Idolatry The Devils Favorite Sin

Today's study I believe is going to be a very eye-opening study as we zero in on the topic of "*idolatry*" and the biblical concept of idolatry and what it actually means, and what it actually points to biblically speaking. And as we move forward here this morning my hope and my prayer this morning is that we may be able to open the eyes of those who are having trouble seeing, and the ears of those who are having trouble hearing what our God breathed Scripture is literally shouting from its pages.


Today's modern-day Christian by enlarge has been preprogrammed by anyone of over 50,000 different Christian denominational charters of men to read the Bible from the middle of the Bible instead of reading the Bible from the beginning of the Bible. Most modern-day Christians by and large believe that the Bible starts in the book of Matthew, and because they believe that the Bible begins in the book of Matthew, they have been deceived and lured into completely negating, and throwing away the first half of their Bibles. And this my friends is a shame... an utter and even blasphemous shame for today's modern-day Christian to have fallen for.

And I know that we talk about this all of the time, but it's important that we talk about it all of the time because there are so many millions of modern-day Christians out there today who truly do believe that the Bible begins in the book of Matthew.

Today, we're going to once again show, and prove out according to Scripture why it's so important to read the Bible from the beginning and not to read the Bible from the middle and ignore the first half of the Bible as so many modern-day hucksters standing behind today's modern-day pulpits disgracefully and shamefully teach and preach.

When we begin to read the Bible from the beginning, starting with the book of Exodus, we begin to understand that there are all kinds of words that can be found within the pages of our Bibles that have more than one meaning. Many words that we find in our Bibles are actually used as metaphors, which simply means that they once again, have more than one meaning. The word "*adultery*" is a perfect example. Most modern-day Christians, when they hear the word "*adultery*" will automatically think that the word "*adultery*" is used exclusively to depict a married man or woman having an intimate relationship with another married man or woman. However... the word "*adultery*" in the Bible is often times used as a metaphor for Yah's children worshiping other gods. When Yah's children turn away from him, and turn to other gods, they are indeed committing adultery in the eyes of Yahovah.

When we, as Yah's children forsake our Father in heaven... when we depart from his ways to follow after our own ways, this is seen as adultery or whoredom. A great example of this is found in the book of Hosea. **Hosea 1:1-2 (scrn 1)**




Unfortunately, by and large, today's modern-day Christian has no concept of the meaning of idolatry, or adultery as the Bible itself defines idolatry and adultery because they once again do not read the book from the beginning as they should. Most modern-day Christians by and large believe that they are "once saved always saved" and that they cannot lose their salvation, and the reason that they believe that they are once saved always saved and that they cannot lose their salvation is because this is what has been taught by wolves in sheep's clothing standing behind today's modern-day denominational pulpits.

But for a true God-fearing, Messiah following, cross bearing Christian who reads the Bible for themselves, we know... That you cannot read second Peter chapter 2, or Hebrews chapter 10, or Hebrews chapter 6, or the book of Revelation, or the red-letter words spoken by our Messiah, and come away from the Bible thinking that we are "once saved always saved". And so, before we move forward here this morning I'd like to present to you a little 10 minute teaching that we did just this past year concerning the demonic teaching of "once saved always saved" (PLAY VIDEO HERE)

Moving forward... as we begin to read the Bible from the beginning of the book, we begin to realize that idolatry and adultery go hand-in-hand, and have everything to do with forsaking, or ignoring the commandments of our Father in heaven. Another perfect example of this can be found in **Ezekiel 23:37 (scrn 2)**



Eze 23:37 For they have committed adultery, and blood is on their hands. With their idols they have committed adultery, and they have even offered up to them for food the children whom they had borne to me.

Ezekiel chapter 23 verse 37 clearly establishes the biblical definition of both “*idolatry*” and “*adultery*”. Once again, “*idolatry*” and “*adultery*” go hand-in-hand. If a man is led away from Yahovah by a beautiful woman, he is indeed idolizing that woman. That woman becomes his idol. And when that woman becomes his idol, and the most important thing in his life... that man is immediately guilty of adultery in the eyes of Yahovah whether or not he has ever even touched that woman physically makes no difference. Let’s take a close look at **Matthew 10:37 (scrn 3)**

Mat 10:37 Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.



Once again, I would submit to you that if you love your Father or your mother more than your Messiah... you have made your Father or your mother your idol. They are what you idolize. They are what you worship. And you are therefore guilty of adultery in the eyes of our Father in heaven and his only begotten Son.

Properly understanding this concept should help us to understand what true “*idolatry*”, and “*adultery*” actually mean within the context of Scripture. **Colossians 3:5 (scrn 4)**

Col 3:5 Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, **which is idolatry.**



If you were to approach a modern-day professing Christian standing outside of any church today, and you were to ask that modern-day professing Christian if they had ever engaged in idolatry, chances are very good that that modern-day professing Christian would proclaim that they have never engaged in idolatry. But... is that true?

I want us to think about that question for just a moment. Have we... ever committed idolatry? Have we... ever committed adultery against Yahovah our Father in heaven or his only begotten Son? I want us to pause here for just a moment and think about that question. **(scrn 6)**



Anybody ever watch this show before? Anybody ever raced to the television set each time this show came on the air so that they could see who the next and I quote, "*American Idol*" was going to be?

And what about these three people that are sitting behind this desk? Could it be said that any one of these three people might be someone's "*idol*"?

How many people in the world do you think that there are that would easily pay 50 to 100 dollars in order to go to a concert to see any one of these "*American Idol*'s"? How many people in the world do you think have posters, and images of these "*American idols*" plastered all over their bedroom walls? **(scrn 7)**



How about one of these idols? Do you think any of our children might have any of these kinds of posters plastered on their bedroom walls? Images... of these man-made gods? Think about it for just a minute. Human beings that defy nature. Human beings that can fly, that have supernatural power, and supernatural strength. Human beings that have the ability to save the world from destruction. (scrn 7)



Is there really any difference between the idols found back in the days of David, and Solomon, and Rehoboam... and the idols found today in the days of Donald Trump (also known as King Cyrus by some... another whole topic that we won't get into here today)?

My point in all of this is that there truly is no difference between the man-made idols of

yesterday and the man-made idols of today. Yesterday, during the days of the patriarchs and even the apostles, these idols were man-made. Today during our time, these idols are again, man-made. And I would submit to you that both the idols of yesterday, and the idols of today are both directly connected to Satanism. The little “g” god of this world wants nothing more than to fill the hearts and in the minds of our children with... idolatry. And these idols that are on full display being splashed across the silver screen have not only been created to attract children, but adults as well. I cannot tell you how many people that I know that are full-grown adults, that are absolutely enamored, and attracted to these new futuristic man-made idols.

And of course, we could get into sports, and cheerleaders, and today’s modern-day gladiators, and today’s video music stars, that also become idols in the hearts and in the minds of many people today in our time.

But what we need to comprehend here, is that nothing has really changed. From even back in the days of Solomon, who was said to be the wisest man on earth, nothing has really changed. And as we contemplate what happened to Solomon who was the son of David, who could have originally been our Messiah... the Son of God... we need to stop and think. And we’ll come back to King Solomon who had the opportunity to be the Messiah of Israel in just a moment.

King Solomon who was the son of David, who could have been the Messiah of Israel to sit on David’s throne, threw it all away because of his idolatry, and because of his adultery. Knowing this, and understanding this, we should be well aware of what idolatry, and adultery costs. Both idolatry, and adultery transgress the law of Yahovah. Both idolatry and adultery are indeed classified as “*sin*” which is classified as “*the transgression of the law*” according to first John 3:4. And we also know that according to Romans chapter 6 verse 23, the wages of sin... the wages of transgressing the law... is... death.

Keeping all of this in mind, I want us to understand who it is that Solomon could have been, and why it is that Solomon could not fulfill the promise that Yahovah had made to David. Both idolatry, and adultery have everything to do with the fall of Solomon who was said to be the wisest man on the face of the earth. In order to understand the pitfalls of both idolatry, and adultery, we need to fully understand the genealogy of Solomon, and why it was that Solomon disqualified himself from being the original Messiah who is called the son of God. Let’s begin with **2nd Samuel 7:12-16 E1**

2Sa 7:12 When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom.

2Sa 7:13 He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.

2Sa 7:14 I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son. When he commits iniquity, I will discipline him with the rod of men, with the stripes of the sons of men,

2Sa 7:15 but my steadfast love will not depart from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I

put away from before you.

2Sa 7:16 And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.”

Clearly, beyond the shadow of a doubt, Yahovah, our Father in heaven had chosen David to sit upon the throne of Israel and I quote, “*forever*”. And I want us to clearly understand this promise that Yahovah had made to David. Knowing, and understanding that Yahovah himself had personally promised David that he would raise up David’s offspring after David... and that it would be David’s offspring, that would come from David’s very own body that would be established forever as King over Israel... it should be easily comprehensible by those who read their God breathed Scripture, that this man... who would come from the very loins of David, and the very body of David would call Yahovah his Father, and Yahovah would call him his Son. This my friends is exactly who our Messiah is. Once again, our Messiah is known as “*the son of David*” in the very first sentence of the New Testament.

And so, with this in mind, I’d like us to hear what David said to his son Solomon back in the beginning of the book. Let’s turn to **first Chronicles 22:7-13 E2**

1Ch 22:7 David said to Solomon, “My son, I had it in my heart to build a house to the name of the LORD my God.

1Ch 22:8 But the word of the LORD came to me, saying, ‘You have shed much blood and have waged great wars. You shall not build a house to my name, because you have shed so much blood before me on the earth.

1Ch 22:9 Behold, a son shall be born to you who shall be a man of rest. I will give him rest from all his surrounding enemies. For his name shall be Solomon, and I will give peace and quiet to Israel in his days.

1Ch 22:10 He shall build a house for my name. He shall be my son, and I will be his father, and I will establish his royal throne in Israel forever.’

1Ch 22:11 “Now, my son, the LORD be with you, so that you may succeed in building the house of the LORD your God, as he has spoken concerning you.

1Ch 22:12 Only, may the LORD grant you discretion and understanding, that when he gives you charge over Israel you may keep the law of the LORD your God.

1Ch 22:13 Then you will prosper if you are careful to observe the statutes and the rules that the LORD commanded Moses for Israel. Be strong and courageous. Fear not; do not be dismayed.

And so, we have David, here in first Chronicles chapter 22, telling us that Solomon could be the fulfillment of the promise that Yahovah had made to David. Solomon... who was a man... who was the son of David... could have been the one to fulfill the promise that Yahovah had made to David. Solomon... could have been the Messiah of Israel according to what Yahovah had told David his Father. But just as David had warned Solomon, it would only come to pass if... if... Solomon was careful to observe the statutes and the rules that Yahovah

commanded Moses for Israel.

Once again, we see that monstrously huge word “*if*”... in first Corinthians chapter 22 verse 13. According to David here in first Chronicles chapter 22 verse 10, Solomon would not only be the one to build a house for the name of Yahovah, but Solomon could have also been the one that Yahovah would call his son, and Solomon could have been the one that would have sat on David’s throne that Yahovah would establish over Israel forever if... if... Solomon was careful to observe the statutes and the rules that Yahovah had commanded Moses for Israel. And I want us to once again see this warning being made by David a little bit further down in the book of **first Chronicles 28:9 E3**

1Ch 28:9 “And you, Solomon my son, know the God of your father and serve him with a whole heart and with a willing mind, for the LORD searches all hearts and understands every plan and thought. If you seek him, he will be found by you, but if you forsake him, he will cast you off forever.

Notice here in first Chronicles chapter 28 verse nine, that David once again warns his son Solomon against forsaking Yahovah. David clearly tells his son Solomon here in first Chronicles chapter 28 verse nine that if Solomon forsakes Yahovah, Yahovah will cast him off forever. And of course... we know that it was through both idolatry, and adultery... that Solomon did indeed forsake Yahovah just as his Father David told him not to. **First Kings 11:9-13 E4**

1Ki 11:9 And the LORD was angry with Solomon, because his heart had turned away from the LORD, the God of Israel, who had appeared to him twice

1Ki 11:10 and had commanded him concerning this thing, that he should not go after other gods. But he did not keep what the LORD commanded.

1Ki 11:11 Therefore the LORD said to Solomon, “Since this has been your practice and you have not kept my covenant and my statutes that I have commanded you, I will surely tear the kingdom from you and will give it to your servant.


1Ki 11:12 Yet for the sake of David your father I will not do it in your days, but I will tear it out of the hand of your son.

1Ki 11:13 However, I will not tear away all the kingdom, but I will give one tribe to your son, for the sake of David my servant and for the sake of Jerusalem that I have chosen.”

If we take the time to read the first Kings chapter 11 from the beginning, we would see that King Solomon loved many foreign women along with the daughter of Pharaoh. Solomon, the son of David had joined himself with Moabite women, and Ammonite women, and Edomite women, and Sidonian women, and Hittite women from all the surrounding nations of the people after being told not to enter into marriage with them. First Kings chapter 11 verse three tells us that Solomon had 700 wives who were princesses, and 300 concubines. And it is written that his

wives were the ones who had turned away his heart from Yahovah.

And what is equally stunning to realize here in first Kings chapter 11, is that Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Sidonians who represents “*Easter*”, and the Roman Catholic created pagan Festival of “*Easter*”. (scrn 8)



Her name was Artemis in Ephesus, but it was Ashteroth in the Hebrew language, Astarte in the Phoenician language, Ishtar in the Akkadian language, Eostre in the Anglo-Saxon language, and Easter in the English language. And although she had many different names throughout history, the symbols of Artemis also known as “*Easter*” were always the same no matter what name she was known by. She was always depicted with... and known by... rabbits and eggs and she was often times depicted with bare breasts hence the goddess of fertility theme that she always carried with her throughout the ages.

Once again my friends, it is astounding... what you will find in the beginning of the book, when you read the book... from the beginning.

Solomon threw it all away because of his addiction to both idolatry, and adultery against Yahovah. Even though his father David told Solomon of the promise that Yahovah had made to David, Solomon was so addicted to idolatry because of the hundreds of pagan women that he had joined himself to as his wives, that he simply could not break free from the sins of idolatry and adultery against Yahovah. Once again **1st Chronicles 22:9-10 (scrn 9)**

1Ch 22:9 Behold, a son shall be born to you who shall be a man of rest. I will give him rest from all his surrounding enemies. For his name shall be Solomon, and I will give peace and quiet to Israel in his days.

1Ch 22:10 He shall build a house for my name. He shall be my son, and I will be his father, and I will establish his royal throne in Israel forever.?



Solomon could have been the Messiah of Israel. Solomon could've been the son of David that would have sat in David's throne forever, but Solomon was overrun with idolatry because of the women that he idolized.

The disqualification of Solomon that we read about in first Kings chapter 11 is absolutely heartbreaking when we take into consideration exactly what it was that Solomon the wisest man on the face of the earth at that time... threw a way.

But what is even more heartbreaking, is the fact that Solomon was said to be the wisest man on the face of the earth! **First Kings 4:29-30 (E10)**

1Ki 4:29 And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding beyond measure, and breadth of mind like the sand on the seashore,

1Ki 4:30 so that Solomon's wisdom surpassed the wisdom of all the people of the east and all the wisdom of Egypt.



Knowing, and understanding that Solomon was indeed the wisest man on earth at that time, and knowing and understanding that Solomon did indeed love Yahovah in the beginning... and knowing and understanding that Solomon still managed to be led astray by our adversary... should speak volumes to today's modern-day Christian in our time.

If the wisest man in the world could be so easily led astray... and if what David tells us in first Chronicles chapter 28 verse nine is true, and that Yahovah did indeed cast Solomon off forever because of his idolatry... what does that say about our idolatry today?

And I want us to fully understand that this is not the first time that this had happened. This is exactly why Saul was rejected from being the King of Israel. Listen to what Samuel told Saul who was the first King of the house of Israel in **1st Samuel 15:23 (scrn 11)**

1Sa 15:23 For rebellion is as the sin of divination (witchcraft “qesem”), and presumption is as iniquity (wickedness) and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the LORD, he has also rejected you from being king.”



Once again, Saul had forsaken the word of Yahovah when Yahovah had commanded Saul to go in and to strike the Amalekites and to devote to destruction all that they had. Yahovah had commanded Saul not to spare any of them but to kill both man and woman and child and infant and ox in sheep and camel and donkey. And yet, Saul returned with the sheep and the oxen and the fatted calves and the lambs of the Amalekites instead of putting them to death as he was commanded by Yahovah.

And even though Saul brought these animals back to sacrifice to Yahovah... his presumption was seen as idolatry. When Yahovah gives us explicit instructions, it would behoove us to execute those explicit instructions. And so it was, that Yahovah had chosen David to surpass Saul and to become the King of the house of Israel whose throne would indeed last forever through his offspring who is Yeshua Hamashiach.

And it is also tectonically important for us to understand that even though Solomon could not fulfill the promise that Yahovah had made to David because of Solomon's idolatry... Yahovah still... miraculously found a way to take from the body of David, and to join the body of David inside the womb of Mary a virgin woman 14 generations later... in order to create the offspring of David who would indeed set upon the throne of David in a kingdom, and upon a throne that Yahovah would establish and I quote, “*forever*”.

How astounding, how majestic, how overwhelming is the knowledge and the power and the Majesty of the one true Most High Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob who is... our Father. And how reassuring is it to know that when Yahovah speaks something... it is indeed irrevocable. Just as the apostle Paul tells us in the 11th chapter of the book of Romans, “*the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable*”.


Idolatry... it is indeed the devil's favorite sin. Idolatry in of itself encapsulates covetousness, vanity, pride, greed, and yes... adultery. Idolatry can be designated as anything that comes in between us and our Father in heaven and his only begotten Son who sits on the throne of David his faithful servant.

Idolatry encapsulates much more than we think it does. Idolatry extends into today's fallen Babylonian world like an ancient prostitute whose alluring image was strong enough to bring down the wisest man on the face of the earth. And that ancient prostitute is alive and well today in our time, and she thrives within our culture and within our society today.

Let us love, and let us honor our mothers and our fathers as it is written, but let us not idolize anyone or anything other than our Father in heaven and his only begotten Son that he sent into the world from the loins of David to sit on the throne of David. For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Yeshua Hamashiach who gave himself as a ransom once, and for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time.


And for those of you who are still stuck in the Roman Catholic created three in one pagan Trinity God doctrine of demons... I would once again encourage you to stop listening to those educated by the wisdom of men, and to start listening to your own God breathed Scripture.

We are clearly told within the confines of our Scripture that God is not a man. **(scrn 12)**



Yahovah has presented himself in the form of a burning Bush, he has presented himself as a cloud, he has presented himself as a man, he has presented himself as the wind that parted the

seas to drown the armies of the Pharaoh of Egypt. But this does not mean that God is a Bush, or that God is a cloud, or that God is a man. God is spirit. And those who worship him must worship him in both spirit and in truth.



And if you are not worshipping him in both spirit and in truth, then you are not worshipping him. Today’s Baptist preachers who are indeed the daughters of Catholicism continue to preach that the creator of the heavens and the earth has turned himself into a man and came down from heaven and hung himself on a cross and became sin.

My friends this is nothing short of the blasphemy. Yahovah the creator of the heavens and the earth is not a man, and cannot become sin. And it **is not** our Father in heaven’s responsibility to sacrifice himself for the sins of mankind. Yahovah did not sin against himself. Man sinned against Yahovah. It is the responsibility of mankind to sacrifice himself for the sins of mankind. And this is exactly why he who knew no sin, became sin in order to become our Passover Lamb, the propitiation for the sins for all of mankind in the eyes of his Father.

When people talk of a Roman rooted Catholic Trinity, they are talking of blasphemy against Yahovah who cannot know sin, or even be close to sin let alone become sin. Any sin that approaches Yahovah is immediately destroyed. It is because mankind sinned against Yahovah, that mankind owed a debt of ransom. The reconciliation between man and God can only come through the sacrifice of man. Not says I, but says our God breathed Scripture. **First Timothy 2:5-6 (scrn 14)**

1Ti 2:5 For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,

1Ti 2:6 who gave himself as a ransom for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time.



If Yeshua Hamashiach is not the son of God as he said that he was in John chapter 10 verse 36, then Yeshua Hamashiach is a liar and the whole Bible is worth nothing. If Yeshua Hamashiach is not the son of God as God said that he was in second Samuel chapter 7 verse 14 of the Old Testament, and again in Matthew chapter 3 verse 17, and again in the book of Luke chapter 3 verse 22, and again in Matthew chapter 17 verse five of the New Testament, then God is a liar and the whole Bible is worth nothing.


For today's newfound denominational Gentile country clubs to proclaim that Yeshua Hamashiach is not the son of God... is to say that both Yeshua Hamashiach and God himself are both liars and the Bible then becomes nothing. The very word of God becomes nothing. And this my friends is exactly why the preach and teach the demonically inspired Roman Catholic created pagan Trinity doctrine.

Idolatry, and adultery is exactly what these men are committing to when they proclaim that the Son of God is no longer the Son of God. And there is much more to be said about this topic than we have time for here this morning, but let it be known, and let it be put in your hearing that our God is one God. Although there are many gods that can be found throughout the Bible, there is only one Most High God. There is only one Most High El Elyon.

The spirit of Yahovah entered into Yeshua Hamashiach who was, is, and always will be the offspring of David who sits on David's throne. And yes, Yeshua and his Father are one just as we and our Father are one in spirit. And Yahovah did many miracles through the man Yeshua Hamashiach the offspring of David. And just as the spirit of Yahovah enters into each one of us

to shape us, and to mold us, and to lead us, and to guide us into the light... his spirit also entered into his only begotten Son, the offspring of David in order to shape him, and to mold him, and to lead him to be our Passover Lamb. And this is exactly why it is written that David would never lack **a man** to sit on the throne of David. **Jeremiah 33:15-18 (scrn 15)**



Thus says the word of Yahovah. Let God be true... and every man... a liar.

Idolatry... Is indeed the Devils favorite sin. False doctrine is also... idolatry. When we continue to search in order to find someone else to agree with our false doctrine so that we can feel vindicated... we are indeed engaged in idolatry.

I need no other man, I need no other writing, I need no other proof, I need no Rabbi, no early church Father, no Bible commentator, no Council of men, to know and to understand what my Father has written directly to me through his God breathed Scripture. And it is his discernment that was given to me by him that leads me into all truth. The very Ruach Hokadesh that our Messiah said that he would leave us to teach us all things.

Knowing and understanding the truth of Yah's word is not about searching for other people to vindicate our false doctrines. Knowing and understanding the truth of Yah's word is about reading God's word for ourselves and asking him for the proper understanding and discernment to understand Yah's word. We do not need the writings of rabbinical Judaism's Babylonian Rabbis, or the writings of Christiandoms so-called "*early church fathers*", or their councils of men to teach us the word of Yahovah. All we need is the Ruach Hokadesh of Yahovah who is the only one who has been sent to teach us all things and to remind us of what our Messiah has said. Not says I, but says the red-letter words of our very own Messiah in **John 14:26 (scrn 16)**

Joh 14:26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.



Idolatry is once again anything that comes between us and the truth of Yahovah's spoken word. Idolatry is not confined to a carved image. Idolatry is not confined to a graven image. Idolatry is anyone... or anything... or any doctrine... or any philosophy... or any theology... or any church dogma that comes between us and the truth. And the truth is not given to us by Babylonian rabbis, or early church fathers... the truth is given to us through the Ruach Hokadesh of the one true Most High El Elyon of Israel.

Of making many books there is no end, and much study is a weariness of the flesh. But the end of the matter is that all has been heard. Fear God and keep **his** commandments, for this is indeed the whole duty of man.

Just as we have already seen, Solomon could have qualified as the Messiah of Israel. The very reason that Solomon did not qualify as the Messiah of Israel is because of his addiction to idolatry, and adultery against the Most High Elohim of Israel. And so it was, that the Most High Elohim of Israel chose another. And so it was, that the house of Israel had to wait another 14 generations before another offspring of David would finally be brought forth from the body of David through a virgin woman 14 generations later. Once again, the gifts and the calling of Yahovah are indeed irrevocable.

And with that being said, I would once again as we always do like to ask that everyone within the sound of my voice would please, please take what you have heard here today to your own prayer closet. Bow your head, and bend your knee, and face the holy promise land of Jerusalem, and ask in the name of Yeshua Hamashiach if what you have heard here today be true, or not.

Ask, seek, and knock on his door, and on his door alone, and the door will be opened to you. And if you will do that, and if you will stay the course to the end, you and I will surely walk through the Gates of his soon coming kingdom together.
