



## **The Passover Truth Is The Death Of Easter** **Part 2 The Time-line**

Once again I would like to thank everyone who has decided to take the time to join us here for this particular study. This is part 2 of “The Passover Truth Is The Death Of Easter” and as we've already seen in part 1 of this study.. Yahshua Hamashiach, Jesus the Messiah himself said.. that he was going to be crucified on Passover day in Matthew chapter 26 verse 2 with his own voice, his own breath, and in his own red letter words, and yet the world continues to believe the Catholic created myth of “Good Friday” and “Easter”.. that directly calls our Messiah a liar, and claims that our Messiah didn't know what he was talking about.

We've already seen in part one of this study that all four gospels... Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John all agree that our Messiah died on Passover day which was also known as “The Day Of Preparation” because Passover day was the day that everyone was to rid their homes of all Yeast, and the Passover lamb was to slaughtered at the Temple, and these preparations were to be made on Passover day in preparation for the very next day which was the Feast of Unleavened Bread.

We've also looked at several historical documents including the Catholic Encyclopedia itself.. that all clearly show us that “Easter” is about a pagan fertility goddess that has been known through out time by many different names. Her name was Artemis in Ephesus, but it was Ashteroth in the Hebrew language, Astarte in the Phoenician language, Ishtar in Akkadian language, Eostre in the Anglo-Saxon language, and Easter in the English language.


And so it was with most of the ancient little “g” gods through out history.. they just kept getting a new face lift after every few generations. The Roman Catholic Church along with her daughter Protestant churches have simply simply taken our Messiah and thrown him in the basket with a bunch of other worthless pagan sun gods that our adversary has used through out history to turn Gods people away from God.

The Roman Catholic Church did not only replace Gods Holy sanctified 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath that he said would be a sign between him and his people.. a perpetual agreement through out all of our generations forever.. with their own man made, man created, man fabricated 1<sup>st</sup> day of the week Sunday Sabbath.. but they also have literally stolen and hidden the very anniversary of the death, burial, and resurrection of our Messiah from his people.

Once again we were warned in Daniel chapter 7 verse 25 that the wicked one would indeed try to wear out the saints, and to change the times and the law... and that we would even be handed over to him for three and a half years before he would be thrown down by God. And we know that the kingdom and the dominion and the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven shall be given to the people of the saints of the Most High at that time.

But even though all of this is found in our scriptures... what do men choose to believe? All of this truth is found abounding from the very pages of our Bibles... and in our history books... and yet what do we choose to believe? Just like the Israelite's clear back in Jeremiah chapter 8 verse 8... when the lying pen of the scribes had made the truth of Gods Word into a lie.. so too have today's modern day scribes made God's Word into a lie...and we... have once again just like the Israelite's... fallen for it... and we are once again destroyed for lack of knowledge... because we have rejected knowledge, and we have chosen to follow after the teachings, and the wisdom of men instead of reading the scripture for ourselves and turning to the Ruach Hakodesh of God for the discernment that we so desperately need... in a world so infested with deception.

We also talked about the importance of not only knowing what is in our Bibles... but also how important it is to know what is not in our Bibles:

1. Jesus died on “Good Friday”.
2. Jesus died on a “Friday”.
3. Jesus rose on “Easter Sunday”.
4. The Passover is a Jewish holiday.
5. N.T. Believers in the Bible did not keep Passover or the Feast Days.
6. Passover has been “fulfilled” so we don't have to be bothered with it.

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And so we talked about all of these things that are not found in the scripture anywhere, and we tore these things down with the truth of what the scriptures does say so that we could eradicate the myths of men and what the scriptures do not say.

This week I want to make clear what the scriptures do say about the time-line of the death, burial, and resurrection of our Messiah, and once again... weed out and eradicate the myths of men and what the scriptures do not say. So lets take a look at the time-line of the death, burial, and resurrection of our Messiah according to the scriptures.

As we mentioned in part one of this study.. our Messiah told us that he would indeed be in the heart of the earth for three days and for three nights. So lets go back and look at those important red letter words found in Matthew chapter 12 verse 40:

*Mat 12:40 For just as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.*

So if our Messiah was sober... and if he wasn't mistaken, and if he knew what he was talking about... then we should be able to trust.. that our Messiah was going to be in the earth for how long according to the very words that he himself spoke? For three days, and for three nights... not according to some denominational charter of men, not according to some seminary professor, not according to some early Church father, not according to some Pastor, Priest, Bishop, or Pope... but according to our Messiah, with his own breath, and with his own tongue, and with his own red letter words... we can know for sure.. that he said... that he was indeed going to be in the heart of the earth.. for three days and for three nights.

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### **Inclusive verse Exclusive Reckoning:**

Now.. with that being said.. we need to understand the difference between “Inclusive Reckoning” and “Exclusive Reckoning”. So let me give you an example of “Inclusive Reckoning”:

*Exo 19:9 And the LORD said to Moses, "Behold, I am coming to you in a thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with you, and may also believe you forever." When Moses told the words of the people to the LORD,*

*Exo 19:10 the LORD said to Moses, "Go to the people and consecrate them **today and tomorrow**, and let them wash their garments*

*Exo 19:11 and be ready for the **third day**. For on the third day the LORD will come down on Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people.*

So here God uses “Inclusive Reckoning”... so what does that mean. It means that God counts the first day as the day that he tells Moses what he's going to do, he very clearly says “**today and tomorrow**, let them wash their garments and be ready for the **third day**.”. This is called “Inclusive Reckoning” because he counts the day that they are in as the first day.

We today... do not use “Inclusive Reckoning”.. we use “Exclusive Reckoning”. For example..

lets say today is Saturday... and I were to say to you.. “I will meet you in two days at my house at 12 o'clock noon”. What day would you be at my house? You would most likely be at my house on Monday at noon, because you would not count the day that I said to meet me in two days... you would normally count the next day as the first day, so Sunday would be day one... and Monday would be day two.

But if you used “Inclusive Reckoning” and I said meet me at my house in two days... you would count today as the first day... so you would be at my house tomorrow... because tomorrow would be the 2<sup>nd</sup> day... understand? That's the difference between “Inclusive” and “Exclusive Reckoning”.

When you “Exclude” the day that you are in.. that is “Exclusive Reckoning” because we “Excluded” the day that we made the plan from being the first day. But if we were using “Inclusive Reckoning” and it was Saturday, and I said “I'll meet you at my house in two days at 12 o'clock noon” then you would need to meet me tomorrow at noon... because “Inclusive Reckoning” counts today as day one, and tomorrow as day two.

Now I know that I've just confused a few people out there but stay with me for just a moment. When we look at the time-line of the death, burial, and resurrection of our Messiah I'll show you why we need to apply “Inclusive Reckoning”. If we are going to be able to verify that our Messiah was in the earth for three days and for three nights just like he said he would be, then we must use “Inclusive Reckoning” just like our Father did in the book of Exodus (that we just read).

So lets take a look at this time-line.

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As you can see.. Our Messiah dies on Thursday afternoon and even though it's three o'clock in the afternoon... Thursday is counted as day one.. Friday is a High Sabbath (and we talked about that in part one of this study last week) and it's day two. Saturday is the 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath, and it's counted as day 3.

Now using “Inclusive Reckoning” we can also see three nights... Thursday night is night one, Friday night is night 2, and Saturday night is night 3... so we have all three days and all three nights exactly as our Messiah told us that he would be in the earth using “Inclusive Reckoning”.

Now lets take a look at an example of “Exclusive Reckoning”.. some people will try to teach that our Messiah died on Wednesday, and if that's the case... you then are forced to use “Exclusive Reckoning”.. but... even with “Exclusive Reckoning”... we going to clearly see that this does not match up to what our Messiah said, nor does it match up to what the scriptures say.

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Now some people will teach that Yahshua died on a Wednesday afternoon... because they do not understand “Inclusive and Exclusive Reckoning”... but if we're going to abide by what the scripture says... and the very red letter words spoken by our Messiah say... then a Wednesday crucifixion is impossible.. because you wind up with Wednesday night, Thursday night, Friday night, and Saturday night... that's four nights... and four nights is not in line with what our Messiah said.. so clearly.. our Messiah could not have been crucified on a Wednesday.. in order for the prophecy of Jonah to work, and his own red letter words to be true.

So with that information under our belts... lets move back to our first time-line:

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Now once again this is “Inclusive Reckoning” because we're Including the day he died as day one.. even though it was three o'clock in the afternoon.. it's still included as day one... Just like God used the day that he spoke to Moses as being day one in the book of Exodus... and as you can see we are now able to fit the three day and three night formula that our Messiah gave us right over this time-line and see... that everything matches up perfectly. So there should be no doubt that our Messiah did indeed die.. on a Thursday afternoon... not on a Friday afternoon.

What most Christians do not understand is that there were actually two Sabbath days during the time that our Messiah was in the earth. Once he died on that cross... Gods people literally stood still. No one worked.. until the day that he was resurrected early Sunday morning on First Fruits... and for those of you who do not understand why there were two Sabbath days, and do not understand that the Feast of Unleavened Bread was known as a “High Sabbath”.. you can go back and check out part 1 of this study at our website at HolyImpactMinistries.com... or simply go read Exodus 12:16..

So now with that information under our belts... lets talk about exactly when our Messiah did actually rise from the dead... was it at sunrise like so many of our our modern day denominational charters of men, and their collage professors, and so called “Early church fathers” would have us believe? Lets turn to John chapter 20 verse 1:

*Jo 20:1 Now on the first day of the week Mary Magdalene came to the tomb early, while it was still dark, and saw that the stone had been taken away from the tomb.*

Now I don't know about you my friends.. but I don't see how in the world you can have a Sunday morning resurrection at sunrise.... and be having all of these pagan sunrise services..when it's still dark, and he's already gone. And when I say "Pagan Sunrise Services" I mean just that... and if you don't believe that my friends... stay with us.

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### **The Pagan Sunrise Service:**

I was an elder in more than one church... that would take a bunch of chairs out into the field on Sunday morning before the sun would come up... and they would face the chairs towards the east, with their backs to the house of God.. and actually sit and worship the beauty of the sun while telling the congregation... that this is when their "Jesus" rose from the dead... and they would bow their heads and pray before the sun... and this is how they would take it upon themselves to worship the one true God of Abraham, Issac, and Jacob, and his son.

Now.. most Christians once again are completely unaware... of what is written in their Bibles... because if they knew what was written in their bibles... they would never.. and I mean... never... attend an Easter "Sun rise Service" ever again. Let me show you what's written in the first half of the book that most Christians have been conveniently programmed not to read... you see there's a reason they don't want you to read the first half of the book... there's a reason that they don't want you to see these things... Let me show you just how clever our adversary is... let me show you how absolutely brilliant our adversary is.

*Eze 8:5 Then he said to me, "Son of man, lift up your eyes now toward the north." So I lifted up my eyes toward the north, and behold, north of the altar gate, in the entrance, was this image of jealousy.*

*Eze 8:6 And he said to me, "Son of man, do you see what they are doing, the great abominations that the house of Israel are committing here, to drive me far from my sanctuary? But you will see still greater abominations."*

*Eze 8:7 And he brought me to the entrance of the court, and when I looked, behold, there was a hole in the wall.*

*Eze 8:8 Then he said to me, "Son of man, dig in the wall." So I dug in the wall, and behold, there was an entrance.*

*Eze 8:9 And he said to me, "Go in, and see the vile abominations that they are committing here."*

*Eze 8:10 So I went in and saw. And there, engraved on the wall all around, was every form of creeping things and loathsome beasts, and all the idols of the house of Israel.*

*Eze 8:11 And before them stood seventy men of the elders of the house of Israel, with Jaazaniah the son of Shaphan standing among them. Each had his censer in his hand, and the smoke of the cloud of incense went up.*

*Eze 8:12 Then he said to me, "Son of man, have you seen what the elders of the house of Israel are doing in the dark, each in his room of pictures? For they say, 'The LORD does not see us,*



*the LORD has forsaken the land."*

*Eze 8:13 He said also to me, "You will see still greater abominations that they commit."*

*Eze 8:14 Then he brought me to the entrance of the north gate of the house of the LORD, and behold, there sat women weeping for Tammuz.*

*Eze 8:15 Then he said to me, "Have you seen this, O son of man? You will see still greater abominations than these."*

*Eze 8:16 And he brought me into the inner court of the house of the LORD. And behold, at the entrance of the temple of the LORD, between the porch and the altar, were about twenty-five men, with their backs to the temple of the LORD, and their faces toward the east, worshiping the sun toward the east.*

*Eze 8:17 Then he said to me, "Have you seen this, O son of man? Is it too light a thing for the house of Judah to commit the abominations that they commit here, that they should fill the land with violence and provoke me still further to anger? Behold, they put the branch to their nose.*

*Eze 8:18 Therefore I will act in wrath. My eye will not spare, nor will I have pity. And though they cry in my ears with a loud voice, I will not hear them."*

You see this Pagan tradition of Easter knows no bounds my friends. It is nothing more than a continuation of the most vile, and disrespectful pagan rituals ever known to man. And the reason that they have been taught to us.. is to purposely and continuously get Gods people to slap him in the face because of their lack of knowledge... and why?... all because they have rejected knowledge.

And I know that most of today's modern day professing Christians will say "Well I'm not worshiping the sun" but that's exactly what you are doing... you my friend are doing exactly what you've been trained to do...thinking in your own heart that what you are doing is good... but in reality.. what you are doing is calling evil... good... and good.... evil.

Our Father does not and I repeat... does not want to be worshiped like Tammuz!.. or any other pagan little "g" god for that matter... once again... let us re-read Deuteronomy chapter 12:

*Deu 12:28 Be careful to obey all these words that I command you, that it may go well with you and with your children after you forever, when you do what is good and right in the sight of the LORD your God.*

*Deu 12:29 "When the LORD your God cuts off before you the nations whom you go in to dispossess, and you dispossess them and dwell in their land,*

*Deu 12:30 take care that you be not ensnared to follow them, after they have been destroyed before you, and that you do not inquire about their gods, saying, 'How did these nations serve their gods?—that I also may do the same.'*

*Deu 12:31 You shall not worship the LORD your God in that way, for every abominable thing that the LORD hates they have done for their gods, for they even burn their sons and their daughters in the fire to their gods.*

*Deu 12:32 "Everything that I command you, you shall be careful to do. You shall not add to it*

*or take from it.*

And yet... so many will say “Oh Pastor... but I'm not worshipping the sun... we're worshipping God” and my question then becomes.. which God is it that you think you are worshipping? Because the one true God of Abraham, Issac, and Jacob says... and I quote... “You shall not worship the Lord your God in that way”... so if God says that we can't worship him in that way (as the pagans used to worship their gods)... then it should be evident that we are not worshipping the God that we think that we're worshipping while we're doing the exact same thing that he commanded us NOT TO DO!

My friends... do not sit out in a field with your back to the house of God, on Easter morning with your face to the sun... and think for one minute... that you are worshipping the one true God of Abraham, Issac, and Jacob... simply put my friends... YOU ...ARE.....NOT!

You can watch the beauty of a sun rise on any other day, and praise God... but not on the pagan Easter morning, sitting there weeping for Tammuz because some man lied to you and your children and made you believe that he raised from the dead on some pagan Easter day. The tears that are falling from your eyes are not for your Messiah... because if they were... you would have already celebrated the true anniversary of his death, burial, and resurrection on Passover day, and first fruits... the day that HE... said that he died, and the day that the SCRIPTURES tell us that he rose again... not some man made, man created, man fabricated pagan “Easter” festival.

First of all if you're sitting in that field on Easter morning... that means that you have completely and utterly ignored, profaned, and forsaken... the anniversary of his death, burial, and resurrection all together.... and you have traded his Passover for the bare breasted pagan goddess of Easter!

Second of all... you have no business sitting out in a field on a PAGAN HOLIDAY while claiming to follow the Messiah who taught us to get rid of and destroy all pagan worship and to expunge it from our hearts.

My friends... you can not have the laws of God written in your heart and in your mind, and still be dancing with the Devil in the pale moon light! You can not sit at the table of demons, and sit at the table of God... You can not be filled with the indwelling of the Ruach Hakodesh of God and still thirst after the pomp and the pageantry of a pagan goddess, and teach your children the magic and divination of a rabbit that lays colored eggs.

Knowing full well what the truth of Gods Word says concerning the death, burial, and resurrection of our Messiah you can not trample underfoot the Son of God, and profane the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and outrage the Spirit of grace! For we know who it was that said, "Vengeance is mine; I will repay." And again, "The Lord will

judge his people." My friends know this, and hear this... It is indeed.. a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

Now.. lets talk a little bit about "First Fruits" and what that is and why it's so important to understand. "First Fruits" is a very special day. It's special because once again there are several things that can be spiritually discerned from "First Fruits"... but before we get into that... let's go back and lets remember exactly who it is that our Father is looking for. Who is it exactly that our Father wants to be his people... who is it that our Father chooses to become his people? Lets turn back to the Samaritan woman at the well that our Messiah spoke to, and lets hear what he told her in John chapter 4 verses 19 through 24:

*Joh 4:19 The woman said to him, "Sir, I perceive that you are a prophet.*

*Joh 4:20 Our fathers worshiped on this mountain, but you say that in Jerusalem is the place where people ought to worship."*

*Joh 4:21 Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe me, the hour is coming when neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem will you worship the Father.*

*Joh 4:22 You worship what you do not know; we worship what we know, for salvation is from the Jews.*

*Joh 4:23 But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him.*

*Joh 4:24 God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth."*

My friends.. can one who chooses the man made, man created, man fabricated pagan "Easter" over our Messiah's "Passover" worship him in "spirit and in truth"? I would submit to you my friends... that there is nothing, and I say again... NOTHING.. spiritual about worshipping our Father like a bare breasted pagan goddess... and there certainly... and I say again there is CERTAINLY... no truth in what we are doing sitting with our backs to the house of God and our faces towards the sun on Easter morning... no....truth... what...so ...ever.

So our Father is looking for those who will worship him in "spirit.. and in truth" so obviously... then there are things that can only be seen by those of us who are "spiritual". There are things that only those who have the indwelling of the Ruach Hackodesh can see... because those spiritual things can only come from the Ruach Hackodesh himself... and so it is with things like the Passover, and with "First Fruits".

Lets go read... the commandment of "First Fruits" so that we can get a better understanding of what "First Fruits" is all about.. lets turn to

*Lev 23:5 In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at twilight, is the LORD's Passover.*

*Lev 23:6 And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the Feast of Unleavened Bread to the*

*LORD; for seven days you shall eat unleavened bread.*

*Lev 23:7 On the first day you shall have a holy convocation; you shall not do any ordinary work.*

*Lev 23:8 But you shall present a food offering to the LORD for seven days. On the seventh day is a holy convocation; you shall not do any ordinary work."*

*Lev 23:9 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,*

*Lev 23:10 "Speak to the people of Israel and say to them, When you come into the land that I give you and reap its harvest, you shall bring the sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the priest,*

*Lev 23:11 and he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, so that you may be accepted. On the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it.*

Notice here... that the sheaf of the firstfruits of the harvest was to be waved before our Father on "the day after the Sabbath", after the Passover. What day did our Messiah rise from the grave? Was it not the "the day after the Sabbath" of the Passover?

You see our Messiah was indeed the "First Fruit" of the "New Harvest"... once again proving the undeniable fact that our Messiah rose not on "Easter Sunday" according to the Roman Catholic church and her daughter Protestant churches.... but on "First Fruits" which was "the day after the Sabbath", after the Passover, making himself... the "First Fruit" of the "New Harvest"

*1Co 15:21 For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead.*

*1Co 15:22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive.*

*1Co 15:23 But each in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ.*

*1Co 15:24 Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power.*

In closing... let me say this...

Our Messiah told us in Matthew chapter 26 verse 2 that he was going to die on Passover Day. All four gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John all agree that he died on Passover day just as he told us that he would. Our Messiah told us in Matthew chapter 12 verse 40 that he would be in the earth for three days and for three nights. Our Messiah is called "The Passover Lamb" in 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians chapter 5 verse 7.... he is called the "First Fruit" in 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians chapter 15 verse 23. We are told explicitly in John chapter 4 verse 24 that we MUST WORSHIP HIM IN SPIRIT AND IN TRUTH!

So before I let you go... I would be re-missed if I did not proclaim to you loudly and clearly here today... that if you are still choosing the man made, man created, man fabricated pagan myth of Easter over his Passover.. and if you are still choosing to teach your children all the

pomp and pageantry and divination, and magic of this bare breasted fertility goddess and her Easter rabbits that magically lay colored eggs all over your houses... then you have been weighed and found wanting!

You are guilty... of continuing to sin deliberately after receiving the knowledge of the truth... and therefore.. according to the scripture and the scripture alone... there no longer remains a sacrifice for your sins.. because you are continuing to trample underfoot the Son of God and are profaning the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and you are continuing to outrage the Spirit of Grace!... For we know him who said... “Vengeance is mine... I will repay” and again we have all been warned by our Messiah in Revelation chapter 18 verses 4 and 5 to “Come out of her my people lest you take part in her sins... lest you share in her plagues... for her sins are heaped as high as heaven... and God has remembered her iniquities”!

These “lying scribes”... these “false prophets” these modern day “Saducees, and Pharisees” will all be punished according to the scriptures.... so why let them drag you and your children down with them? Why take part in their sins... why share in their plagues... why not simply turn and come back to the truth of Gods Word right now, right here, right this very day, this very hour, this very minute... this very second. Why not REPENT of our sins so that we can truly wash ourselves and our children in the blood of our Messiah and break the bread and share the cup and celebrate the “New Covenant” that his very blood ushered in.. on the day that he told us to do so, and to remember... knowing and understanding... and seeking after.... the truth.

I beg you.... I literally beg you... turn.... now... and come.

My friends the sand is leaving the hour glass as we speak... look around you... the world is in chaos... it reels to and fro like a drunkard... it sways like a hut.. it's transgressions are heavy upon it.. and it will fall...

They will say, "Where is the promise of his coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all things are continuing as they were from the beginning of creation." For they deliberately overlook this fact, that the heavens existed long ago, and the earth was formed out of water and through water by the word of God, and that by means of these.. the world that then existed was deluged with water and perished.

But by the same word the heavens and earth that now exist are stored up for fire, being kept until the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly. But do not overlook this one fact, my friends, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance... but... reach repentance... we must. (2<sup>nd</sup> Pet 3:4-9)
