The Fire of God

Once again, I just want to thank everyone for joining us this morning on our Father's seventh day Sabbath as we venture into an extremely eye-opening topic concerning the fire of God and how fire pertains to... and often times even represents God our Father in real time and how he often times uses fire both in the natural and in spiritual ways to make known his very name and his presence and his power.

It is written that the fear of God is the beginning of wisdom. It is written in Psalms 112 verse one that blessed is the man who fears Yehovah, who greatly delights in his commandments. And again, in Psalms 115 verse 13 we're told that he will bless those who fear him the small together with the great. And again, in Proverbs chapter 10 verse 27 it is written that it is the fear of Yehvoah that prolongs life, but the years of the wicked will be shortened. Here is what is written in the book of Malachi about those who fear Yehvoah God. **Malachi 3:16-17 (scrn 1)**

Those Who Fear Yehaovh...

Mal 3:16 Then those who feared the LORD spoke with one another. The LORD paid attention and heard them, and a book of remembrance was written before him of those who feared the LORD and esteemed his name.

Mal 3:17 "They shall be mine, says the LORD of hosts, in the day when I make up my treasured possession, and I will spare them as a man spares his son who serves him. Mal 3:18 Then once more you shall see the distinction between the righteous and the wicked, between one who serves God and one who does not serve him.



I have heard ignorant people proclaim that they could never fear God because God is love and love is God and God loves everyone and therefore there is no need to fear God. But once again my friends this is nothing but the mind of the Devil himself who seeks to kill and to destroy the spoken word of God. It is written Jacob I loved... but Essau I hated. Those who do not fear God do not know God and should not be listened to nor should they be given credence or be aloud to teach.

And so it is... that the reward of humility and the fear of Yehvoah are indeed riches, and honor and life according to Proverbs chapter 22 verse 4. And these are things that we should always remember and never forget. God is not our buddy... God is our Father who is the creator of the heavens and the earth, and he holds the power of both blessings and curses... life and death. He is our shield and our buckler and our length of days. And he often times uses "fire"... to not only appear to his people and to identify himself as God... but he also uses fire to also get his point across.

Let's begin our study this morning by turning to Exodus 3:1-5 (scrn 2)

The Burning Bush

Exo 3:1 Now Moses was keeping the flock of his father-in-law, Jethro, the priest of Midian, and he led his flock to the west side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God.

Exo 3:2 And the angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush. He looked, and behold, the bush was burning, yet it was not consumed. Exo 3:3 And Moses said, "I will turn aside to see this great sight, why the bush is not burned."

Exo 3:4 When the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called to him out of the bush, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am."

Exo 3:5 Then he said, "Do not come near; take your sandals off your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground."



Clearly here in the beginning of our Bibles we see our Father in heaven presenting himself as a flame of fire to Moses as he introduces himself to Moses and gives Moses his instructions. But this is not the only time that our Father in heaven presents himself as fire.

When our Father in heaven came down from the top of Mount Sinai to present himself to his chosen set apart people in order to give them his testimony, he also presented himself as a flame

The Fire of God Presents His Testimony...

Exo 19:16 On the morning of the third day there were thunders and lightnings and a thick cloud on the mountain and a very loud trumpet blast, so that all the people in the camp trembled.

Exo 19:17 Then Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet God, and they took their stand at the foot of the mountain.

Exo 19:18 Now Mount Sinai was wrapped in smoke because the LORD had descended on it in fire. The smoke of it went up like the smoke of a kiln, and the whole mountain trembled greatly.

Exo 19:19 And as the sound of the trumpet grew louder and louder, Moses spoke, and God answered him in thunder.



Once again... we see the presence of God himself in the form of a flame of fire. And so, it should be evident to us that our Father in heaven almost always presents himself as a flame of fire to his chosen set apart people, but that's not all he does with fire. Yehovah God our Father also uses fire to make it known who he is. Fire... in of itself has always been from the beginning the calling card if you will of our Father in heaven. Think about it for just a moment... how did God identify himself to the house of Israel who were worshiping the false god Baal? Let's turn to 1st Kings 18:20-40 E1

The Prophets of Baal Defeated

1Ki 18:20 So Ahab sent to all the people of Israel and gathered the prophets together at Mount Carmel.

1Ki 18:21 And Elijah came near to all the people and said, "How long will you go limping between two different opinions? If the LORD is God, follow him; but if Baal, then follow him." And the people did not answer him a word.

1Ki 18:22 Then Elijah said to the people, "I, even I only, am left a prophet of the LORD, but Baal's prophets are 450 men.

1Ki 18:23 Let two bulls be given to us, and let them choose one bull for themselves and cut it in pieces and lay it on the wood, but put no fire to it. And I will prepare the other bull and lay it on the wood and put no fire to it.

1Ki 18:24 And you call upon the name of your god, and I will call upon the name of the LORD, and the God who answers by fire, he is God." And all the people answered, "It is

well spoken."

1Ki 18:25 Then Elijah said to the prophets of Baal, "Choose for yourselves one bull and prepare it first, for you are many, and call upon the name of your god, but put no fire to it."

1Ki 18:26 And they took the bull that was given them, and they prepared it and called upon the name of Baal from morning until noon, saying, "O Baal, answer us!" But there was no voice, and no one answered. And they limped around the altar that they had made.

1Ki 18:27 And at noon Elijah mocked them, saying, "Cry aloud, for he is a god. Either he is musing, or he is relieving himself, or he is on a journey, or perhaps he is asleep and must be awakened."

1Ki 18:28 And they cried aloud and cut themselves after their custom with swords and lances, until the blood gushed out upon them.

1Ki 18:29 And as midday passed, they raved on until the time of the offering of the oblation, but there was no voice. No one answered; no one paid attention.

1Ki 18:30 Then Elijah said to all the people, "Come near to me." And all the people came near to him. And he repaired the altar of the LORD that had been thrown down.

1Ki 18:31 Elijah took twelve stones, according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob, to whom the word of the LORD came, saying, "Israel shall be your name,"

1Ki 18:32 and with the stones he built an altar in the name of the LORD. And he made a trench about the altar, as great as would contain two seahs of seed.

1Ki 18:33 And he put the wood in order and cut the bull in pieces and laid it on the wood. And he said, "Fill four jars with water and pour it on the burnt offering and on the wood."

1Ki 18:34 And he said, "Do it a second time." And they did it a second time. And he said, "Do it a third time." And they did it a third time.

1Ki 18:35 And the water ran around the altar and filled the trench also with water.

1Ki 18:36 And at the time of the offering of the oblation, Elijah the prophet came near and said, "O LORD, God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, let it be known this day that you are God in Israel, and that I am your servant, and that I have done all these things at your word.

1Ki 18:37 Answer me, O LORD, answer me, that this people may know that you, O LORD, are God, and that you have turned their hearts back."

1Ki 18:38 Then the fire of the LORD fell and consumed the burnt offering and the wood and the stones and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench.

1Ki 18:39 And when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces and said, "The LORD, he is God."

1Ki 18:40 And Elijah said to them, "Seize the prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape." And they seized them. And Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon and slaughtered them there.

Lev 9:22 Then Aaron lifted up his hands toward the people and blessed them, and he came down from offering the sin offering and the burnt offering and the peace offerings.

Lev 9:23 And Moses and Aaron went into the tent of meeting, and when they came out they blessed the people, and the glory of the LORD appeared to all the people. Lev 9:24 And fire came out from before the LORD and consumed the burnt offering and the pieces of fat on the altar, and when all the people saw it, they shouted and fell on their faces.

Once again, our Father in heaven used fire as his calling card to prove to the House of Israel that he was indeed the one true Elohim of Israel and that there were no other gods before him.

Fire has been Yehvoah God's calling card from the very beginning, and it is this fire that he always uses in order to not only identify himself... but to also get his point across. When Aaron was ordained as High Priest over Israel, God once again used "fire" just like he did in Elijah's battle against the priests of Baal. Let's turn to Leviticus 9:22-24 (scrn 4)

Yehovah Uses Fire To SpeakHis Will...

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Here in the ninth chapter of the book of Leviticus Yehovah God once again uses fire to let the people know that he has not only accepted Aaron as the High Priest of Israel... but that he has also personally chosen Aaron as the High Priest of Israel. And so, Yehvoah God uses fire to represent his glory and his majesty and his power time and time again all throughout our God breathed Scriptures and this is important to understand. The Spirit of God is always represented by and through "fire". And just as Aaron was sanctified and ordained through the fire of God... Aaron's sons were also taken away through the "fire" of God because they had brought strange and unauthorized fire before Yehvoah in the very next chapter of the book of Leviticus in **Leviticus chapter 10:1-4 (scrn 5)**

When We Bring Strange Fire Before Yehaovh

Lev 10:1 Now Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, each took his censerand put fire in it and laid incense on it and offered unauthorized fire before the LORD, which he had not commanded them. Lev 10:2 And fire came out from before the LORD and consumed them, and they died before the LORD. Lev 10:3 Then Moses said to Aaron, "This is what the LORD has said: 'Among those who are near me I will be sanctified, and before all the people I will be glorified.'" And Aaron held his peace. Lev 10:4 And Moses called Mishael and Elzaphan, the sons of Uzziel the uncle of Aaron, and said to them, "Come near; carry your brothers away from the front of the sanctuary and out of the camp."



Just as Yehovah God had already told his set apart people... Yehovah is to be sanctified by his children and his is to be glorified by them. You do not sanctify and glorify your Father with strange fire. Presenting another fire before God is like presenting another god before him because once again... it is "fire that Yehvoah uses to not only present himself to his people but to also show his power and majesty and his glory and his judgment.

Knowing this and understanding this... it should be of no surprise how the second beast of Revelation will use fire to deceive those who dwell on the earth. Let's turn to **Revelation 13:11-14 (scrn 6)**

The Second Beast Imitates God With Fire...

Rev 13:11 Then I saw another beast rising out of the earth. It had two horns like a lamb and it spoke like a dragon.

Rev 13:12 It exercises all the authority of the first beast in its presence, and makes the earth and its inhabitants worship the first beast, whose mortal wound was healed.

Rev 13:13 It performs great signs, even making fire come down from heaven to earth in front of people,

Rev 13:14 and by the signs that it is allowed to work in the presence of the beast it deceives those who dwell on earth, telling them to make an image for the beast that was wounded by the sword and yet lived.

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It is because our Father in heaven uses "fire" that the beast will also use "fire" in an attempt to imitate the one true El-elyon of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. And it is fire that will be used to deceive, if possible, even the very elect of God if they are not well grounded in the word of God.

Billions of people around the globe will be in awe of the ability of the beast to cause fire to come down out of the heavens. But who is this second beast? This beast that has two horns like a lamb and yet speaks like a dragon?

As we have already shown... the second beast is the great United States of America who was raised up from the earth. The two horns representing both "church" and "state" that will once again be welded into one bringing back the dark ages in full force so that... it will be the man of perdition that will sit in the Temple of God proclaiming himself to be God as the world bows down and receives its mark by obeying and giving homage to another false god. They will believe in their foreheads and therefore do with their hands all that they are commanded to do by the beast and this is why it is written in the book of Daniel that the saints themselves will be handed over to the beast! **Daniel 7:25 (scrn 7)**

<u>The Deception of Fire From Heaven</u> Causes The Beast To Rule The Saints...

Dan 7:25 He shall speak words against the Most High, and shall wear out the saints of the Most High, and shall think to change the times and the law, and they shall be given into his hand for a time, times, and half a time.



God's signature calling card... "fire"... will be used by the Devil himself to once again dress himself up as an angel of light in order to emulate and impersonate the one true Elohim of Israel. And it will be through this "strange fire" that many will be deceived. But today in our time we should not be surprised concerning these things. Is the beast with the two horns not right now beginning to speak like a dragon against God? Has the beast with two horns not kicked the God of Israel out of its schools and out of its halls of justice? Is the beast with two horns not right now shaking its fist in the face of God by redefining marriage and marrying women with women and men with men? Is the beast with two horns not willfully and intentionally murdering unborn children in the wombs of their mothers each and every day, day after day? Is the beast with two horns not now teaching the 1st day of the week Sunday Sabbath of the Pope of Rome instead of teaching the only seventh day Sabbath of the God of Israel? And is the beast with the two horns not already developing the deception of fire... coming down from heavens? (Go To Website)



From hummingbirds that zip about in all directions to bats that veer sharply to nab flies in midair and land upside down to hang from cave ceilings, the world is filled with extraordinary flying animals.

These tiny aviators are more agile than any aircraft — but that may be about to change. Inspired by the aerial abilities of birds, bats and insects, researchers are crafting a new generation of ultralight drones that lack propellers and are equipped not with fixed wings but with flapping ones.

One day, these tiny flying machines may be flitting unobtrusively over the landscape, collecting weather data, monitoring traffic, <u>alerting first responders to accidents and disasters</u>, inspecting construction sites and more. Farmers could use them to pollinate crops and <u>law enforcement agencies could use them for search and rescue and to conduct surveillance</u>.

There is no end to how the Devil will encourage man to imitate God the same way that he dresses himself up as an angel of light in order to imitate God. We are now living in an age where man has at his disposal all of the necessary tools that he needs to dress himself up as an angel of light in order to imitate God and by the way... just who is it that has given man these high technology tools? (scrn 8)



Once again, it is the Devil's will that man would follow him and not the Elohim of Israel. And just as he lured both Adam and Eve into taking from God what did not belong to them... that same serpent is now today in our time luring man to once again lust after becoming and I quote... "like God".

And so, "fire" that is so often times used as the very signature of God, and used to signify his power and his strength and his glory is exactly what his adversary will use in order to once again emulate and impersonate God in order to fool if possible... even the very elect.

The word "fire" in the Bible is often times used in more that one way. Just like the word "LORD" in the Bible has a double meaning, so too does the word "fire". The word "fire" is used in the Bible 465 times within 424 verses, and it can be used to demonstrate a normal "fire" like the fire that is seen in Exodus chapter 29 where it is written that the flesh of the bull and it's skin and its dung you shall burn with "fire" outside the camp. But there is also a more importantly used understanding of the word "fire" that conveys a spiritual meaning and understanding. For example... did you know that our Messiah told us that he came to cast "fire" upon the earth? Let's turn to Luke 12:49-53 (scrn 9)

I Came To Cast "Fire" Upon The Earth!

Luk 12:49 "I came to cast fire on the earth, and would that it were already kindled!

Luk 12:50 I have a baptism to be baptized with, and how great is my distress until it is accomplished!

Luk 12:51 Do you think that I have come to give peace on earth? No, I tell you, but rather division.

Luk 12:52 For from now on in one house there will be five divided, three against two and two against three.

Luk 12:53 They will be divided, father against son and son against father, mother against daughter and daughter against mother, mother-in-law against her daughter-in-law and daughter-in-law against mother-in-law."



What "fire" do you suppose that Yeshua has cast upon the earth? The "fire" that our Messiah has cast upon the earth is a fire for God his Father. The fire that he has cast upon the earth is a fire that burns within his chosen set apart people and this is the very reason that there will be division. There will be those with the fire of God... and those without the fire of God, those who have the eyes to see and the ears to hear... and those who do not have the eyes to see or the ears to hear. Why do you think there will be division? Why do you think that father will be against son and son against his father and mother against her daughter and daughter against her mother and mother-in-law against her daughter in law and daughter in law against her mother-in-law? Here's how Matthew puts it; Matthew 10:36-38 (scrn 10)

Fire For God vs The Lust of The World...

Mat 10:36 And a person's enemies will be those of his own household. Mat 10:37 Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. Mat 10:38 And whoever does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me.



Isn't it amazing how so many people will invest hundreds if not even thousands of dollars in knowing their earthly lineage and their fleshly family's history while thinking nothing of the family that they have been grafted into! For those who are impassioned by the world... they are so easily led astray by thinking that it's all about their fleshly families and their earthly flesh but what does the Bible say? What does our very own Messiah say? He says that a person's enemies will be those of his own household. In other words... if you love your mother or your father or your son or our daughter more than your Messiah... you are not worthy of him. Why?

Because it is not about your earthly family. The fire that Yeshua cast upon the earth will indeed separate us from our earthly fleshly families. It's about our spiritual family. Our earthly families will return to the dust of the earth, and those who do not have the fire of God that Yeshua cast upon the earth... will be destroyed. But the spiritual family that we have been grafted into will live on forever! Those who know the truth, and who understand the biblical definition of the love of God found in 1st John chapter 5 verse three.... those who fear God and thirst after his wisdom and his love... those who are chosen and set apart from the world are those who are our true brothers and sisters not those who are born of our flesh. **Romans 9:6-8 (scrn 11)**

Not The Children of The Flesh But of The Promise!

Rom 9:6 But it is not as though the word of God has failed. For not all who are descended from Israel belong to Israel,

Rom 9:7 and not all are children of Abraham because they are his offspring, but "Through Isaac shall your offspring be named."

Rom 9:8 This means that it is not the children of the flesh who are the children of God, but the children of the promise are counted as offspring.



It is this "fire" of God that our Messiah came to baptize us with! Listen closely to what John the Baptist had to say about our Messiah who came to baptize us with the Holy Spirit and "fire"; Matthew 3:11-12 (scrn 12)

The "Fire" of Faith vs. The "Fire" of Destruction ...

Mat 3:11 "I baptize you with water for repentance, but he who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

Mat 3:12 His winnowing fork is in his hand, and he will clear his threshing floor and gather his wheat into the barn, but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire."



The fire of God is indeed likened unto a two-edged sword. The fire of God is sharper than any two-edged sword piercing to the division of the soul and of the spirit of joints and marrow and discerning the thoughts and the intentions of the heart. And no creature is hidden from its sight, but all are naked and exposed the eyes of him to whom we must give an account.

We spoke in great detail this past Wednesday evening during our Wednesday night Bible study about the importance of being able to see patterns, types and shadows of things written within the Scripture but not evident to the normal reader. We spoke about the Tabernacle Menorah which was the lampstand that gave light within the holy place and we made note of the fact that the olive oil that fueled the Menorah with light came from olives that had not been pressed as they normally would be... but beaten. The olive oil that fueled the Tabernacle with light came from olives that were "**beaten**" just like our Messiah was beaten for our transgressions so that he could give light to the world.

And we read in Romans chapter 11 how the Apostle Paul points directly to our Messiah as being the Olive Tree that we are all grafted into and how it is that we as grafted in gentiles who are also seen as wild olive shoots should not be arrogant towards the branches who are the Jews and how it is that we do not support the root... but that it is the root that supports us if... if we continue in his kindness otherwise... we too will be cut off just like many of the unbelieving Jews were cut off along with their Pharisees who were the Pastors, Priests, Bishops and popish leaders of their time.

It is this Olive Oil that fuels the fire of God within us that is his very Holy Spirit that sets us on fire for him. I would like us to all take note of how it was that the Apostles received the Holy Spirt of God in Acts 2:1-4 (scrn 13)

The Fire of God Delivered!

Act 2:1 When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place. Act 2:2 And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting.

Act 2:3 And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them.

Act 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.

You see, the fire that Yehvoah God is... in the form of a Spirit... is the very same fire that he gives to each one of us to burn within our hearts just like the Menorah full of beaten olive oil that reminds us of how our Father loved us even when we were sinners, and how his only begotten Son the descendant of David who was a man after God's own heart also loved us even more than life itself. The very "fire" of Yehvoah God that we read about within his God breathed Scriptures represents the "fire" that he is, and when we have this fire that our Messiah baptizes us with... we do indeed become one with not only our Messiah who also has that very same fire... but we also become one with our Father in heaven just as our Messiah had asked him to do in John 17:15-26 E2

Joh 17:15 <mark>I do not ask that you take them out of the world</mark>, but that you keep them from the evil one.

Joh 17:16 They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.

Joh 17:17 Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth.

Joh 17:18 As you sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world.

Joh 17:19 And for their sake I consecrate myself, that they also <mark>may be sanctified in </mark> truth.

Joh 17:20 "I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word,

Joh 17:21 that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us<mark>, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.</mark>

Joh 17:22 The glory that you have given me I have given to them, <mark>that they may be</mark> one even as we are one<mark>,</mark>

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Joh 17:23 I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me. Joh 17:24 Father, I desire that they also, whom you have given me, may be with me where I am, to see my glory that you have given me because you loved me before the foundation of the world. Joh 17:25 O righteous Father, even though the world does not know you, I know you, and these know that you have sent me.

Joh 17:26 I made known to them your name, and I will continue to make it known, that the love with which you have loved me may be in them, and I in them."

This "fire" of God that comes directly from God is indeed given to us by his Ruach Hakodesh... his Holy Spirit is what causes us to be fueled with the beaten Olive Oil that fuels the light that we have each been given each and every day continuously! We have become one with our Father in haven, his only begotten Son, his Ruach Hakodesh, all the sons of God, his angels and messengers and all of his heavenly host who bow down at his feet and who also have willfully and intentionally accepted this very same fire burning deep within their very being. The Angel that John tried to bow down to in the 22nd chapter of the book of Revelation told John not to bow to him because he was a fellow servant with him and his brothers the prophets and with those who keep the words of this book, and the Angel tells John to worship God and only God as they do. This fire runs not only through the hearts of human believers, but this same fire also runs throughout his heavenly host as well. God is one because there is no other like him and yet... God is many. He is not just 3 or 7, or 50, or 70... Yehvoah God resides in billions if not trillions of his sons that he has created and his fire burns within all of us! Surely, we ought to be able to say just as our Messiah did that if you've seen me... you have seen my Father!

The fire of God although may be seen by some as allegorical and used as a metaphor is indeed a very real spiritual gift that the Ruach Hakodesh of God himself gives to us in order to fuel our obedience to him so that his commandments are no longer works that are a burden to us... but a labor of love that we do because we love him and because we want him to know that we know and understand all that he has done for us as his chosen set apart children.

In the end it is written that the world that we know today will end in a blaze of Yehovah's fire and will not only be destroyed... but replaced with a new earth and a new heaven that we read about at the end of the age clear at the back of the book in Revelation chapters 21 and 22.

What's important to understand is that the "fire" of God will indeed destroy the wicked and all things wicked and all remembrance of the wicked shall indeed perish. And this needs to happen because our God is indeed a just God and his enemies and the enemies of his children who have been given every opportunity to come... cannot live in peace with his chosen set apart children and therefore after being warned time and time and time again... he will indeed send his only begotten Son from the stump of Jesse Davids Father to once again do his will upon the earth and to kill the wicked. **Isaiah 11:1-4 (scrn 14)**

He Shall Kill The Wicked!

Isa 11:1 There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch from his roots shall bear fruit.

Isa 11:2 And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD.

Isa 11:3 And his delight shall be in the fear of the LORD. He shall not judge by what his eyes see, or decide disputes by what his ears hear,


Isa 11:4 but with righteousness he shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; and he shall strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips he shall kill the wicked.



As it is written, "It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God" and this is exactly what will happen to the wicked on that great and terrible day when the Lamb of God treads the winepress of his Father's wrath upon the earth. And yet this very same fire that will overcome the adversaries is the exact same fire that is good, and right and just that leads us all to everlasting life so that we can have not only everlasting life... but as our Messiah tells us... life more abundantly.

At times we have been allowed to see and even taste a small glimpse of that life during many of our gatherings together during our fellowships and during his appointed fest days and appointments when we are all gathered around in one place to honor and to give praise and glory to him. This abundant life when every man will sit under his own fig tree in peace when there will be no such thing as death and mourning nor crying nor pain for the former things will have passed away is the day that we are all waiting for, and I tell you the truth... that day is sooner now than when we first believed.

Our Messiah told the Assembly in Laodicea that because they were lukewarm and neither hot nor cold, he would spit them out his mouth. Being sort of on fire is not being on fire. Being sort of a Christian is not being a Christian. Being double minded is not of God but of the Devil his adversary. James 1:22-25 (scrn 15)



It is written that there is a way that seems right to a man, but it only leads to death, and it is also written that many will come to our Messiah calling him "Lord, Lord", and they will boast about how they have cast out demons in his name and how they have done all kinds of wonderful works in his name only to have him look at them and tell them that he never knew them... at which time he will command them to get away from him because they were and I quote... "lawless".

My hope and my prayer this day and every day is that all who are within the sound of my voice would willfully and intentionally open their hearts and their minds in surrender and receive the precious gift that our Father has given to us through our Messiah and King his only begotten Son the descendant of David so that we can all as one... be... on fire for him. Continuously hot, and continuously humble before him and continuously bold enough to speak his word in truth and in Spirit no matter the challenges of the day.

Let us renew our minds daily and audit our faith and get rid of the worldly nonsense that has crept into our faith. Let us sweep our houses and make straight our ways and shine the light from the fire that we've been given. Let us allow the Spirit of Yehvoah God to ignite the beaten Olive Oil that is within us continually each and every day and let us pray and give thanks and honor and glory to the one who has given us breath and life and a new heart of flesh.

Let us always and forever be one... all burning with the same beaten Olive Oil and of one mind and of one accord. Let us allow him to remove our transgressions from us so that we can attend the feasts and the appointments of our Father dressed in white with the confidence of knowing that our God is a just God, a generous God, a loving God, a powerful God, a forgiving God, a merciful God and that there are no other gods before him. He and he alone is the Most High Elohim of Israel and there are no other gods that are like the one true Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. And it is for this reason that he can create a new heaven and a new earth for his children to live in peace while once again walking amongst us as his children.

Join me this week in waking up each and every morning with the willful intent of being not just a hearer of the law... but a doer of the law. Join me this week in looking into the perfect law of liberty that we see in Psalms chapter 19 that frees us from the sins of this world and releases us from the bondage and darkness of transgression so that we can choose life for not only ourselves but for our children and for our children's children.

Join me as we bond together as one... seeking first the kingdom so that all things can be added unto us because we have the eyes to see and the ears to hear the truth of our Father's word and we have willfully and intentionally chosen to accept his free gift of salvation because it is good, and right, and just to not only hear his word... but to do his word.

Join me as we run the race together with our eyes set on the prize that leads to life without curses and without death and without mourning or crying or pain anymore. Join me as together we dress for battle and press onward into the fight against the rulers, and against the authorities and against the cosmic powers over this present darkness and against the spiritual forces of evil in heavenly places.

And above all... be sure to join us all as we go into our prayer closets to bow our heads and bend our knees and face the holy promised land of Jerusalem and ask in the name of Yeshua Hamashiach if what we have heard here this morning be true... or not.

Ask, seek, and knock on his, door and his door alone and the proper door will be opened to you. And if you will do that, and if you will stay the course to the end... and if you will stay hot and on fire for Yehovah God our Father... you and I will surely walk through the gates of his soon coming kingdom together.
