# The Preacher!

#### Intro; Then Begin:

Once again, I would like to welcome everyone this morning and to say thank you so very much for joining us on our Father's 7<sup>th</sup> Day Sabbath which by the way, is once again the only Sabbath day of God commanded by anyone anywhere within the confines of the 66 books of our God breathed scripture. This morning we'll be diving into the biblical definition of a "Preacher" and exactly what the spoken word of Yehovah God says the biblical definition of a preacher that has been sent by God actually is... verses... the definition of an ungodly preacher that has not been sent by God. And we'll talk about exactly why the Bible does indeed warn us about these ungodly preachers who love to dress themselves up like an angel of light, and why this makes them more dangerous than a den of snakes in a woodpile.

Over time, most of us have sat in the pew of one modern day denominational church or another. Some of us have sat in the pews of many different modern day denominational churches, and some of us have even sat as Elders within some of these many different modern-day denominational churches. But how often do we test the fruit of these so-called preachers? And what measuring stick do we use to test these so-called preachers to see whether their fruit is good or rotten? The truth is... that the Bible itself (which is the spoken word of God) commands us to test the sprits to see if they be true or false, and it is written that we will indeed know them by their fruit. Our God breathed scripture tells us that the devil loves to dress himself up like and angel of light and so do his servants... and while pondering this very scripture I was reminded of what the Apostle Paul wrote about such angels of light who call themselves "preachers". Let's begin our study this morning by turning to **2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 11:13-15 (scrn 1)** 

# FALES PREACHERS (APOSTLES)

2Co 11:13 For such men are false apostles, deceitful workmen, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ.
2Co 11:14 And no wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light.
2Co 11:15 So it is no surprise if his servants, also, disguise themselves as servants of righteousness. Their end will correspond to their deeds.

And so, even back in the days of the Apostle Paul we have a description of who these false preachers are and not only what they're up to... but who it was that sent them. And I would submit to you my friends that it is these very false apostles that come preaching another Jesus, and another spirit and another gospel that have indeed infiltrated the Church today just as they were doing back in the days of the Apostle Paul. And it is these very servants of the devil himself who are right now as we speak teaching heresy and flat-out abominations that ought not to be taught.

If a preacher is not a preacher of the word of God... then who is he a preacher of? If he was not sent by God... then who was it that sent him? And if he is not preaching the word of our Father in heaven... then who's word is he preaching? If he preaches a Jesus not known by our Father in heaven... a Jesus that is not taught of within the confines of our God breathed scripture... then what Jesus is he teaching? And more importantly... why? Why would anyone preach another Jesus, another spirit or another gospel other than the one that our Messiah and his Apostles have taught us?

And while pondering this question... let us all remember that the Pharisees and the Scribes of our Messiah's time were preaching the word of God... and yet... our Messiah called them children of the devil. Why? (scrn 2)

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# **Do And Observe The Torah!** Says Yeshua (Jesus in the Greek)

Mat 23:1 Then Jesus said to the crowds and to his disciples, Mat 23:2 "The scribes and the Pharisees sit on Moses' seat, Mat 23:3 so do and observe whatever they tell you, but not the works they do. For they preach, but do not practice.

You see, the scribes and the Pharisees were reading the law... the Torah... the spoken word of God in their synagogues... but they were not practicing what they were preaching. And later in our Messiah's ministry we see that it was these same scribes and Pharisees that had made void the word of God in order to hold onto their own traditions, and this is exactly why our Messiah called them two-fold children of hell in Matthew chapter 23, and again said that they were indeed children of the devil himself in John chapter 8.

You see it is indeed a sin which is a transgression of the law to add to... or to take away from the word of God says God in Deuteronomy chapters four and twelve. Mixing and mingling the truth with lies is forbidden according to the word of God. Trading what is sweet for what is bitter and what is bitter for what is sweet... trading a lie for the truth and the truth for a lie is indeed the quintessential biblical definition of... sin.

One of the biggest heresies that these false preachers teach is that the law of Yehovah God... which is his spoken word that our Messiah became by the way... is done away with. They ignorantly and shamefully teach and preach the exact opposite of what the spoken word of our Father in heaven and his only begotten Son says without stutter. They have created for themselves a false Jesus... a false god that came to do away with his Father's 7<sup>th</sup> Day Sabbath, and re-create a new first day of the week Sunday Sabbath for himself... a false god that came to do away with his Father's appointed feast days and appointments, a false god that came to make it all about himself who came to turn the spoken word of his Father into a curse and to celebrate his own birthday, and to sit on his own throne instead of sitting on the throne of David as his Father in heaven had promised his faithful servant David in 2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel chapter 7.

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As many of you already know we've already done a rather lengthy study on exactly why the law of our Father in heaven cannot be done away with according to scripture, and that study began at the end of 2020 and lasted for 12 straight weeks, and we still left much information on the table. We could have very easily continued on throughout the rest of the year showing through the spoken word of God why his word is indeed perfect and why it must still stand today in our time according to not only the Apostles themselves... but also according to the very red-letter words of our very own Messiah.

But... nevertheless... there will always be those who could care less. There will always be those who would rather dress themselves up like angels of light... calling themselves "preachers", and "bishops" and "rabbis" and "popes" and "priests" who are indeed false apostles, deceitful workmen who disguise themselves as apostles of our Messiah, and this... is exactly what we will be focusing on here this morning.

How do we tell the difference between a Godly preacher and an ungodly preacher? How do we tell the difference between those who preach the truth... and those who have traded what is bitter for what is sweet and what is sweet for what is bitter... those who have traded the truth for a lie, and a lie for the truth? (scrn 3)



Normally when we hear the word "preacher" we usually have a little different picture in our minds than what we see depicted here on our screen this morning, and for those of you who are listening by radio this morning what we are showing here on the screen is a depiction of a

demon like character with yellow eyes and horns and a snarled look with teeth that are in need of some serious dental work.

But the point is, that we seldom picture a demon or the devil himself when we hear the title or the word "preacher". When we hear the word "preacher" we often times picture in our minds a kindly looking man with a leather bound bible and a \$100 haircut, shiny patent leather shoes and a nice warm smile, and more times than not... this is exactly what we get when we venture into the closest church on the corner of almost any street... at least here in the U.S.. But what we often times do not see... is what's on the inside of that kindly looking man with a leather-bound bible and a \$100 haircut, shiny patent leather shoes and a nice warm smile. Listen closely to what our very own Messiah tells us about how to spot a false preacher who dresses himself up like one of the sheep in order to lead the sheep astray; Matthew 7:15-20 (scrn 4)

### A Tree and Its Fruit

Mat 7:15 "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves.

Mat 7:16 You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles?

Mat 7:17 So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. Mat 7:18 A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit. Mat 7:19 Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Mat 7:20 Thus you will recognize them by their fruits.



I'd like to idle here for just a moment in order to recognize a few things concerning these precious red letter words that come directly from the very breath, the lips, the very mouth and tongue of our beloved Messiah.

The first thing that we should be able to take away from these red-letter words is the fact that our Messiah is warning us about wolves in sheep's clothing entering into the flock. And so, there should be no doubt in our minds that wolves will indeed enter into the flock dressed as sheep. And so, what is our Messiah telling us that they will look like? Does he say that they will look like wolves... or does he say... that they will look like sheep? Our Messiah tells us specifically that these wolves who are entering into the flock will not look like wolves. What will they look like? According to our Messiah... they will look like sheep. In other words... they will look like a kindly man with a leather bound bible a \$100 haircut, shiny patent leather shoes and a nice warm smile. And I tell you the truth my friends... often times these wolves in sheep's clothing who look like kindly men with leather bound bibles a \$100 haircut, shiny patent leather shoes and a nice warm smile are standing behind a denominational pulpit.

But our Messiah tells us even more about these wolves in sheep's clothing. He tells us that we will recognize them by their fruit, in other words... what they produce. Do they produce good fruit... or rotten fruit? And our Messiah goes on to tell us that a good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a bad tree produce good fruit. What does this mean?

Can a good tree bear bad fruit? Have you ever seen a good tree bear bad fruit? I have. Often times an apple or an orange or a pare can get to much sunlight because it's on one side of the tree that gets to much sunlight and that particular apple, orange, or pair can rot before it's time, and sometimes a particular apple, orange or pair can not get enough sun light on the back side of the tree and it can become infested with ants or insects before it becomes ripe, and so... can a good tree from time to time bare bad fruit for different reasons? Yes!

So... what is our Messiah talking about? What is the message that our Messiah is trying to convey to us? Our Messiah is talking about what the tree produces over all. Our Messiah is talking about the fact that a good tree has the ability to feed the masses and give life because the majority of the fruit it produces is indeed good healthy fruit that leads to life.


And so it is with each man. We all have fallen short of the glory of our Father in heaven. We have all sined, and it is written that if we say that we do not sin... then we are liars, not says I but says our God breathed scripture. Let's turn this morning to 1<sup>st</sup> John 1:5-10 (scrn 5)

## Walking in the Light

1Jn 1:5 This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.
1Jn 1:6 If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.
1Jn 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.
1Jn 1:8 If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
1Jn 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
1Jn 1:10 If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

Notice here in 1<sup>st</sup> John chapter 1 verse 6, John tells us that if we say that we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness... in other words if we walk in the transgression of the law... we are liars... because we do not practice the truth. What is John talking about here? John is simply telling us that we are to pick up our crosses and follow our Messiah and do what he did and walk as he walked. Our Messiah kept all of his Father's feast days and Sabbaths and appointments, in fact our Messiah kept the word of God so well it is written that he became... the word of God... that's how well he kept the word of God which is the law. There is nothing in the law that is not the spoken word of God. How do we know that we are to also fallow him and do as he did? All we have to do is to jump to 1<sup>st</sup> John chapter 2 verses 1-6 (scrn 6)

And so, once again, the Apostle John is telling us that we are to follow our Messiah and if we do not walk in the same way in which he walked... if we say that we know him... but we do not keep his commandments... who are we according to the Apostle John? We are liars... and the truth isn't even in us not says I... but says our God breathed scripture. And who's word did our Messiah come to teach and to preach to us? Did our Messiah come to preach his own word and to re-create his own first day of the week Sunday Sabbath and to celebrate his own birthday and to abolish his Father's word and turn it into a curse? Or did he come to move the penalty of the law out of the way so that we could return to his Father's spoken word? What was the curse of the law? It was the penalty of the law... not the law itself. Listen closely to the very red letter words of our Messiah found in John 14:24-26 (scrn 7)

## The Word YouHear Is Not Mine!!!

Joh 14:24 Whoever does not love me does not keep my words. And the word that you hear is not mine but the Father's who sent me. Joh 14:25 "These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you. Joh 14:26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.



You see, the word that our Messiah came to teach and to preach was not his own word, it was his Father's word that was written from the beginning, and those who do not follow it, do not love him. Not says I... but says the very red letter words of our very own beloved Messiah and King.

The Church today is all about the love of God. The Church today is all about how special we are. The Church today is all about how much God loves us, and how much our Messiah loves us. The Church today is all about how much God loves them... but the Church today teaches nothing about how we are to show our love back to him! The Church today prays for the world to be healed, they pray for uncle John to healed of cancer, or for their bills to be paid, or for their children to be saved, or for their own prosperity and wellbeing, and the whole time... while they continually ask these things of God... the scripture which is the very God breathed spoken word of God is cast down and trampled by wolves in sheep's clothing who demonically proclaim that the very spoken word of our Father in heaven that our Messiah came to bring us back to... is null and void and done away with and a curse. The church today teaches that love is a one-way street. Love comes down from God but we have no responsibility... we have no worries, nothing to do to show our love for him in return. It's all about us and how special we are. The Church today teaches that our love in no way shape or form needs to be reciprocated back to where it originally came from. It's all about Jesus doing it all for me at the cross while I just get to bask in his glory and twiddle my thumbs. Your once saved always saved so it's okay to return like a dog to your vomit and like a pig to its mire says... the Church today. But what does our very own Messiah teach us? (scrn 8)

## <u>Depart From Me</u> You Workers of LAWLESSNESS!

Mat 7:21 'Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. Mat 7:22 On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?'

Mat 7:23 And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.'



And once again, your King James version of the Bible may say "iniquity" here instead of lawlessness but the original Greek word here is "An-om-ee-ah" (anomia) and it means "transgression of the law" look it up!

According to the red-letter words of our very own Messiah... you can call him "Lord" all you want. You can even call his name "Jesus", you can even call him by his rightful Hebrew name "Yeshua" all day long... but if you are not doing the will of his Father who is in heaven... if you have rejected him by rejecting his Father that he came to bring you back to... you are not getting into the gates of heaven. Furthermore... our very own Messiah tells us that if you are "lawless"... "an-om-ee-ah" (anomia) you do not know him and he... does not know you. What did we just hear the Apostle John telling us in 1<sup>st</sup> John chapter 2 verse 4?... whoever says that they know him but does not keep his commandments is what?... is a liar and the truth is not even in him, and what commandments did our Messiah come to command us?... his own word, or his Father's word according to our very own Messiah?

My friends it's not about throwing the spoken word of our Father in heaven to the ground so that we don't have to be bothered with it anymore... it's about reciprocating our love for him. It's about knowing and understanding the biblical definition of the love of God found in 1<sup>st</sup> John chapter 5. (scrn 9)

# The Biblical Definition of God;

1Jn 5:1 Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has been born of God, and everyone who loves the Father loves whoever has been born of him.
1Jn 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments.
1Jn 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome.

How could we be so vanity filled as to believe that the Roman Catholic created Jesus did it all for us at the cross, and that we have absolutely no responsibility? How could we have become so vanity filled and loathsome and self-centered to believe that our Father's spoken word is a curse and that it is some kind of mistake that can be treated as though it was never spoken? Is this how we show our love for our Father in heaven who sent his only begotten Son so that we might not perish? Is this how we repay our beloved Messiah and King for laying his life down for our transgressions so that we could return to his Father? Even the Scribes and the Pharisees didn't erase the spoken word of God... sure they added to it... but they still read it every Sabbath in the synagogues, but what has modern day Christianity done to God's word? It has not only added to the word of God time and time again by adding its own Sabbaths and holidays and pagan Easter's and "Good Fridays" but they have totally and utterly erased the very commandment of God himself!

What did our Messiah tell the Scribes and the Pharisees of his time? Let's turn to Matthew 15:1-9 E1

#### **Traditions and Commandments**

Mat 15:1 Then Pharisees and scribes came to Jesus from Jerusalem and said, Mat 15:2 "Why do your disciples break the tradition of the elders? For they do not wash their hands when they eat." Mat 15:3 He answered them, "And why do you break the commandment of God for the sake of your tradition? Mat 15:4 For God commanded, 'Honor your father and your mother,' and, 'Whoever

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reviles father or mother must surely die.
Mat 15:5 But you say, `If anyone tells his father or his mother, ``What you would have gained from me is given to God,"
Mat 15:6 he need not honor his father.' So for the sake of your tradition you have made void the word of God.
Mat 15:7 You hypocrites! Well did Isaiah prophesy of you, when he said:
Mat 15:8 "This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me;
Mat 15:9 in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.'"

Why does our Messiah quote the prophet Isaiah? Why does he say that they honored him with their lips while their hearts were far from him? Why did he say that they worshiped him in vain? He says they worship me in vain because they are teaching as doctrines the commandments of men!

Who commanded a first day of the week Sunday Sabbath? Men! Who commanded a "Good Friday" crucifixion instead of honoring the Passover which is the very day that all four gospels Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John all tell us our Messiah died on? Men! Who commanded an Easter Sunday morning instead of the day of First Fruits the actual day that our Messiah was resurrected to wave the sheaf offering before his Father signaling the new incoming harvest so that we could be accepted? Men! Who is it that worships him in vain because they are teaching the doctrines and commandments of men? The Pope of Rome and her protestant daughter Churches who no longer protest against anything!

Our Messiah tells us very clearly that it is not those who call him Lord that are getting into his Father's kingdom... but only those who do the will of his Father who is in his kingdom, but what does man say? Mans says "no!... the spoken word of God is null and void and a curse for those who keep it!" But what does the Bible say? What does God's breathed scripture tell us? What does our beloved Messiah tell us? What do the Apostles including the Apostle Paul tell us? (scrn 10)

**Rom 2:13** For it is not the hearers of the law who are righteous before God, but the doers of the law who will be justified.

**Rom 3:31** Do we then overthrow the law by this faith? By no means! On the contrary, we uphold the law.

Rom 6:1 What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound? Rom 6:2 By no means! How can we who died to sin still live in it?

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*Rom 7:12* So *the law is holy*, and *the commandment is holy and righteous and good.* 

Rom 8:7 For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot. Rom 8:8 Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

**Rom 8:2** For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.

Once again my friends... who is it that teaches that the spoken word of God is null and void and a curse? (scrn 11)



This is the one who proclaims that Yehovah God's word is dead... this is the one who has thought to change the times and the laws of the one true Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob... this is the one who has built for himself his own gentile country club Church... this is the one who has crafted his own sabbaths, and his own feast days and his own birthday... this is the one who proclaims himself to be a preacher dressing himself up as an angel of light... a wolf in sheep's clothing... this is the one who teaches us to honor our Messiah with our lips while our hearts are far from him... this is the one who is the father of all lies because it is his character to lie because he has been a liar from the beginning!... this is the serpent, the dragon, the devil who has made war on the offspring of the woman and on those who keep the commandments of God and the testimony of Yeshua Hamashiach the only begotten Son of God the Son of David the seed of Abraham and the offspring of the human women who was sent to crush the head of the serpent so that we could return to our Father in heaven as he intended from the very beginning! This is him my friends... this is him, and let there be no mistake about it my friends... he does indeed dress himself up like an angel of light to fool if possible... even the very elect! (scrn 12)



This wolf in sheep's clothing has had many different disguises throughout history. This devil that dresses himself up like an angel of light takes on many forms and many fashions... he loves pomp and pageantry... he loves to tie up heaven burdens that are hard to bear and lay them on people's shoulders while they themselves are not willing to move them with their finger. They do all their deeds to be seen by others. They make their robs and their gowns colorful and long, they love the place of honor at their man-made feasts and the best seats in their gentile country club churches, and they love to be greeted in the marketplaces and to be

called great one's by others the whole time... waging war against those who keep the commandments of God and the testimony of our Messiah and King. (scrn 13)



Do not be fooled by these wolves in sheep's clothing. Do not be fooled by these devils who love to dress themselves up as angels of light. Do not be fooled by those who come to preach death and darkness dressed up as truth and light. Do not be fooled by these people who have crept into the flock unnoticed who long ago where designated for this condemnation, ungodly people who pervert the grace of our God into sensuality and deny our only Master and Lord Yehshua Hamashiach who came to move the penalty of the law out of the way so that we could once again return to his Father! Do not be fooled by them or the demonically inspired doctrines that they teach! And know and understand that it is written that even the Apostle Paul that today's modern day gentile country club church claims to have built their churches upon... always kept the law which is the spoken word of Yehovah God! (scrn 14)

## The Apostle Paul Always Kept The Law!


Rom 7:25 Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself serve the law of God with my mind, but with my flesh I serve the law of sin.

Act 21:23 Do therefore what we tell you. We have four men who are under a vow; Act 21:24 take these men and purify yourself along with them and pay their expenses, so that they may shave their heads. Thus all will know that there is nothing in what they have been told about you, but that you yourself also live in observance of the kw.



According to the Apostle Paul it was the penalty of the law that was a curse. God made us alive with him having forgiven us all of our trespasses by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands nailing that debt to the cross and setting aside the penalty so that we could finally return to the truth of God's word... not so that we could trash it and trample it underfoot!

The law which is the spoken word of God is to be written in our hearts and in our minds according to the promise of God in Jeremiah chapter 31 in the Old Testament and Hebrews chapter 10 in the New Testament and this was the New Covenant that the very blood of our Messiah brought through his blood says our very own Messiah in Luke chapter 22 verse 20! (scrn 15)




It's not about turning the spoken word of our Father in heaven into a curse as the wretched church today has done... it's about coming back to the word of God... it's about following our Messiah who became the word of God so that we also would follow him and become the word of God made flesh. It's about following him and walking as he walked and doing as he did. He was our example... he was, is and always will be our King that we are to follow back to the tree of life that we were banished from in the garden of Eden because of our transgression. It's a second chance... it's a calling... it's a gift... it's an opportunity a hope that we have been given to once again walk with God in the garden just as Adam did, and just as our Messiah does. (scrn 16)

Those who have been chosen to preach and to teach the truth of God's word preach blessings and life... they do not preach curses and death! **Deuteronomy 30:11-20 E2** 

#### The Choice of Life and Death

**Deu 30:11** "For this commandment that I command you today <mark>is not too hard for you,</mark> neither is it far off.

Deu 30:12 It is not in heaven, that you should say, `Who will ascend to heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?'

Deu 30:13 Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, 'Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?'

Deu 30:14 But the word is very near you. It is in your mouth and in your heart, so that you can do it.

Deu 30:15 "See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil.

Deu 30:16 If you obey the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you today, by loving the LORD your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, then you shall live and multiply, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it.

Deu 30:17 But if your heart turns away, and you will not hear, but are drawn away to worship other gods and serve them,

Deu 30:18 I declare to you today, that you shall surely perish. You shall not live long in the land that you are going over the Jordan to enter and possess.


Deu 30:19 I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live,

Deu 30:20 loving the LORD your God, obeying his voice and holding fast to him, for he is your life and length of days, that you may dwell in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them."

It is not what is exalted by God that is the abomination my friends... it is what is exalted among men that is the abomination. Not says I... but says our God breathed scripture! (scrn 18)

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These modern-day Scribes and Pharisees who speak against the spoken word of God are not preachers of our God... they are the preachers of the little "g" god of this world who is the prince of the air. Those who have been sent to preach are only those who humble themselves before the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob and stand on the rock that is his word. (scrn 19)




Here is the true preacher of God... here are those who are humbled enough to come as little children to the spoken word of God... here are those who will inherit the kingdom of God... here are those who will have the law of God written on their hearts and in their minds not says I... but says the red letter words of our very own Messiah; Luke 18:15-17 (scrn 20)

# **True Godly Preachers Come Before God Like Children**

Luk 18:15 Now they were bringing even infants to him that he might touch them. And when the disciples saw it, they rebuked them. Luk 18:16 But Jesus called them to him, saying, "Let the children come to me, and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God. Luk 18:17 Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it."



(scrn 21)



In the end there is no difference between a gun and the Bible. Both can be used to give life... and both can be used to take life away. Both can be used to feed and give life... and both can be

used to starve and to take life away.

Those who do not know how to handle a gun should not own a gun without being trained in the proper way to handle it, and those who do not know how to handle the spoken word of God should not own a Bible without being trained in the proper way to handle it.

There are those who will use the very spoken word of God... the very Bible itself to steel the very salvation that our Messiah came to deliver to you and to your children and to your children's children. They are indeed as the Bible itself says... false apostles, deceitful workmen disguising themselves as apostles of our Messiah. And no wonder... for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light, so it should be of no surprise to us if he servants also disguise themselves as servants of righteousness, but I tell you the truth my friends... their end will indeed correspond to their deeds. John 8:43-47(scrn 22)

## Why Can They Not Hear God's Word?

Joh 8:43 Why do you not understand what I say? It is because you cannot bear to hear my word.

Joh 8:44 You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

Joh 8:45 But because I tell the truth, you do not believe me.

Joh 8:46 Which one of you convicts me of sin? If I tell the truth, why do you not believe me?

Joh 8:47 Whoever is of God hears the words of God. The reason why you do not hear them is that you are not of God."



Before we close this session this morning I would be lacking in my duty if I were not to once again proclaim the perfect law of God as proclaimed by David, who our Messiah is the descendant of. We must remember that it is the throne of David that our Messiah sits on this very day because just as the very first sentence of our New Testament proclaims... our Messiah is... the son of David who was a man after God's own heart, and if you don't believe that... I would encourage you to go read 2nd Samuel chapter 7, but the point that I am trying to make here this very morning... is exactly what David said about the law... the Torah... the very spoken word of Yehovah God. What did David who our Messiah is a descendant of say about the law of God? **Psalms 19 E3** 

Psa 19:1 To the choirmaster. A Psalm of David. The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork.

Psa 19:2 Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge.

Psa 19:3 There is no speech, nor are there words, whose voice is not heard.

Psa 19:4 Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them he has set a tent for the sun,

Psa 19:5 which comes out like a bridegroom leaving his chamber, and, like a strong man, runs its course with joy.

Psa 19:6 Its rising is from the end of the heavens, and its circuit to the end of them, and there is nothing hidden from its heat.

Psa 19:7 The law of the LORD is perfect<mark>, reviving the soul; the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple;</mark>

Psa 19:8 the precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes;

Psa 19:9 the fear of the LORD is clean<mark>, enduring forever;</mark> the rules of the LORD are true, and righteous altogether.

Psa 19:10 More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb.

Psa 19:11 Moreover, by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.

Psa 19:12 Who can discern his errors? Declare me innocent from hidden faults.

Psa 19:13 Keep back your servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me! Then I shall be blameless, and innocent of great transgression.

Psa 19:14 Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O LORD, my rock and my redeemer.

Once again my friends... the Bible cannot be read from the middle of the book to the end. The spoken word of God also known as our Bibles must be read from the beginning of the book from the book of Genesis and not from the middle. Who buys a book and begins reading it from the middle of the book and then thinks that they know the story? Only the foolish do such things. Only those who have been pre-programed by wolves in sheep's clothing do such foolishness.

The Bible is one testament... one story... one unfolding plan of salvation that began clear back in the garden of Eden. The Bible is indeed as Timothy tells us God breathed, and it is profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness that the man of God may be completely equipped for ever good work. What are good works? What is the whole duty of man according to our God breathed scripture? Ecclesiastes 12:12-13 (scrn 23)

# The Whole Duty of Man;

Ecc 12:12 My son, beware of anything beyond these. Of making many books there is no end, and much study is a weariness of the flesh.

Ecc 12:13 The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man.



If indeed the Pharisees of our Messiah's time were called sons of the devil by our Messiah because they had made void the word of God in order to hold onto their own traditions... then today's modern-day version of Christianity is 10 fold worse than just sons of the devil. At least the Pharisees read the law of Moses in their Churches every Sabbath. Does today's Church read the Torah every Sabbath? They don't even know when the Sabbath is! (scrn 24)

# **Do And Observe The Torah!** Says Yeshua (Jesus in the Greek)

Mat 23:1 Then Jesus said to the crowds and to his disciples, Mat 23:2 "The scribes and the Pharisees sit on Moses' seat, Mat 23:3 so do and observe whatever they tell you, but not the works they do. For they preach, but do not practice.

Watch out my friends for those who call themselves "Preachers". The two-fold duty of a true God-fearing Messiah following cross bearing Preacher according to Ephesians chapter 4 is to prepare the saints for the work of ministry and to protect them so that we are no longer children tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine <u>and by human</u> <u>cunning and deceitful scheme</u>. And if you're preacher is not doing this according to the spoken word of Yehovah God and Yehovah God alone... then he is indeed no preacher of Yehovah God.

It is written in 1<sup>st</sup> John chapter four that we are to test the sprits to see whether they are from God, for many false prophets have gone out into the world. We should be on guard when someone calls themselves a preacher. And it is these preachers that we should all be testing because it is these preachers that have been sent by one God... or the other. And it is up to us to know which god... has indeed sent them.

And with that last warning I will ask as I always do... that everyone within the sound of my voice would please... please take what you have heard here this evening to your own prayer closet. Bow your head and bend your knee and face the holy promised land of Jerusalem and ask in the name of Yeshua Hamashiach if what you have heard here today be true or not.

Ask, seek, and knock on his door and on his door alone... and the proper door will be opened to you. And if you will that... and if you will stay the course to the end... you and I will surely walk through the gates of his soon coming kingdom together.

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"If a prophet or a dreamer of dreams arises among you and gives you a sign or a wonder, and the sign or wonder that he tells you comes to pass, and if he says, 'Let us go after other gods,' which you have not known, (*a false Jesus*)' and let us serve them,'

you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams. For the LORD your God is testing you, to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

You shall walk after the LORD your God and fear him and keep his commandments and obey his voice, and you shall serve him and hold fast to him.
