



Matthew Chapter 21

I have Put My King In Zion!

Last week as we examined Matthew chapter 20, we spoke in some detail about the true identity of our Messiah and exactly who he was, is, and always will be. And we also spoke about how our Messiah had prophesied about his death several times before it had taken place. And we also spoke about the great detail in which our Messiah had told his Apostles that his death would take place, telling his apostles not only who was going to murder him, and by whose hand he would be murdered, but where it was going to take place and even the very day that it was going to take place which of course was on Passover day just as he had told his apostles it would be in Matthew chapter 26 verse two.

Our Messiah had prophesied about his death at least four different times that we know of just here in the book of Matthew. And the detail in which he spoke about exactly how his death was going to take place is literally astounding for those of us who have read the Old Testament because it is in the Old Testament that we find not only the introduction to our Messiah but also a lot of these details concerning the death of our Messiah as well.

And we also made mention of the fact that the “Jesus” that churchianity teaches and preaches about today in our time is a far cry from the actual Hebrew Jewish Yeshua who came from the house of David and the tribe of Judah that we read about in the Bible.

And once again... I would submit to you that if the Pharisees and the scribes of our Messiah's time were called children of the devil for adding to the word of God and for taking away from the word of God... then today's modern-day church is 70 times more guilty than the scribes and the Pharisees who were standing behind the pulpits of our Messiah's time.

And we also made mention of the fact that our Messiah praised the assemblies in the book of Revelation for being able to identify those who called themselves Jews and were not. And he also praised the assemblies in the book of Revelation for being able to identify those who called themselves disciples... and were not.

Once again, today in our time the assemblies of our modern-day churches could care less who is a Jew and who is not a Jew or who is a disciple and who is not a disciple. By and large the assemblies of our modern-day churches today have become all-inclusive. They have literally made themselves friends of the world in order to fit in with the world. The church today is consistently looking for ways to fit in with the world and her mother church of Rome so that they can hold hands and sing Kumbaya with the enemy. But this is in no way what the Bible teaches (**scrn 1 show**)

Jas 4:4 You adulterous people! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Therefore **whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.**



This morning as we begin to read through Matthew chapter 21, we are going to once again find a lot of the Old Testament writings and prophecies coming to life. We're going to see a lot of the Old Testament writings and prophecies being fulfilled as we journey through Matthew chapter 21. If there has ever been any doubt in your mind of exactly how important the Old Testament is... you're going to want to stay with us here this morning.

The truth of the matter is, that unless we have read the beginning of the book first and have a basic understanding of the history of Christianity from the beginning... we will in no way know or understand what is being fulfilled here in the back half of the book in the book of Matthew. And today by the end of this study, I think that you will agree with me when I say that you cannot read the Bible from the back half of the book starting with the book of Matthew without first reading the beginning of the book starting with Genesis. Because if you do, you will have been robbed of the prophetic truth and even the identity and the qualifiers that qualify Yeshua (Jesus in the Greek) to even be our Messiah.

What we must understand is that in order for our Messiah to even be our Messiah, he must pass the qualifications of the Old Testament the Torah, the writings of the prophets, and the Psalms. And just to clarify what I am saying here as not coming from myself, I would like us to listen very, very closely to what our Messiah tells us in the book of **Luke chapter 24 verses 44 through 49 (scrn 2)**

Luk 24:44 Then he said to them, “These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled.”

Luk 24:45 Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures,

Luk 24:46 and said to them, “Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead,

Luk 24:47 and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem

Luk 24:48 You are witnesses of these things.

Luk 24:49 And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high.”



Once again, our Messiah himself told us that everything written about him in the law of Moses and the prophets, and the Psalms had to be fulfilled. Why? Because everything that was written about him in the law of Moses (also known as the Torah) the prophets and the Psalms were what qualified our Messiah to be our Messiah. **(scrn 3 show)**

Act 17:10 The brothers immediately sent Paul and Silas away by night to Berea, and when they arrived they went into the Jewish synagogue.

Act 17:11 Now these Jews were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they received the word with all eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so.



In the 17th chapter of the book of Acts the apostle Paul makes mention of the noble Jews of Berea. And Paul clearly tells us in Acts chapter 17 that the Jews of Berea were more noble than the Jews in Thessalonica because the noble Jews of Berea examined the Scriptures daily to see if what Paul was telling them about the Messiah was true.

What's important to understand about this Scripture is that the noble Jews of Berea were not examining the New Testament. The New Testament had not yet been written at that time. So how did the noble Jews of Berea know what the apostle Paul was telling them about the Messiah was true? They knew that what the apostle Paul was telling them about the Messiah was true because they were examining the Torah, the writings of the prophets, and the Psalms that our Messiah has already told us had written about him.

And therefore... they were able to identify our Messiah by reading the Torah, the writings of the prophets, and the Psalms... this should clearly tell us where it was that our Messiah was first introduced to us. And it was not, and I repeat not... in the book of Matthew or anywhere in the

New Testament.

Our Messiah was first introduced to us in the Torah, the first five books of the Bible, the writings of the prophets, and the Psalms. He was not introduced to us first... in the New Testament. And this is extremely important for each and every modern-day professing Christian to know and to understand because if they don't know these things and they don't understand these things, they will never be able to truly identify the one true Elohim of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob nor will they be able to truly identify the Son of David the Son of Abraham. And this... is the holy war that we fight today. And this is a holy war that we fight. It is a spiritual warfare that has everything to do with worshiping another god other than the God of the Bible.

Keeping all of these things in mind I would like for us now to open our Bibles to Matthew chapter 21, and I would like for us to read through the entire chapter of Matthew chapter 21 so that we can once again know exactly what it says and just as importantly... what it does not say.

Matthew chapter 21 E1

The Triumphal Entry

Mat 21:1 Now when they drew near to Jerusalem and came to Bethphage, to the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples,

Mat 21:2 saying to them, "Go into the village in front of you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her. Untie them and bring them to me.

Mat 21:3 If anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord needs them,' and he will send them at once."

Mat 21:4 This took place to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet, saying,

Mat 21:5 "Say to the daughter of Zion, 'Behold, your king is coming to you, humble, and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden.'"

Mat 21:6 The disciples went and did as Jesus had directed them.

Mat 21:7 They brought the donkey and the colt and put on them their cloaks, and he sat on them.

Mat 21:8 Most of the crowd spread their cloaks on the road, and others cut

branches from the trees and spread them on the road.

Mat 21:9 And the crowds that went before him and that followed him were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"

Mat 21:10 And when he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred up, saying, "Who is this?"

Mat 21:11 And the crowds said, "This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth of Galilee."

Jesus Cleanses the Temple

Mat 21:12 And Jesus entered the temple and drove out all who sold and bought in the temple, and he overturned the tables of the money-changers and the seats of those who sold pigeons.

Mat 21:13 He said to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer,' but you make it a den of robbers."

Mat 21:14 And the blind and the lame came to him in the temple, and he healed them.

Mat 21:15 But when the chief priests and the scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying out in the temple, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" they were indignant,

Mat 21:16 and they said to him, "Do you hear what these are saying?" And Jesus said to them, "Yes; have you never read, "'Out of the mouth of infants and nursing babies you have prepared praise'?"

Mat 21:17 And leaving them, he went out of the city to Bethany and lodged there.

Jesus Curses the Fig Tree

Mat 21:18 In the morning, as he was returning to the city, he became hungry.

Mat 21:19 And seeing a fig tree by the wayside, he went to it and found nothing on it but only leaves. And he said to it, "May no fruit ever come from you again!" And the fig tree withered at once.

Mat 21:20 When the disciples saw it, they marveled, saying, "How did the fig tree wither at once?"

Mat 21:21 And Jesus answered them, "Truly, I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what has been done to the fig tree, but even if you say to this mountain, 'Be taken up and thrown into the sea,' it will happen.

Mat 21:22 And whatever you ask in prayer, you will receive, if you have faith."

The Authority of Jesus Challenged

Mat 21:23 And when he entered the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came up to him as he was teaching, and said, "By what authority are you doing these things, and who gave you this authority?"

Mat 21:24 Jesus answered them, "I also will ask you one question, and if you tell me the answer, then I also will tell you by what authority I do these things.

Mat 21:25 The baptism of John, from where did it come? From heaven or from man?" And they discussed it among themselves, saying, "If we say, 'From heaven,' he will say to us, 'Why then did you not believe him?'

Mat 21:26 But if we say, 'From man,' we are afraid of the crowd, for they all hold that John was a prophet."

Mat 21:27 So they answered Jesus, "We do not know." And he said to them, "Neither will I tell you by what authority I do these things.

The Parable of the Two Sons

Mat 21:28 "What do you think? A man had two sons. And he went to the first and said, 'Son, go and work in the vineyard today.'

Mat 21:29 And he answered, 'I will not,' but afterward he changed his mind and went.

Mat 21:30 And he went to the other son and said the same. And he answered, 'I go, sir,' but did not go.

Mat 21:31 Which of the two did the will of his father?" They said, "The first." Jesus said to them, "Truly, I say to you, the tax collectors and the prostitutes go into the kingdom of God before you.

Mat 21:32 For John came to you in the way of righteousness, and you did not believe him, but the tax collectors and the prostitutes believed him. And even when you saw it, you did not afterward change your minds and believe him.

The Parable of the Tenants

Mat 21:33 "Hear another parable. There was a master of a house who planted a vineyard and put a fence around it and dug a winepress in it and built a tower and leased it to tenants, and went into another country.

Mat 21:34 When the season for fruit drew near, he sent his servants to the tenants to get his fruit.

Mat 21:35 And the tenants took his servants and beat one, killed another, and stoned another.

Mat 21:36 Again he sent other servants, more than the first. And they did the same to them.

Mat 21:37 Finally he sent his son to them, saying, 'They will respect my son.'

Mat 21:38 But when the tenants saw the son, they said to themselves, 'This is the heir. Come, let us kill him and have his inheritance.'

Mat 21:39 And they took him and threw him out of the vineyard and killed him.

Mat 21:40 When therefore the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those tenants?"

Mat 21:41 They said to him, "He will put those wretches to a miserable death and let out the vineyard to other tenants who will give him the fruits in their seasons."

Mat 21:42 Jesus said to them, "Have you never read in the Scriptures: "The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; this was the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes'?"

Mat 21:43 Therefore I tell you, the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people producing its fruits.

Mat 21:44 And the one who falls on this stone will be broken to pieces; and when it falls on anyone, it will crush him."

Mat 21:45 When the chief priests and the Pharisees heard his parables, they perceived that he was speaking about them.

Mat 21:46 And although they were seeking to arrest him, they feared the crowds, because they held him to be a prophet.

The 21st chapter of the book of Matthew is chalked full of information that is well capable of opening the eyes of the blind and unstopping the ears of the deaf. But... in order for eyes to see and ears to hear what is being proclaimed here in the 21st chapter of the book of Matthew, we once again must have read and be familiar with the law also known as the Torah, the writings of the prophets, and the Psalms.

What's the very first thing that we see here in Matthew chapter 21? The very first thing that we see here in Matthew chapter 21 is our Messiah once again checking the box of one of the qualifiers that qualifies him to be our Messiah.

Once again, the very reason that our Messiah sent his apostles to go find a donkey and a colt that was tied with her was to fulfill a qualifying prophecy of the prophet **Zechariah (scrn 4)**

Zec 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he, humble and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

Zec 9:10 I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim and the war horse from Jerusalem; and the battle bow shall be cut off, and he shall speak peace to the nations; his rule shall be from sea to sea, and from the River to the ends of the earth.



Right here in the book of Zechariah, it was prophesied by the prophet Zechariah that the Messiah of Israel would come to them humbly and mounted on a donkey, and not only a donkey but on a colt the foal of a donkey which is exactly what Matthew tells us here in Matthew chapter 21. And right here prophesied by the prophet Zachariah we are told that he shall speak peace to the nations and that his rule shall be from sea to sea and from River to the ends of the earth.

Once again my friends, a qualifying prophecy that needed to take place in order for our Messiah to be our Messiah.

And I also want to make mention of the fact that the apostles did not just bring our Messiah one donkey to ride. They brought him a donkey and a foal. Now, why is this important? It's important because according to the prophecy of Zechariah our Messiah was not only to ride a donkey, but he was to ride a colt the foal of a donkey. And this is exactly why Matthew tells us that Yeshua told his apostles in Matthew chapter 21 verse two to go into the village and find a donkey tied and a colt along with her and to untie them both and bring them to him.

Once again, in most plays and theatrical recreations of our Messiah entering into Jerusalem, there is only one donkey shown. But the reality is that our Messiah did not ride a full-grown donkey into Jerusalem. Our Messiah rode a colt into Jerusalem and its mother followed with them.

Now, why is this important to understand? And why would our Father in heaven send us a King riding on a donkey?

We must first once again understand that it is written that the house of Israel was a stiff-necked people. At every turn the house of Israel rejected God. At every turn they profaned his feast days, they profaned his Sabbath and by doing so they had profaned his holy name. And just as it is written in the 36th chapter of the book of Ezekiel... the very reason that God is going to bring the house of Israel back into the promised land at the end of the age is not because the house of Israel deserves it, or because the house of Israel was such a good and righteous people. God is not going to bring us as a mixed multitude back into the promised land of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob because we are good people. He is going to place us back into the promised land of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob for his namesake... because he vowed that he would do so. Donkeys are known to be a stubborn breed of animal. Our Messiah was riding this stubborn breed of animal for a reason.

What we are seeing here in Matthew chapter 21 is a King sitting over and in control of a stubborn people. What we are seeing here in Matthew chapter 21 is a King that God himself, Yehovah, is placing in Zion to sit upon the throne of David over his rather stubborn children. Let's now turn once again to the Psalms that our Messiah clearly told us were written about him. **Psalms chapter 2 E2**

The Reign of the Lord's Anointed

Psa 2:1 Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain?

Psa 2:2 The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD and against his Anointed, saying,

Psa 2:3 "Let us burst their bonds apart and cast away their cords from us."

Psa 2:4 He who sits in the heavens laughs; the Lord holds them in derision.

Psa 2:5 Then he will speak to them in his wrath, and terrify them in his fury, saying,

Psa 2:6 "As for me, I have set my King on Zion, my holy hill."

Psa 2:7 I will tell of the decree: The LORD said to me, "You are my Son; today I have begotten you."

Psa 2:8 Ask of me, and I will make the nations your heritage, and the ends of the earth your possession.

Psa 2:9 You shall break them with a rod of iron and dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel."

Psa 2:10 Now therefore, O kings, be wise; be warned, O rulers of the earth.

Psa 2:11 Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling.

Psa 2:12 Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and you perish in the way, for his wrath is quickly kindled. Blessed are all who take refuge in him."

Clearly, right here in Psalms chapter 2, we are told that Yehovah God has set His King on Zion on His holy hill. Zion is another prophetic name for Jerusalem. **(scrn 5)**

And here in the book of Psalms, David tells us that Yehovah has set his King in Zion on his holy hill and furthermore... David tells us that God has said to him and I quote, “you are my son; today I have begotten you.” Once again confirming the fact that the Son of David would become the Son of God just as God promised David in second **Samuel chapter 7 verses 13 and 14 (scrn 6)**

2Sa 7:13 He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.

2Sa 7:14 I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son. When he commits iniquity, I will discipline him with the rod of men, with the stripes of the sons of men,



Once again, today’s modern-day professing Christian who has not read the Bible from the beginning of the book will be completely ignorant and dumbfounded by these tectonically important biblical facts. It is imperative that we read the Bible from the beginning of the book and not from the back of the book. Because if we read the Bible from the back of the book beginning with the book of Matthew we are once again, going to be completely dumbfounded and ignorant of the qualifiers of our Messiah and not only the qualifiers of our Messiah but the true identity of our Messiah.

And so, we have our Messiah right here in Matthew chapter 21 entering into Jerusalem (also known as Zion) as the only begotten Son of God

and once again he's checking off another box that qualifies him to be our Messiah the Son of David the Son of Abraham and the only begotten Son of God. And we haven't even gotten out of the first paragraph of Matthew chapter 21 yet. But there's more.

What we see in Matthew chapter 21 verses seven and eight is that the people spread their cloaks on the donkey and also on the road before the donkey. And those who didn't have cloaks cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road for him. And I want us to once again pay extremely close attention to what is written in **Matthew chapter 21 verse nine (scrn 7 show)**

Mat 21:9 And the crowds that went before him and that followed him were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"

Mat 21:10 And when he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred up, saying, "Who is this?"

Mat 21:11 And the crowds said, "This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth of Galilee."



Notice here in Matthew chapter 21 verse nine that the crowds that went before him were shouting something very profound. They were shouting and I quote, "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!"

My friends, you just can't get around what is being stated here in the book of Matthew. What is the true identity of our Messiah? Is our

Messiah or is our Messiah not... the son of David? Did our Messiah... or did our Messiah not... come in the name of his Father Yehovah? And we'd better be very very careful about how we answer these questions. Because as we can clearly see here in Matthew chapter 21 our Messiah did indeed have a human father. His name was David. And our Messiah was not God the Father... but came in the name of God the Father just as God himself had promised David in second Samuel chapter 7. Let's once again go read that so that we don't leave anyone behind concerning the truth of the identity of the only begotten Son of God according to the Bible. **Second Samuel chapter 7 verses eight through 17 E3**

2Sa 7:8 Now, therefore, thus you shall say to my servant David, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, I took you from the pasture, from following the sheep, that you should be prince over my people Israel.

2Sa 7:9 And I have been with you wherever you went and have cut off all your enemies from before you. And I will make for you a great name, like the name of the great ones of the earth.

2Sa 7:10 And I will appoint a place for my people Israel and will plant them, so that they may dwell in their own place and be disturbed no more. And violent men shall afflict them no more, as formerly,

2Sa 7:11 from the time that I appointed judges over my people Israel. And I will give you rest from all your enemies. Moreover, the LORD declares to you that the LORD will make you a house.

2Sa 7:12 When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom.

2Sa 7:13 He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.

2Sa 7:14 I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son. When he commits iniquity, I will discipline him with the rod of men, with the stripes of the sons of men,

2Sa 7:15 but my steadfast love will not depart from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you.

2Sa 7:16 And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.'"

2Sa 7:17 In accordance with all these words, and in accordance with all this vision, Nathan spoke to David.

Clearly, right here in your Bible, it is written that God himself promised David that he would raise up David's Son after him created by God... from the very body of David according to second Samuel chapter 7 verse 12... and furthermore, that this man that God would create from the body of David would sit upon David his earthly father's throne.

Furthermore, Yehovah God promised David that he would establish David's throne and this man's kingdom forever. And once again in second Samuel chapter 7 verse 14, God promises David and I quote, "I will be to him a Father, and he shall be to me a Son." In other words, Yehovah God himself would point to this man that he was going to create from the body of David in order to sit upon the throne of David and he would call this man his only begotten Son... which is exactly what we see happening in **Psalms chapter 2 verses 6 through 8. (scrn 8)**

Psa 2:6 "As for me, I have set my King on Zion, my holy hill"

Psa 2:7 I will tell of the decree: The LORD said to me, "You are my Son; today I have begotten you."

Psa 2:8 Ask of me, and I will make the nations your heritage, and the ends of the earth your possession.



Now my friends, you just can't get any more simple than this. This one paragraph of the Bible completely and utterly destroys the false Jesus of churchianity today. This one paragraph of the Bible alone completely

and utterly destroys a Roman Catholic created Trinity God that has been turned into a proverbial egg. This one chapter in the Bible that branches out through all of the rest of the Bible completely and utterly destroys a lawless Jesus. This one chapter of the Bible that branches out throughout all of the rest of the Bible completely and utterly destroys a Jesus that came to make it all about himself who came to celebrate his own birthday and came to create his own Sabbath day and came to do away with his Father's spoken word and to throw the law to the ground.

But there's more... I would like us to once again return to Matthew chapter 21 (**scrn 9 show**)

Mat 21:9 And the crowds that went before him and that followed him were shouting, **'Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!'**

Mat 21:10 And when he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred up, saying, "Who is this?"

Mat 21:11 And the crowds said, **'This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth of Galilee.'**



And I would also like us to pay close attention to verse 11. Clearly here in Matthew chapter 21 verse 11 what did the crowds say? Did the crowds say that Yeshua was God? Did Yeshua ever say that he was God? The answer to that question is a resounding no he did not. Not even once did Yeshua (Jesus in the Greek) ever claim to be his Father. He said that the spirit of his Father resided within him just like the spirit of God resides in each one of us. But he never not one time anywhere within the

confines of the 66 books of the Bible ever claimed to be his Father. What he did claim to be is the descendent of David. (scrn 10)

Rev 22:16 “I, Jesus, have sent my angel to testify to you about these things for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star.”



I ask you plainly, is God the root and the descendent of the man David? That my friends is laughable on its face. Clearly... once again... this is not and I repeat not... what the Bible says. Here's what the Bible does say (scrn 11)

Num 23:19 God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?



(scrn 12)


Rev 22:16 “I, Jesus, have sent my angel to testify to you about these things for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star.”



Right here in Revelation chapter 22 verse 16, our Messiah tells us very

clearly his true identity and it is not God the Father. Our Messiah tells us very clearly in Revelation chapter 22 verse 16 and I quote, “I am the root and the descendent of David the bright morning star.”

What does it mean to be the root of David? Our Messiah tells us what it means to be the root of David right here in Revelation chapter 22 verse 16. To be the root of David is to be the descendent of David that would sit upon the throne of David. The very reason that God shows David to be the descendent of our Messiah is because it is written that David was a man after God’s own heart. **(scrn 13)**



It is for this reason... because David was a man after God’s own heart that the throne of David has been established by Yehovah God for David’s descendent to sit upon and rule over God’s people forever. This is the very reason why the descendent of David was chosen by God himself. This is the very reason why Yehovah God made this covenant promise with David. **Jeremiah chapter 33 verses 17 and 18 (scrn 14 show)**

Jer 33:17 “For thus says the LORD: David shall never lack a man to sit on the throne of the house of Israel,

Jer 33:18 and the Levitical priests shall never lack a man in my presence to offer burnt offerings, to burn grain offerings, and to make sacrifices forever.”



According to the prophet Jeremiah who once again wrote about our Messiah, David shall never lack a man to sit on the throne of the house of Israel. Not says I, but says our God-breathed Scripture. And what does our New Testament have to say about this? (**scrn 15**)

1Ti 2:5 For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,

1Ti 2:6 who gave himself as a ransom for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time.




According to your New Testament... according to the apostle Paul who wrote first Timothy... there is only one God just as the Torah tells us that there is only one God. Furthermore... Paul also tells us that there is one mediator between God and men and that mediator is and I quote, “**the man** the Messiah Yeshua.” And once again the apostle Paul did not say “the man Christ Jesus”. That’s what your English-translated Bible says. No one had ever even heard of the name “Jesus” until the late 16th century. Even the first King James Version of the Bible published in 1611 did not have the name “Jesus” in it. Any a pastor worth a pound of salt can tell you that. But once again... he must be worth... a pound of salt. (scrn 16)

The truth of the matter is that the “J” sound was not introduced into the Greek language until the late 15th century and was not used until the late 16th century. The original Greek name of our Messiah found in the first King James translated version of the Bible was “Ee-ay-sooce” (Iesous) not Jesus. Furthermore... our Messiah was not a Greek man and therefore we have no reason to call him by a Greek name.

Our Messiah as we have just read in the Bible was not a Greek man who was given a Greek name. Our Messiah was a Hebrew Jew who was given a Hebrew name and that Hebrew name was “Yeshua”. Furthermore... if we wanted to translate the Hebrew name “Yeshua” into the English language it would not be “Jesus” it would be “Joshua”.

Once again, churchianity and today’s modern-day Christian denominational empires are found weighed and wanting concerning the true identity of the true only begotten Son of God, Son of David, Son of Abraham, who was indeed without question according to our God-breathed Scripture, a Hebrew Jewish man... who came from the house of David and the tribe of Judah and nowhere else!

Just as the apostle Paul tells us, there is one God and there is one mediator between God and men. And that my friends is the man Yeshua and no one else.

I would like to now turn back to Matthew chapter 21 once again to reread **Matthew chapter 21 verse 11 (scrn 17)**

Mat 21:9 And the crowds that went before him and that followed him were shouting, “Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!”

Mat 21:10 And when he entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred up, saying, “Who is this?”

Mat 21:11 And the crowds said, “This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth of Galilee.”



Right here in Matthew chapter 21 verse 11 what did the crowds say? The crowds said and I quote, “This is the prophet... the prophet... Yeshua from Nazareth of Galilee.” Emphasis on the word “prophet”. Was our Messiah a prophet? I ask you plainly... was our Messiah a human prophet according to the Bible? The answer to that question is a resounding “yes”, we just read it right here in Matthew chapter 21 verse 11. And where did the crowds get that idea that our Messiah was a human prophet and the son of David? Once again, they got this from reading the Torah and the Old Testament writings. Let’s turn to **Deuteronomy chapter 18 verses 15 through 19 E4**

A New Prophet like Moses

Deu 18:15 “The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your brothers—it is to him you shall listen—

Deu 18:16 just as you desired of the LORD your God at Horeb on the day of the assembly, when you said, ‘Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God or see this great fire any more, lest I die.’

Deu 18:17 And the LORD said to me, ‘They are right in what they have spoken.

Deu 18:18 I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their

brothers. And I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him.

Deu 18:19 And whoever will not listen to my words that he shall speak in my name, I myself will require it of him.

According to Moses right here in Deuteronomy chapter 18, God promised the house of Israel that he would raise up for them a prophet like Moses from among their brothers. This is where the crowds in Matthew chapter 21 got the idea of our Messiah being a prophet. They got that idea from the Torah, the Old Testament writings, and the law of Moses.

We know that our Messiah was a prophet because the Bible tells us that our Messiah was a prophet in both the Old Testament and in the New Testament. And anyone who says that our Messiah was not a prophet is point blank nothing more than a godless liar. And we can call them nothing else!

My friends what it all boils down to is who is it that we are going to listen to. Who is it that we ultimately worship? Is it men that we worship? Is it a pastor or a priest or a bishop or a Pope or a Rabbi that we worship? Or is it the God of the Bible that we worship?... The Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob that we worship?

The choice is yours to make. But know this... it is written within the confines of the testimony of God himself that thou shalt have no other gods before him.

The scribes and the Pharisees of our Messiah's time who were standing behind the pulpits of the synagogues of his time were called children of the devil not because they weren't reading the Bible, not because they weren't keeping the seventh-day Sabbath, not because they weren't keeping his feast days, but because they had created for themselves another God that called the Gentiles who were created in the image of God unclean dogs. They had created for themselves another God who had said that you could walk this far on the Sabbath, but you could not

walk that far on the Sabbath. They had created another God that said that you could not pop a few grains of wheat in your mouth while on a journey on the Sabbath day. They had created another God that commanded you to wash your hands before you ate. And because they had created this other God that had said things that the God of Israel did not say, our Messiah pointed to them as being and I quote, “twofold children of hell” who would travel over land and sea to make one follower and when they did make him a follower they made that follower a twofold child of hell more so than themselves.

My friends... if this was so for the scribes and the Pharisees of our Messiah’s time who were standing behind the pulpits of his time... then I would submit to you that today’s modern-day scribes and Pharisees that are standing behind the pulpits of our churches today are 70 fold more so the children of the devil than the Pharisees ever were.

Today’s churchianity is a false man-made created version of true Christianity. Today’s church by and large does not follow the Messiah Yeshua the only begotten Son of God the Hebrew Jew who sits upon the throne of David at the right hand of God. The church by and large today along with her denominational empires worship a false Jesus who was once again created by modern-day Pharisees and scribes to be a lawless son of perdition. A lawless fake. A lawless fraud. A Roman Catholic created son of the devil that was created for the sole purpose of leading astray if possible... even the very elect.

Read your Bible for yourself. And read it from the book of Genesis, not from the book of Matthew. Get down on your knees and ask for his discernment not for your pastor’s discernment, not for your pope’s discernment, not for your rabbi’s discernment, but for God’s discernment.

Ask, seek, and knock on his door and his door alone so that the proper door can be opened to you. If you are knocking upon the door of the devil, the devil will open that door and you will immediately be torn to

shreds and sifted by the one whose door you have been knocking upon.

You must ask, seek, and knock upon the door of Yehovah God the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. You must know his only begotten Son that he created from the body of David who was a descendent of Abraham who sits upon the throne of David at the right hand of God this very day.

You must not only read your Bible, but you must become... the spoken word of God made flesh just as our Messiah became the spoken word of God made flesh. His law must be written across your heart and in your mind in order for him to be able to forgive you of your sins because if his law is not written across your heart and in your mind then you have no concept of what the Son of David the Son of Abraham has even done for you.

If you are still walking around with a stony heart and you have not had the heart transplant of God and God's law is not written across your heart and in your mind... then your sins are not forgiven you! Because you do not truly believe and have faith in the only begotten Son of God, and you do not even know the true identity of the only begotten Son of God let alone the new covenant that his very blood has brought upon you. **(scrn 18)**

Heb 10:16 “This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, declares the Lord: I will put my laws on their hearts, and write them on their minds,”

Heb 10:17 then he adds, “I will remember their sins and their lawless deeds no more.”

Luk 22:20 And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, “This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood.”



The horrible truth is that most modern-day professing Christians don't even know what they are doing when they are taking the cup and eating the bread of communion! Because they have no idea what the blood of our Messiah is even all about! It's about the new covenant that God promised his people! It's about writing his law in the hearts and in the minds of his people! It has nothing to do with a pagan Easter Sunday morning or a Roman Catholic created Good Friday! **First Corinthians chapter 11 verses 26 through 30 (scrn 19)**

1Co 11:26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

1Co 11:27 Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty concerning the body and blood of the Lord.

1Co 11:28 Let a person examine himself, then, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup.

1Co 11:29 For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment on himself.

1Co 11:30 That is why many of you are weak and ill, and some have died.



How can you partake of the bread and the cup when you do not even understand that the very blood of our Messiah was spilled in order to write the law of God across your heart!?

If you are worshiping a lawless Jesus... a Roman Catholic created egg... then you are not worshiping the descendent of David the Morningstar. You are not worshiping the righteous... Yeshua of Bethlehem. You are not worshiping the Passover lamb who died on Passover day for your transgressions. You are not worshiping the one mediator between God and men, the man Yeshua Hamashiach. You are not worshiping the prophet that Yehovah God had raised up and created from the brothers of the house of Israel likened unto Moses to become the unblemished Lamb of God that could be the propitiation for the sins of the world.

Who is it that you worship? Who does the first day of the week Sunday Sabbath belong to? Who created the first day of the week Sunday Sabbath? It certainly was not God, and it certainly was not his only begotten Son. Nowhere within the confines of the 66 books of your Bible will you ever find either Yehovah God or his only begotten Son

ever commanding anyone to keep holy the first day of the week Sunday and to call it the Sabbath. The first day of the week Sunday Sabbath was created by the Pope of Rome and it belongs to the Pope of Rome and those who honor the first day of the week Sunday Sabbath are honoring no one other than... the Roman Catholic Pope of Rome who is the son of the devil himself who sits upon a golden throne exulting himself high and far above God and above all that is holy and all other gods.

Those who worship the false man-made Messiah on the Roman Catholic created "Good Friday" and Easter Sunday morning, are honoring and worshiping a false god. Your Messiah died on Passover day and is called your Passover lamb he was raised up on first fruits to waive the sheave offering before his Father in heaven so that we could be accepted in the eyes of God. He was in the earth for three days and for three nights not for two days and for 2 nights. WAKE UP! READ YOUR BIBLE! Stop dancing with the devil in the pale moonlight! Open your eyes, unplug your ears, touch not the unclean thing, give praise to the one true Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob and give thanks to the son of David the son of Abraham the human man who is the human mediator between man and God. Wake up and come out of your stupor!

The time is at hand the end is near, our Messiah is on his way and the armies of heaven follow with him! And he is coming to make war on the lawless and the ungodly! And it will indeed be the lawless that will be thrown into the pit and it will indeed be the lawless who will be thrown into the winepress of the wrath of God himself, and it will indeed be the blood of the lawless who will reach as high as a horse's bridle. And it will indeed be the lawless kings and queens and presidents and prime ministers whose bones the vultures and the birds of prey of the air will gorge themselves upon!

This is not a game. This is the truth. And you either have it and know it and understand it and live it... or you don't.

Choose this day whom it is that you will serve. Choose this day whom it

is that you worship. Choose this day who it is that is worthy of your praise and your obedience. Choose this day... and my advice to you is that you do indeed... choose wisely.

May the hand of Yehovah touch your heart this very day. The hand of Yehovah open your eyes and unplug your ears this very day.

Once again, I as a pastor cannot save you with a prayer. I cannot save you by calling you down to the front of the aisle. I cannot save you by saying a prayer for you. I as a pastor, as a man, have no power to save. I am a sewer. I plant the seed of truth in the hearing of those who have the eyes to see in the ears to hear. But there is one man who can save. There is one man who is capable of doing these things and his name is Yeshua Hamashiach. He is the only begotten Son of God and he has been given the authority by God his Father to judge. And he has been given the authority by God his Father to call to himself who it is that he will call.

As for me what I can do is tell you to repent and be baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of his Holy Spirit for the forgiveness of your transgressions and you will receive the gift of the Ruach Hakodesh. For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off, anyone whom the Lord our God calls to himself.

And with all that being said, I will once again ask everyone within the sound of my voice to please, please... Take what you have heard here today to your own prayer closet. Bow your head and bend your knee and face the holy promised land of Jerusalem and ask in the name of Yeshua Hamashiach if what you have heard here today be true or not.

Once again... Ask, seek, and knock on his door and on his door alone and the proper door will be opened to you. And if you will do this, and if you will stay the course to the end, you and I will surely walk through the gates of his soon coming kingdom together.
