4**

Isa 52:1 Awake, awake, put on your strength, O Zion; put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city; for there shall no more come into you the

uncircumcised and the unclean.

Isa 52:2 Shake yourself from the dust and arise; be seated, O Jerusalem; loose the bonds from your neck, O captive daughter of Zion.

Isa 52:3 For thus says the LORD: “You were sold for nothing, and you shall be redeemed without money.”

Isa 52:4 For thus says the Lord GOD: “My people went down at the first into Egypt to sojourn there, and the Assyrian oppressed them for nothing.

Isa 52:5 Now therefore what have I here,” declares the LORD, “seeing that my people are taken away for nothing? Their rulers wail,” declares the LORD, “and continually all the day my name is despised.

Isa 52:6 Therefore my people shall know my name. Therefore in that day they shall know that it is I who speak; here I am.”

Isa 52:7 How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who publishes peace, who brings good news of happiness, who publishes salvation, who says to Zion, “Your God reigns.”

Isa 52:8 The voice of your watchmen—they lift up their voice; together they sing for joy; for eye to eye they see the return of the LORD to Zion.

Isa 52:9 Break forth together into singing, you waste places of Jerusalem, for the LORD has comforted his people; he has redeemed Jerusalem.

Isa 52:10 The LORD has bared his holy arm before the eyes of all the nations, and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God.

Isa 52:11 Depart, depart, go out from there; touch no unclean thing; go out from the midst of her; purify yourselves, you who bear the vessels of the LORD.

Isa 52:12 For you shall not go out in haste, and you shall not go in flight, for the LORD will go before you, and the God of Israel will be your rear guard.

Isa 52:13 Behold, my servant shall act wisely; he shall be high and lifted up, and shall be exalted.

Isa 52:14 As many were astonished at you— his appearance was so marred, beyond human semblance, and his form beyond that of the children of mankind—

Isa 52:15 so shall he sprinkle many nations. Kings shall shut their mouths because of him, for that which has not been told them they see, and that which they have not heard they understand.

Before we go any farther, I like us to re-examine Isaiah chapter 52 verse eight where we are told that the voice of your watchmen lift up their voice, together they sing for joy, for eye to eye they see the return of Yahovah to Zion. Once again, this is just another pattern of the feast of Sukkot also known as the feast of Tabernacles that we just came back from. This is the last appointment of the year that our Father in Heaven commands us to keep when we come before him to rejoice in his return and remember how he once rescued us out from under the hand of the Pharaoh of Egypt. What we just experienced during the feast of Sukkot symbolizes what is

taking place here in Revelation chapter 21 with a new Heaven and a new earth being created for the house of Israel so that the promise of Yah can be fulfilled and so that his people can, and will be gathered together in Zion (also known as Jerusalem) to tabernacle with him forever.

And I also want us to pay particularly close attention to **Isaiah chapter 52 versus 13 through 15. E4**

Isa 52:13 Behold, my servant shall act wisely; he shall be high and lifted up, and shall be exalted.

Isa 52:14 As many were astonished at you— his appearance was so marred, beyond human semblance, and his form beyond that of the children of mankind—

Isa 52:15 so shall he sprinkle many nations. Kings shall shut their mouths because of him, for that which has not been told them they see, and that which they have not heard they understand.

I want us to notice that Yah's servant here in Isaiah chapter 52 versus 13 through 15, is his only begotten Son (our Messiah). It is our Messiah who is a servant of the Most High Elohim, who will act wisely. It is our Messiah who shall be high and lifted up. It is our Messiah who will be exalted. Many were astonished at him when he came the first time. His appearance was so marred beyond human semblance, and his form beyond that of the children of mankind so that his blood would be sprinkled upon many nations. And I want us to remember on the day of atonement why it was that the High Priest had to sprinkle the house of Israel with blood. It was to sanctify the house of Israel and to make them clean in the eyes of Yah on the day of atonement. And this is exactly what the blood of our Passover Lamb, (our Messiah) does for us today.

He shall indeed shut the mouths of Kings because the day is coming that they will see and they will hear the truth about him that they have denied for so long.

I want us to also notice in Isaiah chapter 52 verse one, that it says and I quote, "*there shall no more, come into you the uncircumcised and the unclean*". And so, once again, it should be more than evident to us that Yah's laws will still stand at the end of the age because just as our Messiah has already told us, in the book of Luke chapter 21 verse 33 and I quote, "*Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away*". And once again, the word of our Messiah was not his own word according to our Messiah. The word that our Messiah spoke was his Father's word. **(scrn 4)**

Joh 7:16 So Jesus answered them, "My teaching is not mine, but his who sent me.

Joh 14:24 Whoever does not love me does not keep my words. And the word that you hear is not mine but the Father's who sent me.



Once again my friends, I love the book of Revelation because it sets the record straight as does the book of Hebrews, and the book of James. All throughout the book of Revelation, we see the reestablishment of our Father's laws and his precepts, and his appointments, but we also see the reestablishment of the 12 tribes of Israel with the holy city, the new Jerusalem coming down out of Heaven from God prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

We see the 12 Gates and we see the 12 Angels and we see the 12 tribes of the sons of Israel inscribed on those Gates, we see the 12 names of the 12 apostles of the Lamb, we see the 12 different kinds of jewels that were fixed on the ephod... the breastplate of the High Priest. And yet... today's denominational charters of men deny what we read right here with our own eyes. They deny the law of Yah, they deny the Passover Lamb, they deny the first fruit of the new harvest, they deny the seventh day Sabbath of Yahovah which he says is a sign between him and us throughout all of our generations forever. They deny it all, and yet they say... that they love and serve him.

And so, I ask you my friends, what God do they worship? Who is their Messiah really? This Messiah that throws away the law of his Father, this Messiah that throws away the appointments of his Father, this Messiah that throws away the precepts of his Father, and comes to celebrate his own birthday, and comes to create his own Sabbath? Where is that found in the 66 books of our Bibles? Who is this Jesus that they bow down to? Who is this replacement of the God of Israel?

I would submit to you my friends that this newfound, Jesus that much of the world bows down to today comes directly from the spirit of Maricon of Sinope. And if you do not know who Marciano of Sinope is... that is your homework for this week... Google "Marciano of

Sinope!”

And with that being said my friends we have one more chapter to finish up the book of Revelation and I will give my closing remarks at that time, but as for now I would like to ask everyone within the sound of my voice to please take what you have heard here today to your own prayer closet. Bow your head, and bend your knee, and face the holy promise land of Jerusalem, and ask in the name of Yeshua Hamashiach if what you have heard here today be true, or not.

Ask, seek, and knock, and the door will be opened to you. And if you will do that, and if you will stay the course to the end, you and I will surely walk through the Gates of his soon coming kingdom together.
