



## **The Trinity 3 In 1 or 1 in 3 Part 2**

In part one of “The Trinity 3in 1 or 1 in 3” we learned through the scripture that according to both our Father Yahovah the one true God of Abraham, Issac, and Jacob... and his son Yahshua (Jesus)... that there is no such thing as a triune God who is 3 persons in one person.

In part one of this study we did a good job in opening the eyes of many people, and many people are writing in wanting to know more. On our Facebook page Sister Renee wrote this under our first video teaching on the Trinity:

*Hello Pastor Velain, I thank you for all of your teachings, but am struggling with this one. I am open to receiving God's truth and am not really going against this particular teaching. I just don't know if you spoke on this in fullness. We understand Jesus to be the Messiah from YHWY. In this teaching you said that he was created, but when? By conception? We need to compare things to ALL scripture to see if we have a correct understanding. So where does John 1:1-18 fit in?*

And Sister Renee is exactly right. The understanding of the Trinity can not be understood by most in one teaching because there are so many scriptures to contend with when confronted with this Topic, and so I thought that it would be a good idea to continue on in this teaching, to help those who are trapped in the underpinnings of the Roman Catholic created Trinitarian doctrine that so many of us have been programmed with clear back from the time that we were children.

Let me first say this. If you were to line up 10 Christians in a line... and you were to privately ask each one of them what the “Trinity” is. You would most likely end up with 10 different versions of what the “Trinity” is. It's hard to find two Christians walking down the street together who have the same understanding of what the “Trinity” is.

So let me say this. If your definition of the “Trinity” is that there is a Father, and that there is a Son... and that there is a Holy Spirit... then yes... there is a Trinity!... But... if your definition of the “Trinity” is that there are three Gods... all co-equal, all equal in power, and equal in authority, and all in one being... then you are sadly mistaken according to the scripture that clearly tells us that God is one... not three. No where in the scriptures in eiather the Old or the New Testaments are we told that there is a triune god. The scripture teaches directly opposite of

such a thing and it teaches it over and over and over again. Read Isah 45: verses 5 and 6, read Deuteronomy 6: verse 4, read Isaiah 44: verse 6, read John chapter 17 verse 3, or John 5:verse 30, or John 14:28 and I could go on and on and on my friends. There is no three in one god ever taught in our Bibles... bar none... anywhere.

What is taught... is the “Word” of God. The “Word” of God is an “Attribute” of God. The “Word” of God is part of Gods “Character”. The “Word” of God is what God stands for, and what he abides by... it is also known as “Light” and “Truth”. And this is exactly what most of today's modern day denominational charters of men and their so called “Early Church Fathers” and their seminary Professors do not understand.

Before we go any further with this teaching on the deception of the Trinitarian doctrine it's monumental that we all understand the definition of two words that most Christians do not understand. The first word is Attribute:

If you simply go to Google... which seems to be the most widely used search engine on the Internet... and you type in the word “Attribute” here's the definition given:

Google:

*a quality or feature regarded as a characteristic or inherent part of someone or something.*

It would be quite normal to say that a mans “Characteristic” is who a man is. As Google puts it it is a quality.. or feature of someone or something. This my friends is what Gods “Word” is. Gods “Word” is part of his “Character”... it is an “Attribute” of God. It has always been part of who God is and what he stands for, and we must grasp this understanding in order to understand who God, his only begotten Son, and his Ruach Hokadesh... his “Holy Spirit” is.

The word of God did not become flesh until the man Yahshua Jesus was begotten. Once again he was not per-existant... he was Gods only “begotten” son which comes from the Greek word “*mon-og-en-ace*”.

Yahshua Jesus... the Son of God was given the “Word”... and the word of God did not become flesh until Yahshua was begotten. Yahshua Jesus was given Gods “Character” and he was given Gods “Attributes”, and Gods “word” was instilled, and woven into the very fabric of Yahshua.

Now how do I know that Yahshau Jesus was given the “Word” of God which is the “Character” and the “Attributes” of God? I know that because that's what his scriptures tell me! Consider

*Luk 2:52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and man.*

When we're told in 1<sup>st</sup> John 14 that the “Word became flesh and dwelt among us” what John is trying to convey to us is that God created the man Yahshua Jesus... and put his “Word” in him..

and the “Word” then became flesh. We must remember the promise that God made to David in 2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel chapter 7 verses 12 through 17. God promised that it would be a man who came from Davids lineage, and would be the offspring of David.. that God would create a kingdom for, and who God would call a Son. So when we ask the question...was Yahshua Jesus created by God? The answer to that question is yes if we believe in scripture and scripture alone and if we refuse the teachings of men.

The “Word” of God was always with God because his “Word” was part of his Characteristic... The “Word” was always an “Attribute” of God. The word of God is “Truth”.. it is “Light” it is a protective hedge against evil.. it is the very fabric of God and what he stands for. Just as we're told in Luke 2:52 Yahshua Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature, and in favor with both God and man. He was created by God and so let us not make any mistake about this most important biblical fact.

As human beings it should be clear that our Father in Heaven is not a God of confusion.. and when we read scriptures like Isah 45:5 and 6 where our Father tells us very clearly and with out stutter.. that he is one God... and that there is no other besides him... or when we read in John 14:28 where our own Messiah tells us that his Father is greater than he is... we should know that something is wrong when we're told that God is 3 beings in one, or that there are **3 co-equal Gods all co-equal in authority, and power, and glory**. And just for the new viewer that may be tuning in... lets turn to these two scriptures and lets just read them once again for ourselves just so that we can all be on the same page... lets read Isah 45:5 and 6:

*Isa 45:5 I am the LORD, and there is no other; besides me there is no God; I equip you, though you do not know me,*

*Isa 45:6 that people may know, from the rising of the sun and from the west, that there is none besides me; I am the LORD, and there is no other.*

Clearly... the Catholic Created story of a triune god holds no validity in this scripture according to the Father... and so now once again lets turn to the Son to see what the Son has to say about the matter in John 14:28:

*Joh 14:28 You heard me say to you, 'I am going away, and I will come to you.' If you loved me, you would have rejoiced, because I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I.*

Yahshua Jesus tells us in Mark chapter 12 verse 29 that the most important commandment is that we understand that God is one. Lets read Mark 12:28 and 29 for ourselves:

*Mar 12:28 And one of the scribes came up and heard them disputing with one another, and seeing that he answered them well, asked him, "Which commandment is the most important of all?"*

*Mar 12:29 Jesus answered, "The most important is, 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one.*

And we've listed even more scriptures than these in part one of this study so if your just joining us for the first time we invite you to go back and view the first part of this teaching because we won't re-hash all of those scriptures over again here today in part 2 of this study but be forewarned that these scriptures are here and do speak for themselves, and that there are many more of them.

Now I know that my Trinitarian brothers out there will jump to proclaim that they only believe in one God... but this is not the truth my friends. They do not believe in one God. They will tell you that they believe in 3 gods in one being which really only makes one god because he's 3 in one... but our Father in Heaven Yahovah, and his Son BOTH REJECT THIS TEACHING all throughout the scriptures.

Yahshua Jesus never says and I quote "I am God". The closest he ever came to ever saying such a thing is when he told his disciples that if they had seen him... they had seen God. But Yahshua was not telling them that they had actually seen the living God... he was only telling them that he was the Son of God... and all that God his Father stands for he stands for.

If I love my Father and I am keeping his word and doing his commandments and keeping his precepts and appointments and walking in his ways... then it would be perfectly normal for me to say... if you have seen me... you have seen my Father. My friends!... take into consideration what John tells us in John 1:18:

*Joh 1:18 No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.*

Now... this is a miss-translation in the English Standard Version... once again... translated by Trinitarians they have missed the mark. Lets read from the King James Version, and lets see if we can't get the proper translation... John 1:18:

*Joh 1:18 No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.*

And this comes from the disciple John after Yahshua was already dead, buried, and resurrected. Please note my friends and I quote "NO MAN HAS SEEN GOD AT ANY TIME".

Now my Trinitarian brothers can believe the Pagan underpinnings of the Roman Catholic Church or they can take hold of what the scriptures truly say. You simply can not skirt around these scriptures my friends. They are here, in our faces, and we need to contend with them... not just walk away from them and sweep them under the carpet because they don't fit our pre-

programed agenda.

So here in these two scriptures... along with many others... we have confirmation from both the Father and the Son.. that they are completely separate beings... separate in body... but yet unified in character, truth and attribute. And I would submit to you my friends... that this is where all to many of us seem to be fooled into believing in what is clearly a pagan Trinity doctrine. And if you don't understand the pagan underpinnings of the Trinitarian doctrine I would invite you to go back and view part one of this study that is posted in the archives of our website at HolyIMpactMinistries.com on our "7<sup>th</sup> Day Sabbath" page... or ... simply study the history of the triune gods of paganism for yourself.

So lets start with the scripture that Sister Renee quoted... which was John 1:1 through 18 and lets see what it truly says:

*Joh 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.*

*Joh 1:2 He was in the beginning with God.*

*Joh 1:3 All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made.*

*Joh 1:4 In him was life, and the life was the light of men.*

*Joh 1:5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.*

*Joh 1:6 There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.*

*Joh 1:7 He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through him.*

*Joh 1:8 He was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light.*

*Joh 1:9 The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world.*

*Joh 1:10 He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him.*

*Joh 1:11 He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him.*

*Joh 1:12 But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God,*

*Joh 1:13 who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.*

*Joh 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.*

*Joh 1:15 (John bore witness about him, and cried out, "This was he of whom I said, 'He who comes after me ranks before me, because he was before me.'")*

*Joh 1:16 For from his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace.*

*Joh 1:17 For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.*

*Joh 1:18 No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.*

Okay... so lets slow down and lets hear what John wants us to hear in this message. Lets take it

from the top. John verses 1 and 2:

*Joh 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.*

*Joh 1:2 He was in the beginning with God.*

First of all the word “Word” in verse one should not be capitalized. Once again.. most of the translators who have translated our Bibles for us were Trinitarians who believed in a “triune” God. They believed that God was not one as he and the Son both tell us... but they believed that God was 3 Gods in one because that's what man had taught them... so... when they translated our English Bibles... these Trinitarians capitalized the word “Word” thinking that the “word” of God was Jesus. However... we know from reading our scripture... that Yahshua Jesus had not even been begotten as of yet. My friends... the word of God was simply as it is stated here in this scripture... it was his “word” it was what he spoke, what he believed, it was “truth” and “light” and a stronghold against evil. The “word” of God had not yet become flesh... that did not happen until Yahshua Jesus was “begotten” of God... created... by God... from the lineage of his servant David just as we are told in 2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel chapter 7 verses 12 through 17.

Moving into verse 2 it's once again extremely important to know that the word “He” in verse two is not a proper translation. My friends once again we must understand that the translators who have translated most of our English Bibles were Trinitarians who believed in a three in one God. And once again they have translated most of our English Bibles under the assumption that God is triune in nature or a three in one God... and so... because they already believed that he was a three in one God... they used the word “He” to translate this scripture. However... once again my friends... I would submit to you that the word “He” does not belong in this scripture.

### **Show KJV and word search on “same”**

What we must understand my friends is that the translators of the English Bible were almost all... Trinitarians who had been taught the same Trinitarian doctrine that we've all been taught, and so it should be clear... that the word “He” in verse 2... is not a correct translation. It could mean “He” or it could mean “She” or it could mean “This” or “These”. But you see if you're a Trinitarian and you believe in a triune God... which word are you going to use?... You're going to use the word “He” in this scripture because you have a per-conceived belief that God is three in one.. even though... that's not what we find in other places through out the scripture. And so it is that those translators with a belief in a triune God are going to use the word “He”... because that's what makes sense to them.

You see what we're being told by John in verse one is that God can not be separated from his Word. What God says... is what God is... it's what he stands for... it's what he believes... it is who he is... it is pure unadulterated... truth... it is “Light” it is his “Characteristic” and his commandments are his “Attributes”... and this is what John is trying to convey. The Word of God that God Spoke is “Truth”, and the “Truth” has been with God from the very beginning...

and those who have his “Word” have his “Truth” and those who have the truth of his Word also have his “Light” so that they are no longer in the darkness as the world is. So what John is telling us in verse 2 is not that Jesus the man was with God... what John is telling us is that Gods “Word” his belief, his Character, and his Attributes were with him from the very beginning “The same was in the beginning with God”... not “He” was with God.. but rather Gods “word” was with God. God does not change my friends he is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow He can not lie, he can not cheat, he can not steal.. he is the perfect one... he is where the truth and the light begin and end... he is... the only one true God of Abraham, Issac, and Jacob.

Lets continue with verses 3 through 5:

*Joh 1:3 All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made.*

*Joh 1:4 In him was life, and the life was the light of men.*

*Joh 1:5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.*

Who were all things man through? God the Father that's who. He is God... and according to our scripture... there is no other. In God was life and the life was the light of men. Gods light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

Lets continue with verses 6 through 9 where John finally begins to talk about Yahshua Jesus:

*Joh 1:6 There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.*

*Joh 1:7 He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through him.*

*Joh 1:8 He was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light.*

*Joh 1:9 The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world.*

The man sent from God was John the Baptist who came as a witness and to bear witness about the “light” that God was about to send into the world with his only “begotten” son... who came from the lineage of his servant David.... that all might believe through his Son Yahshua who God was sending into the world with his “Word”... his “Light”... his “Truth”. This my friends... is when the “word” of God... is made flesh.

John the baptist was not the light.. but came to bear witness about the “Light”... that Yahshua was about to bring to the world. The true “Light” (or “Truth”) which gives “Light” (and truth) to everyone was coming into the world, because that “Light” and that “Truth” were given to Yahshua Jesus his son by God the Father... to bring into the world.

Lets continue with verses 10 through 13

*Joh 1:10 He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him.*

*Joh 1:11 He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him.*

*Joh 1:12 But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God,*

*Joh 1:13 who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.*

He... Yahshua Jesus was in the world... and the world was made through him. Now when John says that the world was made through Yahshua... John is once again referencing Gods “word” that had been made flesh. Now think my friends which came first Gods “word” or the man Yahshua Jesus? Gods word came first... then the man Yahshua. Gods word was put into Yahshua Jesus the man and it was Gods word that the world was made through... not the man himself Lets be clear.. once again we already know that Yahshua Jesus was begotten he was created by God his Father, and once again through the scriptures we already know that Yahshua Jesus came from the lineage of Gods servant David. So it was the word that was in Yahshua Jesus that created the all things... not the physical man Yahshua himself.

So Lets test that word “Through” in verse 10. The original Greek word that they translated as “Through” is the Greek word “Dia” which has several meanings.

Once again my friends... if you are a “Trinitarian” as most of the translators were... you would obviously use the word “Through” to prove your Trinitarian doctrine because that's what you believe to be true... but if you are not a Trinitarian.. because you have read what the Father and what the Son both say about being two different individuals... you would translate verse 10 like this:

*Joh 1:10 He was in the world, and the world was made on account of him, and for this reason, yet the world did not know him.*

I am not a Trinitarian. because I have prayed for the discernment of God and his Son through is Ruach Hakodesh... his holy spirit... and so because I know that my Messiah said that God his Father is greater than he is... and because I know that my Father in Heaven tells me that he is one God and there is no other God besides him... I know... that the more correct understanding of John 1:10 is that Yahshua Jesus was in the world and the world was made on account of him and for this reason... and I know that even though the world was made on his account... the world did not know him.

You see once again we must understand that God knows all. God knew that he was going to give this world... this kingdom... to his Son... and this is why the World was created... so that God could create a world... a family... a kingdom from himself and for himself. A world... a kingdom... a family for himself. All fathers give to their sons all that they have... and God is no exception. God created this world with his Son in mind.

But you see the Catholic created Trinitarian doctrine says no! Gods not that smart. God could not have made the world on account of his Son who was not even born yet. God can't plan that far ahead. God can't make the world first and then the Son? You see the Trinitarian doctrine is not built upon faith. Nor is it built upon the Rock... or the knowledge of knowing that with God all things are possible... and not only possible... but probable as well. To them.. it was there brand of the man Jesus who made the world and that's what they'll teach you and your children. But as for those of us who truly know him from his scriptures.. we know... that it was God who created all things through is word of truth, and light, and righteousness. All things were made from the stuff.. that Gods word represents.

Imagine trying to manufacture and airplane with out the truth. If all your mathematical measurements were not true and just. Could you then manufacture and aircraft with out true and just measurements? No you could not. You would wind up with a heap of aluminum that would never be able to take off from the ground. You see God created all of creation with his word which was truth, righteousness, and light. All things that God made are perfect from the beginning. It's not until man has his hand in things... that the things that God has created become tainted and tarnished... and not because God did not created man perfectly... but because man has chosen to bow his knee to Gods adversary who consistently lies to and deceives man into thinking that he is his own God.. and there is no other.

The "Light" (Truth) was coming into the world. Yahshua was in the world and yet it did not know that he was the Son of God. He came to his own people (because he was born of David) and they did not receive him. But he gave those who did believe in him the right to become the children of God (Just like him). But.. they had to have the "Light" (Truth.. see Gal 3:27-29). And the Word of God (that God had spoken) became flesh and dwelt among us. Notice verse 14: we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

The Law came through Moses (which is also truth that comes from God) grace and truth came through the Messiah (who preached the law of his father... see Math 5:17-20).

And last but not least in verse 18 we find that no one has EVER SEEN GOD. His Son Yahshua... (and I quote) "made him known". In other words... Gods mercy, his grace, his will, his spoken "Word"... his "Truth"... were shown by his Son. These are the things that God is.

You see the truth is in the scripture. But the Roman Catholic Church and her "Vicar Of Christ" (along with most of her so called "Protestant" daughter churches) want you and your children to believe that God is like all the other Pagan Gods (triune deities). He is not. He is indeed just as he said "One God":

Isa 45:5 I am the LORD, and there is no other, besides me there is no God; I equip you, though you do not know me,  
Isa 45:6 that people may know, from the rising of the sun and from the west, that there is none besides me; I am the LORD, and there is no other.

As for me and my house... we will serve the one true God... of Abraham, Issac, and Jacob, who sent his Son to be our Passover Lamb, and is the FIRST FRUIT of the new harvest!

And as we close this second teaching on the deception of the Roman Catholic created "Trinity" and it's three in one God... I want you to know that we could continue on with this teaching for the next two years easily. There are so many questions, and so many deceptions, and so much to understand when trying to understand the truth of who the one true God of Abraham, Issac, and Jacob really is that we could probably never quit teaching on this particular topic.. and from time to time we may return to this topic to answer more questions.. but as for now I will leave you with this teaching and I hope to have peaked your interest enough to launch your own investigation into this most troubling topic.

But before you venture out on this study make sure that you go to your prayer closet, and bow your head and bend your knee and face the Holy promised land of Jerusalem and ask in the name of Yahshua Hamashiach Jesus the Messiah for the discernment to understand... the truth.

The world my friends is full of deception and it's a mine field for those of us who are seeking truth. And our adversary has gone through great lengths to distort the truth, and to bend and twist the truth through the wisdom of men and their philosophical teachings and pagan Gnostical understandings... We must stand on the rock. And we must know what our scripture says, and we must study to show ourselves approved rightly dividing the truth of his word that we have if we will only read and study it. Don't be afraid to dig deep... because the deeper you dig... the brighter the light becomes.

No matter what you believe about the "Trinitarian Doctrine"... remember to always do Gods word. If we study his word... and if we find truth there and then do not do it... then more will not be given to us. And we should all know that according to Ecclesiastics chapter 12 verse 13... this my friends... is the whole duty of man.
