

Numbers Chapter 14 The Unpardonable Sin!



Last week as we examined the 13th chapter of the book of Numbers, we ran into the stark realization of good versus evil being manifested between the literal offspring of the serpent himself and the offspring of the human woman spoken of back in genesis chapter 3 verse 15.


And once again, the very topic of giants found within the pages of our bibles and the fallen angels who brought these giants to the earth is indeed a biblical concept that both the house of Israel in Moses day and the Apostles in our Messiah's time we're not only well aware of, but were also well-grounded in.

The word "giants" (which comes from the Hebrew word "nephil") in the English language is found over 13 times in our English translated King James version Of the Bible. (scrn 2)



But there are also other words in the Bible that also mean "giants" and many of these words are overlooked within our English translated bibles. For example the word "Rephaim" in the Bible also alludes to giants or tribes of giants.

In fact... Naves Topical Index gives us seven different references that all pertain to the English word "giants". Here's what Smith's Bible Dictionary has to say about other names that represent "giants"; (scrn 4)

Giants

men of extraordinary size or height.

- They are first spoken of in (<u>Genesis 6:4</u>) under the name Nephilim. We are told in (<u>Genesis 6:1-4</u>) that "there were Nephilim in the earth," and that afterwards the "sons of God" mingling with the beautiful "daughters of mens produced a race of violent and insolent *Gibborim* (Authorized Version "mighty men").
- 2. The Rephalim, a name which frequently occurs. The earliest mention of them is the record of their defeat by Chedorlaomer and some allied kings at Ashteroth Karnaim. The "valley of Rephaim," (<u>2 Samuel 5:18</u>; <u>1 Chronicles 11:15</u>; <u>Isaiah 17:5</u>) a rich valley southwest of Jerusalem, derived its name from them. They were probably an aboriginal people of which the EMIM, ANAKIM and ZUZIM, THE [which see] were branches. [also GOLIATH]

And this once again is nothing more than just the tip of the iceberg when it comes to what are known as giants within the confines of our God breathed scripture. In fact, there is so much to know about these Nephilim giants and their Rafaim, that I dare say we could do a whole documentary just on this one topic alone that would last for hours upon hours and still barely scratch the surface of what not only the Bible itself says about these giants... but also what history itself shows us about these biblical giants. And so, the point is not to argue whether or not giants existed within the confines of our Bibles. That fact he's already been substantiated and clarified through both the Bible itself and our history books not to mention archaeological finds that have been found up until the 18th century when the Smithsonian institute was given power by the United states Congress to subvert and yes, even destroy this evidence... along with the Roman Catholic Church herself. It has long been part of our documented history that much of the evidence that was found of these biblical giants all across the United states and the world at large up until the 1800s has been destroyed by Roman Catholicism and her Jesewit army.

Once again, it is indeed the Roman Catholic Church that does not want anyone to know that the Bible is true and just in what it proclaims. Darwin's theory of evolution is far more important to the Roman Catholic Church and the Smithsonian institute than the truth of the Bible. But I would submit to you my friends that it is extremely difficult to erase all of man's history even for those who wield the power and authority of Rome. And I would also submit to you that the Roman Catholic Church along with the Smithsonian institute have done a horrendous job in trying to cover this archaeological evidence up. Even though she has thought to change the times and the law of God himself to the best of her devilish ability... the archaeological evidence of the Bible is plane for all to see who are willing to open their eyes and look for it.

We have the Bible that tells us that there were giants in those days, we have Bible dictionaries that tell us that there were giants in those days, we have study bibles that tell us that there were giants back in those days, we have archaeological

evidence and even pictures that tell us that there were giants back in those days and yet the church today by and large will point directly to these fallen angels in the book of Jude as being non-existent along with the giants that they produced because once again... it is their understanding that the wisdom of men and their denominational charters of men are superior to the truth of our God breathed scripture and Yehvoah God himself who clearly proclaims to us... that there were indeed giants in those days and afterward... within the confines of his God breathed scripture.

Once again my friends... Ignorance prevails. And those who willfully and intentionally deny the truth given to us within the confines of our God breathed scripture once again walk aimlessly in the dark. And exactly what our Messiah tells us in Matthew chapter 13 is indeed the case for those who reject the truth. Just as our Messiah tells us, "they will indeed hear but never understand, and they will indeed see... but never perceive. For this people's heart has grown dull, and with their ears they can barely hear, and with their eyes they have closed." What a shame.

But what is important concerning our study into the book of Numbers, is that we understand that the co-mingling of the sons of God who were indeed the fallen angels that we read about in the book of Jude, (that is once again directly quoting from the book of Enoch)... we're leading God's people away from him in more ways than just one.

You see, it wasn't just the fact that the House of Israel and its leaders were afraid of these giants because of their size. It was the fact that the fear that these giants struck the house of Israel with... was causing them to disobey God's commandment.

The fear that these giants struck into the hearts of the leaders of the House of Israel and the people of the House of Israel was being used as a tool that our adversary was skillfully welding in order to lead the House of Israel away from Yehvoah God. And it was this tool of fear that was just about to destroy all of those who had allowed that fear to come before their love of the Elohim of Israel. And this should be a lesson for all of us to learn from!

It is clearly written that God does not give us a spirit of fear. The only thing in the Bible that we are told to fear is God himself. It is clearly written that we are not to fear what man can do to the body, but what God can do to both body and soul by

casting them into the pit. And therefore... this fear that had gripped the House of Israel was indeed a stumbling stone that caused the House of Israel to stumble. And it was because of this fear that the majority of the House of Israel standing there that day before Moses would never see the promised land.

With that being said, before we get too far ahead of ourselves here this evening, let's take the time to read Numbers chapter 14 so that we can know exactly what it says and just as importantly... what it does not say **Numbers 14 E1;**

The People Rebel

Num 14:1 Then all the congregation raised a loud cry, and the people wept that night. Num 14:2 And all the people of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron. The whole congregation said to them, "Would that we had died in the land of Egypt! Or would that we had died in this wilderness!

Num 14:3 Why is the LORD bringing us into this land, to fall by the sword? Our wives and our little ones will become a prey. Would it not be better for us to go back to Egypt?"

Num 14:4 And they said to one another, "Let us choose a leader and go back to Egypt."

Num 14:5 Then Moses and Aaron fell on their faces before all the assembly of the congregation of the people of Israel.

Num 14:6 And Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, who were among those who had spied out the land, tore their clothes

Num 14:7 and said to all the congregation of the people of Israel, "The land, which we passed through to spy it out, is an exceedingly good land.

Num 14:8 If the LORD delights in us, he will bring us into this land and give it to us, a land that flows with milk and honey.

Num 14:9 Only do not rebel against the LORD. And do not fear the people of the land, for they are bread for us. Their protection is removed from them, and the LORD is with us; do not fear them."

Num 14:10 Then all the congregation said to stone them with stones. But the glory of the LORD appeared at the tent of meeting to all the people of Israel.

Num 14:11 And the LORD said to Moses, "How long will this people despise me? And how long will they not believe in me, in spite of all the signs that I have done among them?

Num 14:12 I will strike them with the pestilence and disinherit them, <mark>and I will make of</mark> you a nation greater and mightier than they."

Moses Intercedes for the People

Num 14:13 But Moses said to the LORD, "Then the Egyptians will hear of it, for you brought up this people in your might from among them,

Num 14:14 and they will tell the inhabitants of this land. They have heard that you, O

LORD, are in the midst of this people. For you, O LORD, are seen face to face, and your cloud stands over them and you go before them, in a pillar of cloud by day and in a pillar of fire by night.

Num 14:15 Now if you kill this people as one man, then the nations who have heard your fame will say,

Num 14:16 `It is because the LORD was not able to bring this people into the land that he swore to give to them that he has killed them in the wilderness.'

Num 14:17 And now, please let the power of the Lord be great as you have promised, saying,

Num 14:18 `The LORD is slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love, forgiving iniquity and transgression, but he will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, to the third and the fourth generation.'

Num 14:19 Please pardon the iniquity of this people, according to the greatness of your steadfast love, just as you have forgiven this people, from Egypt until now."

God Promises Judgment

Num 14:20 Then the LORD said, "I have pardoned, according to your word.

Num 14:21 But truly, as I live, and as all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the LORD,

Num 14:22 none of the men who have seen my glory and my signs that I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and yet have put me to the test these ten times and have not obeyed my voice,

Num 14:23 shall see the land that I swore to give to their fathers. And none of those who despised me shall see it.

Num 14:24 But my servant Caleb, because he has a different spirit and has followed me fully, I will bring into the land into which he went, and his descendants shall possess it.

Num 14:25 Now, since the Amalekites and the Canaanites dwell in the valleys, turn tomorrow and set out for the wilderness by the way to the Red Sea."

Num 14:26 And the LORD spoke to Moses and to Aaron, saying,

Num 14:27 "How long shall this wicked congregation grumble against me? I have heard the grumblings of the people of Israel, which they grumble against me.

Num 14:28 Say to them, 'As I live, declares the LORD, what you have said in my hearing I will do to you:

Num 14:29 your dead bodies shall fall in this wilderness, and of all your number, listed in the census from twenty years old and upward, who have grumbled against me,

Num 14:30 not one shall come into the land where I swore that I would make you dwell, except Caleb the son of Jephunneh and Joshua the son of Nun.

Num 14:31 But your little ones, who you said would become a prey, I will bring in, and they shall know the land that you have rejected.

Num 14:32 But as for you, your dead bodies shall fall in this wilderness.

Num 14:33 And your children shall be shepherds in the wilderness forty years and shall suffer for your faithlessness, until the last of your dead bodies lies in the wilderness.

Num 14:34 According to the number of the days in which you spied out the land, forty days, a year for each day, you shall bear your iniquity forty years, and you shall know

my displeasure.'

Num 14:35 I, the LORD, have spoken. Surely this will I do to all this wicked congregation who are gathered together against me: in this wilderness they shall come to a full end, and there they shall die."

Num 14:36 And the men whom Moses sent to spy out the land, who returned and made all the congregation grumble against him by bringing up a bad report about the land—

Num 14:37 the men who brought up a bad report of the land—died by plague before the LORD.

Num 14:38 Of those men who went to spy out the land, only Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb the son of Jephunneh remained alive.

Israel Defeated in Battle

Num 14:39 When Moses told these words to all the people of Israel, the people mourned greatly.

Num 14:40 And they rose early in the morning and went up to the heights of the hill country, saying, "Here we are. We will go up to the place that the LORD has promised, for we have sinned."

Num 14:41 But Moses said, "Why now are you transgressing the command of the LORD, when that will not succeed?

Num 14:42 Do not go up, for the LORD is not among you, lest you be struck down before your enemies.

Num 14:43 For there the Amalekites and the Canaanites are facing you, and you shall fall by the sword. Because you have turned back from following the LORD, the LORD will not be with you."

Num 14:44 But they presumed to go up to the heights of the hill country, although neither the ark of the covenant of the LORD nor Moses departed out of the camp.

Num 14:45 Then the Amalekites and the Canaanites who lived in that hill country came down and defeated them and pursued them, even to Hormah.

Once again, Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb were the only two who were willing to trust in the Elohim of Israel and to go forth and to conquer these giants and to take the land that God himself was giving them. But once again... because of the fear that gripped their hearts... the devil had once again caused the House of Israel to stumble and to fall. And I want us to notice that in Numbers chapter 14 verse two it says and I quote, "And all the people of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron."

In other words, this was not just a small group of rabble rousers this time. This was clearly all of the people of Israel grumbling against Moses and Aaron. And what were they saying once again? Clearly blaspheming the Elohim of Israel himself by proclaiming that they would rather have died in the land of Egypt than to have followed their Elohim into the promised land. Choosing once again the pharaoh of Egypt over the Elohim of Israel. And not only were they blaspheming the Elohim of Israel... they were also blaspheming Moses and Aaron who were sent by the Elohim of Israel. In Numbers chapter 14 verse 4 the House of Israel says, and I quote, "let us choose a leader and go back to Egypt".

Now my friends I want us to stop, and I want us to think for just a moment what we just read in the previous chapter of the book of Numbers in Numbers chapters 11 and 12.

Just a couple of chapters ago the people were grumbling and saying the exact same thing because they were craving meat. And yet, here is the House of Israel once again wanting to go back like a dog to its vomit and like a pig back to its mire back into the land of Egypt to serve the pharaoh of Egypt rather than serving the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. And what did we just read in Numbers chapter 12? Did we not see Miriam the sister of Moses and Aaron being turned white with leprosy because of her rebellion against Moses? And yet... after all of this... none of this fear of God had gripped the heart of the House of Israel. The fear of God did not grip their hearts... but the fear of the devil and his giants did grip the hearts of the House of Israel.

And so, what can we take away from these historical events?

It's not like the House of Israel did not see all of the miracles and signs that Yehovah had done right in front of them bringing plagues against Egypt and defeating the pharaoh of Egypt, and parting the sea before them to walk across, and raining down manna from heaven to give them food to eat.

Listen closely to what Yehvoah God says to the House of Israel in **Numbers** chapter 14 verse 11 E1

Num 14:11 And the LORD said to Moses, "How long will this people despise me? And how long will they not believe in me, in spite of all the signs that I have done among them?

Yehvoah God... tells Moses that he is so disgusted with this stiff-necked people that he is going to strike them with pestilence and disinherit them and that he is going to make a nation out of Moses... greater and mightier than they are. And I want to make sure that we catch this in Numbers chapter 14 verse 12 where Yehovah is ready to disinherit all of the House of Israel and to start over with Moses.

Moses had the opportunity of becoming just as important as Abraham! Moses had the opportunity to essentially become the next Abraham. But what did Moses do? Moses turned down that rather prestigious honor given to him by the Elohim of Israel in order to make himself low and to humble himself in front of the Elohim of Israel and beg for the mercy of the House of Israel that according to Numbers chapter 14 verse 10... wanted to stone him to death along with Joshua and Caleb. All that the House of Israel wanted was to get rid of Moses and to make for themselves a new leader that would lead them back into the bondage of Egypt and under the rule of the pharaoh of Egypt.

Keeping this in mind, this should give us some insight as to how humble and meek that Moses actually was. This should give us a great deal of understanding concerning the heart of Moses the man that God had chosen to lead his people out of bondage. And it should also help us to understand exactly how wise Yehvoah God was in choosing Moses to lead his people out from under the bondage of Egypt.

Keeping that in mind... I now once again ask you plainly... is there any difference between the House of Israel back in the days of Moses and us today in our time? For example... take those who refuse to understand and believe the biblical concept of giants that is found within the very pages of our bibles. All they want to do is to serve their denominational charters of men and the deception that man teaches rather than listening and studying and accepting what the God breathed scripture that they have within their very hands clearly and unequivocally proclaims as truth.

And what about the ignorant and unstudied Christians today that call themselves "Christians" and yet worship and honor the Pope of Rome every Sunday morning on the first day of the week calling it the Sabbath when no one within the confines of their Bible has never commanded them to keep holy the first day of the week and to call it the Sabbath.

Today as we speak it is the 23rd of December. Two days before the celebration of the Roman Catholic church and her Pope of Rome as being the son of god and his own established immaculate birth. One of the greatest lies that has ever been perpetuated against not only God's only begotten Son our King... but Yehovah God himself.

Soon the world will be filled with the divination and magic of flying reindeer and magical Krampus elves, and songs about grandma being run over by reindeer. They will shower themselves with gifts and spoil their children rotten and bask in the glory of a Roman Catholic created lie that has been told for so long and for so many generations that for them... it has become the truth.

Is there any real difference between the House of Israel wanting to return back into the bondage of Egypt and it's Pharoah and us today in our time? Is there any difference between the House of Israel choosing God's adversary over him back in the days of Moses, and us choosing God's adversary over him today in our time? Is there any difference between the cravings of the House of Israel and our cravings today and our time?

Is there any difference between the House of Israel seeing the miracles and the signs of God right in front of their faces... and us today in our time seeing the signs and the miracles of God right in front of our faces? Do we not see the sunrise in the morning and set in the evening? Do we not see how the flowers of the field are clothed and the birds of the air are fed? Do we not see the many blessings that have been bestowed upon each and every one of us hear today who has been blessed time and time again with the signs and wonders of the creator of the heavens and the earth?

I tell you the truth my friends... there is nothing new under the sun. What has been will be done. And this is exactly why it is written that our Father in heaven teaches us the end... from the beginning.

Today you and I are living in a very precarious time. According to everything that the Bible tells us, we are inches away from the end of the age as we know it and the return of our Messiah is indeed at hand today in our time. We... just like the House of Israel have a decision to make. Who is it that we will believe? Will we believe those who govern over us? Will we believe those lawmakers who stand in our halls of justice? Will we believe the presidents and the Queens and the kings, and the prime ministers of the world? Will we believe the CDC and WHO and the doctors and lawyers of our time? Will we believe our denominational empires of men and those who are now standing behind our modern-day denominational pulpits? Will we believe the fear that has been instilled within us concerning today's mandates and proclamations that once again fly in the face of everything that our God breathed scripture teaches us?

Or will we believe the God breathed scripture that we hold within our very hands given to us by our creator the only one true Most High Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob?

While the church today runs wild on a tangent with a belly full of the philosophy and the theologies and the dogmas of their own man-made denominational empires and their charters of men... will we bow down to the fear of them and what they tell us? Have these giants in the land... not instilled the fear of the devil within the hearts of God's people today?

Will we allow the fear of the world And today's giants... to grip our hearts and to turn us away from our Father in heaven and his only begotten Son that came to willfully lay down his life as a sacrificial offering to pay for the atonement of our wickedness? And is that sign not an even greater sign than the House of Israel was there to witness in their day?

Are we going to allow the fear of today's giants to rule over our thoughts and our minds and our hearts to the point that we are willfully and intentionally prepared to turn away from the Elohim who created us?

Let us not think in our hearts and in our minds that we are so different from the House of Israel back in the days of Moses. Let us not think that we are smarter than they, or that we are more blessed than they, or that we are not held to the exact same standard that they were held to.

Who were those that we are reading about here in Numbers chapter 14 that wanted a new leader to lead them back into the bondage of Egypt? Who were they? Were they not the very <u>leaders</u>... of the House of the Israel who had gone to spy out the land of Canaan and came back with a bad report striking fear into the hearts of the people? And is there any difference between the leaders of the House of Israel back in the times of Moses who had spread fear among his people... and our leaders today who are striking fear into the hearts of God's people? Leaders...who have no knowledge of the difference between the clean and the unclean? (scrn 5)

They Promise Them Freedom!

2Pe 2:19 They promise them freedom, but they themselves are slaves of corruption. For whatever overcomes a person, to that he is enslaved.
2Pe 2:20 For if, after they have escaped the defilements of the world through the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and overcome, the last state has become worse for them than the first.
2Pe 2:21 For it would have been better for them never to have known the way of righteousness than after knowing it to turn back from the holy commandment delivered to them.
2Pe 2:22 What the true proverb says has happened to them: "The dog returns to its own vomit, and the sow, after washing herself, returns to wallow in the mire."

When the House of Israel decided that they wanted to go back into the bondage of Egypt and to pay homage to... and to worship the pharaoh of Egypt rather than the Elohim of Abraham Isaac and Jacob, we must understand what they were doing.

After receiving the knowledge of the truth... they were not only trampling under foot the Son of Yehvoah that Yehvoah was about to send them, but they were trampling under foot Yehvoah himself! And it was because of their unbelief in the one true Most High Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob that the House of Israel fell in the desert that very day. It was because they had become enlightened and had tasted the heavenly gift and had shared in the Holy Spirit who was leading them through the wilderness and had tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the age to come and had fallen away... that Yehvoah God was Finished with them. It was because they openly chose God's adversary instead of God... that they had cut the cord between themselves and God himself who had already told them very clearly that they were to have no other gods before him.

You see, this was not something that they had never been taught or told before. They knew these commandments and precepts full well because Yehvoah had already made these commandments and precepts known to them. Yehvoah had made it extremely clear not only through Moses, but through his own spoken words

that he came down to thunder to the House of Israel back in Exodus chapter 19 and 20 that they were to have no other gods before him. The very first commandment of the testimony of the Elohim of Israel had been broken and trampled upon within the very presence of... Yehvoah himself and not only once... but 10 times over! Notice that in **Numbers chapter 14 verses 22 and 23; E8**

Num 14:22 none of the men who have seen my glory and my signs that I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and yet have put me to the test these ten times and have not obeyed my voice,

Num 14:23 shall see the land that I swore to give to their fathers. And none of those who despised me shall see it.

10 Times over... the house of Israel had broken the commandment of the Elohim of Israel and rejected him and had willfully and intentionally chosen to return to the bondage of Egypt.

Number 1: E2 Ex 14:10-12

Exo 14:10 When Pharaoh drew near, the people of Israel lifted up their eyes, and behold, the Egyptians were marching after them, and they feared greatly. And the people of Israel cried out to the LORD.

Exo 14:11 They said to Moses, "Is it because there are no graves in Egypt that you have taken us away to die in the wilderness? What have you done to us in bringing us out of Egypt?

Exo 14:12 Is not this what we said to you in Egypt: 'Leave us alone that we may serve the Egyptians'? For it would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the wilderness."

Number 2: E3 Ex 15:22-24

Exo 15:22 Then Moses made Israel set out from the Red Sea, and they went into the wilderness of Shur. They went three days in the wilderness and found no water.

Exo 15:23 When they came to Marah, they could not drink the water of Marah because it was bitter; therefore it was named Marah.

Exo 15:24 And the people grumbled against Moses, saying, "What shall we drink?"

Number 3: E4 Ex 16:1-2

Exo 16:1 They set out from Elim, and all the congregation of the people of Israel came to the wilderness of Sin, which is between Elim and Sinai, on the fifteenth day of the second month after they had departed from the land of Egypt.

Exo 16:2 And the whole congregation of the people of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness,

Exo 16:3 and the people of Israel said to them, "Would that we had died by the hand of the LORD in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the meat pots and ate bread to the full,

for you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole assembly with hunger."

Number 4: E4 scroll down Ex 16:19-20

Exo 16:19 And Moses said to them, "Let no one leave any of it over till the morning." Exo 16:20 But they did not listen to Moses. Some left part of it till the morning, and it bred worms and stank. And Moses was angry with them.

Number 5: E4 scroll down 27-30

Exo 16:27 On the seventh day some of the people went out to gather, but they found none.

Exo 16:28 And the LORD said to Moses, "How long will you refuse to keep my commandments and my laws?

Exo 16:29 See! The LORD has given you the Sabbath; therefore on the sixth day he gives you bread for two days. Remain each of you in his place; let no one go out of his place on the seventh day."

Exo 16:30 So the people rested on the seventh day.

Number 6: E5 Ex 17:1-4

Exo 17:1 All the congregation of the people of Israel moved on from the wilderness of Sin by stages, according to the commandment of the LORD, and camped at Rephidim, but there was no water for the people to drink.

Exo 17:2 Therefore the people quarreled with Moses and said, "Give us water to drink." And Moses said to them, "Why do you quarrel with me? Why do you test the LORD?"

Exo 17:3 But the people thirsted there for water, and the people grumbled against Moses and said, "Why did you bring us up out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and our livestock with thirst?"

Exo 17:4 So Moses cried to the LORD, "What shall I do with this people? They are almost ready to stone me."

Number 7: E6 Ex 32:1-5

Exo 32:1 When the people saw that Moses delayed to come down from the mountain, the people gathered themselves together to Aaron and said to him, "Up, make us gods who shall go before us. As for this Moses, the man who brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him."

Exo 32:2 So Aaron said to them, "Take off the rings of gold that are in the ears of your wives, your sons, and your daughters, and bring them to me."

Num 11:6 But now our strength is dried up, and there is nothing at all but this manna to look at."

Num 11:8 The people went about and gathered it and ground it in handmills or beat it in mortars and boiled it in pots and made cakes of it. And the taste of it was like the taste of cakes baked with oil.

Num 11:9 When the dew fell upon the camp in the night, the manna fell with it.

Num 11:10 Moses heard the people weeping throughout their clans, everyone at the door of his tent. And the anger of the LORD blazed hotly, and Moses was displeased.

Num 11:11 Moses said to the LORD, "Why have you dealt ill with your servant? And why have I not found favor in your sight, that you lay the burden of all this people on me?

Num 11:12 Did I conceive all this people? Did I give them birth, that you should say to me, 'Carry them in your bosom, as a nurse carries a nursing child,' to the land that you swore to give their fathers?

Num 11:13 Where am I to get meat to give to all this people? For they weep before me and say, 'Give us meat, that we may eat.'


Num 11:14 I am not able to carry all this people alone; the burden is too heavy for me.

Num 11:15 If you will treat me like this, kill me at once, if I find favor in your sight, that I may not see my wretchedness."

Number 10... Is finally where we are now in Numbers chapter 14 where we find that the House of Israel is so frightened and gripped with fear that they have once again chosen to forsake God in order to go back and worship the pharaoh of Egypt because of their fear of the giants that occupied the land that God had promised

them.

And so here we have ten different times not just one time... but ten different times that the House of Israel had forsaken the Elohim of Israel for the pharaoh of Egypt. This my friends is the quintessential definition of the "unpardonable sin" that our Messiah speaks of in Matthew chapter 12 (scrn 6)



As we read about these ten different times in Numbers chapter 14 verse 22 that the House of Israel had actually put Yehvoah to the test by disobeying his voice and choosing to return to the worship of the pharaoh of Egypt over the Elohim of Israel... what we need to sit up and take notice of... is that they had indeed spoken against and blasphemed the very spirit of God himself not once, not twice, but ten different times!

And so, it's important to grasp what is going on here when attempting to understand the punishment that our Father in heaven doled out upon the House of Israel when he told them that none of the men who had seen his glory and had seen his signs that he did in Egypt and in the wilderness would be allowed to enter into the promised land that he promised Abraham. Every one of them would die before they arrived at the promised land and none of them would enter into it because they had once again blasphemed the very Sprit of God himself 10 times over. The only one that was going to be allowed to enter into the land was going to be his servant Caleb who once again stood for the instruction given by Yehovah God to go in and to take possession of the land that he was giving them.

At this point in time after the House of Israel had disobeyed the voice of God and had openly chosen to return to Egypt like a dog to her vomit and like a pig to its mire it should be pretty clear to us why it was that our Father in heaven was fed up with these people who had rejected him here in Numbers chapter 14. After all that he had done... after all the miracles that he had shown them... after he had just rescued them out from under the bondage of the pharaoh of Egypt to take them by the hand and to lead them into the promised land of milk and honey that he had promised Abraham... they were disrespectful... they were grumblers... they were malcontents... and they had clearly shown that the love of God was not in their hearts and not in their minds and that all they were interested in was serving the cravings of their flesh. And this is ultimately what brought them down into the pit.

And once again I would like us to stop right here and to think about what it was that brought them down into that pit. What happens when all we are interested in is the cravings of our flesh? What happens when all we are interested in is what each one of us wants individually? What happens when we are disrespectful to our creator who is our Father in heaven? What happens when we blaspheme his Holy Spirit? What happens when we choose the God of this world over the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob? What happens when we choose the Pope of Rome and his first day of the week Sunday Sabbath instead of God's 7th day Sabbath that is a sign between him and us? What happens when we celebrate the Roman Catholic created anniversary of the death of their Pope who they claim to be the vicar of Christ on Good Friday... rather than celebrating the anniversary of the death of the true Messiah who is the only begotten Son of God on Passover day? What happens when we bow the knee to the little "g" god on earth also known as the Pope of Rome in order to kiss his golden ring instead of bowing down before the Elohim of Abraham Isaac and Jacob? What happens when we continuously run back into the arms of Rome back into the bondage of sin and debauchery and her deception and the filth and the trash of her teachings instead of running into the arms of the one true Most High Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob?

How long do we think that our Father in heaven is going to put up with this nonsense? How long did he put up with it from the House of Israel? And if you

think that the Pope of Rome is not another God on earth, think again. Ge again is a liar, a child of the devil before he is anything else, full of deception thinking to change the times and the law of the one true Most High Elohim of Israel. He is indeed a child of his father who is the father of all lies completely and utterly turning the very birth of our Messiah into a mockery that celebrates himself and his own birth and his own thrown instead of the work of the descendant of David, the seed of Abraham, the only begotten son of Yehovah God himself that has been done for us and our children and our children's children. Make no mistake about it my friends this Roman Catholic created toy God called "old nick" is nothing but an Antichrist invented by the Roman Catholic Church in order to take the minds and the hearts of our children away from the one true savior of the world who has come to give them the greatest gift of all.

And even after all of this insolence, after all of this disrespect, after all of this disobedience what did the house of Israel do when Yehvoah had spoken these things to them? Did they finally bow down? Did they finally repent? Did they cry out for mercy? Or did they once again choose to disobey the Elohim of Israel and March right into battle doing the exact thing that Yehvoah had commanded them not to do because of their disobedience?

And so it was that the House of Israel did indeed March into battle and so it was that the House of Israel was once again defeated because they chose to listen to their flesh and to do what they wanted to do instead of doing with the Elohim of Israel had told them to do. And I would love to say that Numbers chapter 15 and 16 will be better... but once again as we walk through Numbers chapter 15 on into Numbers chapter 16 we will once again read about more rebellion, and more disobedience that is still yet to come... even after all of this.

And so, what is it that we can take away from Numbers chapter 14 as modern day Christians?

Clearly, what should be understood is that even though Moses interceded for the House of Israel and even though Moses was more than willing to put the House of Israel before himself... it was ultimately up to the House of Israel themselves to choose whom it was that they were going to serve. And they willfully and intentionally did choose... wrongly.

Today in our time I would submit to you once again, that nothing has changed. The

decision that was given to the House of Israel to make is the exact same decision that is given to each one of us to make. Who is it that we will serve? Who is it that each one of us will be serving this coming weekend on December 25th? Who is it that we will truly be worshipping? We all know that December 25th is not the birth of our Messiah according to the Bible and that it is nothing more than a Catholic created lie created by the Pope of Rome who believes that she is now a vicar of Christ the replacement of Christ and even God on earth.


And so who is it that they will be serving this coming December 25th? Who is it that they will be choosing? Will they not have made void the word of God in order to hold on to their own traditions? Will they not be worshiping him with their lips while their hearts are far from him worshiping him in vain teaching as doctrines the commandments of men? And has the beast not already thought to change the times and the laws of God right here before our very eyes?

Is the earth not already quaking? Are there not already wars and rumors of wars being spoken of across the face of the earth? Is Kingdom not already rising against Kingdom and nation against nation? Are there not already signs in the sun, the moon, and the stars? Do we not already see the distress of nations in perplexity because of the roaring of the sea and the waves and are people not already beginning to fear with foreboding of what is coming upon the earth? Are there not plagues and famines occurring right now across the face of the earth? Are we not standing right now in the midst of a pandemic with other pandemics and plagues on the horizon? And after all of these things that we have seen and heard and been witnesses to... are we so blind as to not be able to see the wrath of God himself being made manifest right in front of us each and every day? How many people have to die in these tsunamis? How many people have to die in these earthquakes? How many people have to die in these tornadoes and floods end volcanoes before the world will sit up and notice of the fact that the wrath of God is indeed upon them?

Even the heating up of the earth that the mainstream left loves to call "global warming" has been prophesied about all throughout our Bibles because of the wrath of God that both God and his profits, and his only begotten Son had prophesied about thousands of years ago!

Once again, my friends... just as wise old king Solomon has told us generations ago, there is nothing new under the sun. What has been what will be... and what

has been done is what will be done... and there is indeed nothing new under the sun. I would submit to you my friends that our culture and our society is nothing more than a mirror image of the House of Israel back in Moses' time. It was the willful and intentional disobedience of the House of Israel that caused them to fall, and it will be the willful and intentional disobedience of the world that will also cause it to fall along with many modern-day professing Christians who say that they are Christians... and are not. (scrn 7 show)



When our Messiah wrote the very first letter to the very first assembly in the Book of Revelation to the Church of Ephesus, he wrote about how their assembly could not bear those who were evil but have tested those who call themselves apostles and are not and found them to be false.

I tell you the truth, today in our time it is tectonically important for us to know the difference between those who call themselves Christians... and are not. And the only way to identify those who call themselves Christians... and are not... is by testing just as the assembly at Ephesus tested those who called themselves apostles and were not. And the only way that we can test the fruit of a man is to measure what that man produces by the God breathed scriptures that we have been given. Once again, it's not about what is good and righteous in our eyes... it's about what

is good and righteous in his eyes. And my hope and my prayer is that because we have read his God breathed scripture from the beginning in the book of genesis to the end which ends with the Book of Revelation, that we will have the ability to test those who call themselves Christians. The time for us to look up because our redemption is near is not coming... it's not on the way... it's not about to come upon us... it's already here and far too many who call themselves "Christians" do not have the eyes to see or the ears to hear that it is already upon us. And just like the House of Israel back in the days of Moses fell because they did not have the eyes to see and the ears to hear, so too will many of us fall if we do not have the eyes to see and the ears to hear what is happening all around us today in our time.

My prayer is that those who are walking with us through this study of the book of Numbers we'll have the eyes to see and the ears to hear exactly what caused the House of Israel to fall back in the days of Moses and the God given common sense to be able to know that Yehovah God is indeed teaching us the end from the beginning.

What is important for us to always remember is that we have these Old Testament writings in front of us today in our time because it was Yehovah God's will for us to have these Old Testament writings before us in these last days. We must remember that it was the Roman Catholic Church that had originally stolen the Bible from the world back in the dark ages. Back in the dark ages you and your family would have been murdered in cold blood by the Roman Catholic Church for even owning or reading a Bible. Men were strangled and set on fire alive in the middle of their towns for attempting to translate the Bible into their own native tongues and it was because of these men who gave their very lives... that we today have the Bible and these Old Testament writings in front of us in these last days. Let us never forget that. Let us never forget why it is that we have this Torah, this law, this spoken word of the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob to learn from today in our time. There should be no doubt in our minds that it was indeed the will of Yehvoah himself that we would have these precious Scriptures to learn from. And it will indeed without a doubt be these exact same God breathed words that will have the power and the authority to see us through what is soon to come upon the earth in these last days.

And so... with all of that being said and shown... we'll move into the 15th chapter of the book of Numbers next week when we'll talk more about the gentile who was grafted into the house of Israel back in the days of Moses, and the difference between willful and intentional sin... and accidental sin.

And with that... as we close the books for this evening I will do as I always do, and I will once again ask that everyone within the sound of my voice would please take what you have heard here this evening to your own prayer closet.
