


# Matthew Chapter 24d The Coming of The Son of Man

During the past couple of weeks as we have ventured into Matthew chapter 24, we've uncovered quite a lot of prophecy not only from the red letter words of our Messiah, but also from what was spoken of by the prophet Daniel that our Messiah points to here in Matthew chapter 24.

We've spoken about the three different abominations of desolations that are mentioned by the prophet Daniel and the abominations of the first two temples that have already led to their desolations. And we also made mention of the abominations that are within today's modern-day church that are also going to require desolation when our Messiah returns.


And although I know that many people hate the truth that the Bible proclaims... there simply is no other truth. (scrn 1)




What we need to remember is that God's word is truth. The Bible that we carry in our very hands this day is indeed the truth of God's word. The one true God, the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob who commands us to keep holy the seventh day of the week because it is a day that he has made holy and has set as a sign between him and his people. (PLAY SABBATH LIGHT VIDEO HERE)

Exo 31:13 "You are to speak to the people of Israel and say, 'Above all you shall keep my Sabbaths, for this is a sign between me and you throughout your generations, that you may know that I, the LORD, sanctify you.

And once again it is this very 7<sup>th</sup> day of the week that is a beacon... it is a light that shines brightly on the 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath of Yehvoah that beckons all who see it to come and to sit at his feet acknowledging that he is the creator of the heavens and the earth, the one true Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. It is indeed a sign between him and us that will never be forgotten. And what we also need to remember is what happens not only when we forsake Yehvoah God's 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath for the Pope of Romes 1<sup>st</sup> day of the week Sunday Sabbath... but also what happens when we add to God's word. (scrn 2)



Once again my friends, when we add pagan Easter rabbits and pagan toy gods and tooth fairies and cupids and flying reindeer and Krampus elves, and a first day of the week Sunday Sabbath created by the Pope of Rome to God's word... we are indeed creating abominations within the house of God. And those abominations once again do indeed require desolation. And there should be no doubt in our minds that this is exactly what is going to happen to today's over 50,000 different Christian denominational empires around the world today when our Messiah returns. (scrn 3)



They will be among those people proudly proclaiming that they have prophesied in his name and have cast out demons in his name and have done all these mighty works in his name only to have our Messiah look them in the eye and tell them that he doesn't even know them because they are lawless. It will be these people who have sat in these denominational empires that will be shocked to find out that they will be counted with the lost because they did not read the book for themselves!

There is only one truth, there is only one Yehovah God, there is only one plan of salvation, there is only one Messiah and King, there is only one Jerusalem, there is only one Father, and there is only one door that every man, woman, and child must walk through. And anyone who teaches anything else is clearly adding to the word of God and taking away from the word of God. And just as we are told here in the 30<sup>th</sup> chapter of the book of Proverbs, our Father in heaven will indeed rebuke those who do such things and, in the end, they will indeed be found to be liars. (scrn 4 show)

Psa 18:30 This God—his way is perfect; the word of the Yehovah proves true he is a shield for all those who take refuge in him.
Psa 18:31 For who is God, but the Yehovah And who is a rock, except our Elohim?—
Psa 18:32 the Elohim who equipped me with strength and made my way blameless

Once again, is written that the word of Yehovah proves true and he is a shield for all those who take refuge in him. You might be able to kill the body, but you will never be able to kill the soul because once again it is indeed the soul that is shielded by Yehovah our Elohim. And it is this Elohim who is Yehovah that is the rock that we stand upon. We must always remember that God's word is God. The word that Yehovah speaks is the rock that our Messiah became in the flesh because of his obedience to that word. And our Messiah calls us to pick up our crosses and to follow him and to do as he did and to walk as he walked so that the word of God may also be in us just as it was in him. And by doing as our Messiah commands us to do... we also are expected to become the word of God... this is what makes us one with Yehovah God himself just as our Messiah was one with Yehovah God himself.

These things are not difficult to understand unless we have been preprogrammed to believe otherwise which once again leads us right back to adding to God's word and taking away from God's word and the fact that those who do such things will be rebuked and found to be liars. Not

says I, but says our God breathed Scripture.

All of these things are tremendously important to understand when reading down through Matthew chapter 24. And why is that?

I simply cannot tell you how many different man-made theologies and philosophies and denominational dogmas have been concocted by men who have done nothing more than add to God's word in order to uphold their own authority over what is written within these God breathed Scriptures that have been handed down to us by our Messiah.


And therefore... keeping all of this in mind, and being careful not to add to God's word, let us now examine Matthew chapter 24 versus 29 through 31 E1

## The Coming of the Son of Man

Mat 24:29 "Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. Mat 24:30 Then will appear in heaven the sign of the Son of Man, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. Mat 24:31 And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.


Right here in Matthew chapter 24 verse 29 through 34 our Messiah tells us explicitly when he is going to return. He tells us very clearly in Matthew chapter 24 verse 29 that he will return immediately after the tribulation of those days. And therefore, we as true God-fearing, Messiah following, cross bearing Christians can indeed know and understand that our Messiah will not return until... after the tribulation.

Once again, if we are going to abide by the rule of law which is that Yehovah God's word is true... and if we truly do believe that our Messiah came not to speak his own word but his Father's word... then we can know that our Messiah is not going to return until after the tribulation of those days. And just what is this tribulation that our Messiah speaks of? Once again, we can find that by backing up just a few Scriptures to Matthew chapter 24 versus 21 and 22 (scrn 5)



This is a tribulation... a time of trouble if you will... that will be so great that it has never been seen before and will never be seen again. In fact, our Messiah tells us that this time is going to be such a terrible time that if those days had not been cut short no human being would be left alive. But... once again, our Messiah tells us that for the sake of the elect who will clearly still be here teaching and preaching his word through it all... those days will be cut short.

And so therefore, let us take a moment to recap what it is that we have been told by our Messiah so far. (scrn 6 show)



The very first thing that our Messiah tells us is not to allow anyone else to lead us astray. And this may seem like a very quick and small verse, but I would submit to you that everything else hinges on number one. Because if we are led astray then nothing else matters because we will be counted as unworthy.

And therefore, number one is indeed the most important. And then our Messiah tells us that the birth pains will begin, and this has to do with false Christ's, wars and rumors of wars, the saints being put to death and hated by all nations for his namesake which leads us to number three.

The third thing that our Messiah tells us will happen is that lawlessness will be increased causing the love of many to grow cold. But here once again, our Messiah tells us that he who endures to the end (get that my friends)... he who endures to the end will be saved. And again, you can find that in Matthew chapter 24 verse 13.

The fourth thing that our Messiah tells us that will happen is the abomination of desolation that will take place spoken of by the prophet Daniel. And once again, because we know that abomination is what caused the desolation of the first two temples... we should be able to understand that it will be because of the abomination in the house of God today.... that this desolation will also be required to come.


It is always abomination that leads to desolation. You cannot have desolation without abomination. And I tell you the truth my friends, the very reason that all of this must take place is because of the abominations of men who have brought this desolation upon themselves because they did not stand upon the rock that is the word of God. But instead, they have decided to willfully and intentionally add to God's word and to take away from God's word. And this is exactly why this abomination of desolation that is yet to come will indeed come just like it came for the house of Israel during the days of Moses and the prophets. (scrn 6 again)

And it is because of these abominations that the desolation will begin which brings us to number five where our Messiah tells us that there will once again be a great and final tribulation. And the sixth thing that our Messiah tells us is that these false messiahs will continue to rise just like they had risen from the very beginning. And they will continue to come proclaiming themselves to be the Messiah until the true Messiah finally returns which will once again be after the tribulation of those days when his angels blow the last and 7<sup>th</sup> trumpet blast. And the very reason that he will come is because if he did not come, there would be no flesh left alive on earth. This is the end my friends and this is why it is the last trump. But for the sake of the elect... who will still be fighting this war... those days will be cut short, and our Messiah will return.


And this brings us down to Matthew chapter 24 versus 29 through 31 where our Messiah tells us very clearly once again that he just like his Father will indeed come in darkness when the sun will be darkened and the moon will not give its light and the stars will fall from heaven.

Once again my friends, there cannot be a new beginning without


darkness first. Darkness always comes first. Man is born into darkness and then comes to the light. A day begins in darkness at sundown and then the light comes. It is written in the beginning, that the earth was without form and void and darkness was over the face of the deep and there was no light until God said... let there be light. (scrn 7 show)




It is written in first Kings chapter 8 that Yehovah has said that he would dwell in thick darkness. Yehovah has always dwelt in thick darkness. Every time we see a reference of Yehovah being present we see him in a thick cloud full of darkness. (scrn 8)



And this is exactly why darkness is always how the beginning is portrayed. (scrn 9)



We must remember that our Father in heaven is not a man. (scrn 10)



And it is because God is not a man, that he does not have human eyeballs that perceive darkness and light as we human beings do. **Psalms chapter 139 verses 11 and 12 (scrn 11)** 

Psa 139:11 If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light about me be night,"
Psa 139:12 even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is bright as the day, for darkness is as light with you.



And therefore, we should be able to better understand why it is that the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light and the stars will fall from heaven. Yeshua who is the only begotten Son of God will indeed return to the earth just like his Father when his Father created the earth... in darkness. **Deuteronomy chapter 4 verses 11 through 14** (scrn 12)

**Deu 4:11** And you came near and stood at the foot of the mountain, while the mountain burned with fire to the heart of heaven, wrapped in darkness, cloud, and gloom.

**Deu 4:12** Then the LORD spoke to you out of the midst of the fire. You heard the sound of words, but saw no form; there was only a voice.

**Deu 4:13** And he declared to you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, that is, the Ten Utterances, and he wrote them on two tablets of stone.

**Deu 4:14** And the LORD commanded me at that time to teach you statutes and rules, that you might do them in the land that you are going over to possess.



Once again, Moses is referring to Exodus chapters 19 and 20 when Yehovah literally came down in person to utter his testimony to the house of Israel. And once again we see here in Deuteronomy chapter 4 verse 11 that Yehovah God was again wrapped in darkness in a cloud.

These 10 utterances of Yehovah God also known as his testimony are what the church today calls the 10 Commandments. And although they are 10 Commandments, it should be understood that these 10 utterances or commandments are an index to the law of God.

Just as any book has an index, so too does God's law have an index. And

these 10 utterances, this testimony of Yehovah God was given by Yehovah God to encapsulate his law which would be given to Moses to give to the people of Israel. And once again, this was a new beginning for God's people and this is why Yehovah God came down from Mount Sinai in a cloud in thick darkness to give his word, his Torah, his law, his light... to his people.

What is our Messiah doing right here in Matthew chapter 24 verse 29 through 31? He is once again coming in thick darkness to establish his Father's word, is Torah, his Father's law upon the earth so that the earth can once again be filled with light!

And it is clearly written in Matthew chapter 24 verse 30 that when the tribes of the earth see the sign of the Son of Man coming... that they will mourn. Why will they mourn? Because they will know at that very moment that they have chosen the wrong God to follow. They will know that they are indeed doomed. And it is written at this point in time immediately after the tribulation of those days, when the sun will be darkened and the moon will not give its light and the stars will fall from heaven, and the nations are mourning because of their guilt, that our Messiah tells us that he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call. My friends this will be the last trumpet call. **First Corinthians chapter 15 verses 51 through 52 (scrn 13)** 

**1Co 15:51** Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

**1Co 15:52** in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed.

## First Thessalonians chapter 4 verses 16 and 17 (scrn 14)

**1Th 4:15** For this we declare to you by a word from the Lord, that we who are alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep.

**1Th 4:16** For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.

**1Th 4:17** Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord.

**Revelation chapter 11 verses 15 through 19 E2**

### The Seventh Trumpet

Rev 11:15 Then the seventh angel blew his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he shall reign forever and ever." Rev 11:16 And the twenty-four elders who sit on their thrones before God fell on their faces and worshiped God,

Rev 11:17 saying, "We give thanks to you, Lord God Almighty, who is and who was, for you have taken your great power and begun to reign. **Rev 11:18** The nations raged, but your wrath came, and the time for the dead to be judged, and for rewarding your servants, the prophets and saints, and those who fear your name, both small and great, and for destroying the destroyers of the earth."

Rev 11:19 Then God's temple in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant was seen within his temple. There were flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, an earthquake, and heavy hail.

Immediately after the tribulation of those days he will command his angels to be sent out with a loud trumpet call. In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump, the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command with the voice of an archangel and with the sound of the trumpet of God and the dead in the Messiah will rise first. When the seventh angel blows his trumpet, the world will become the kingdom of our Lord and of our Messiah and he shall reign forever and ever.

My friends this is not me saying these things, this is your God breathed Scripture saying these things. And we ought to get it straight.

Man can say whatever man wants to say. Man can write whatever man wants to write. Man can make movies about what ever man wants to make movies about. Man can create Talmud's and Mishnah's and scrolls and dogmas and theologies and philosophies and all the hermeneutics that his human heart desires to create. But what man cannot do... what man cannot do... is to erase one crossing of a "t" or one dotting of an "i" from the word of Yehovah God.

No matter what man writes... no matter what man says... no matter how many movie man makes, or how many pages of nonsense that the sages have written... no matter what man proclaims to the end of the earth... he will in no way ever have the ability to make void one dotting of an "i" or one crossing of a "t" of God's word.

I tell you the truth my friends you can believe what you want. Yehovah God has given you that privilege. Yehovah God himself has given you that ability. We can think what we want to think, we can believe what we want to believe, we can serve who it is that we want to serve, but there is only one truth that leads to life. There is only one God, one Son, one word, one way, one God-given plan of salvation, and one door that will lead us back to our Father in heaven where we have come from and where we belong. And anything short of that truth... is no truth of it at all.

A mixing and mingling of God's word is not God's word. A mixing and mingling of the truth with lies does not lead to salvation. A mixing and mingling of God's word is an abomination that will always lead to desolation. And it will indeed be this abomination that the church today has created for itself that will indeed lead to the desolation of today's modern-day church and her multitude of denominational empires of dirt along with her mother church of Rome.

We are commanded to study to show ourselves approved. We are commanded to renew our minds daily. We are commanded to pick up our crosses and to follow our Messiah and to do as he did and to walk as he walked. We all should be able to teach in the Synagogues. We all should be able to say if you've seen me you've seen my Father. We all should be able to give an account for what we believe.

The "if" equals "then" concept of Yehovah God has been laid out for us from the very beginning. **Deuteronomy chapter 30 verses 11 through 20 E3** 

### The Choice of Life and Death

Deu 30:11 "For this commandment that I command you today is not too hard for you, neither is it far off.

Deu 30:12 It is not in heaven, that you should say, 'Who will ascend to heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?'

Deu 30:13 Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, 'Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?'

Deu 30:14 But the word is very near you. It is in your mouth and in your heart, so that you can do it.

Deu 30:15 "See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil.

Deu 30:16 If you obey the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you today, by loving the LORD your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, then you shall live and multiply, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it.

Deu 30:17 But <mark>if your heart turns away</mark>, and you will not hear, but are drawn away to worship other gods and serve them,

Deu 30:18 I declare to you today, that you shall surely perish. You shall not live long in the land that you are going over the Jordan to enter and possess.

Deu 30:19 I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live,

Deu 30:20 loving the LORD your God, obeying his voice and holding fast to him, for he is your life and length of days, that you may dwell in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them."

If you obey equals then you shall live. If your heart turns away equals then you shall perish. Sounds pretty clear to me. What say you?

And with that I can find no better place to close our study for this seventh day Sabbath.

There is much to know and much to understand. And I would contend that we as modern-day Christians are indeed behind the proverbial Eightball. Most of us are behind in our studies. Most of us are behind in our understanding. Most of us are behind in our worship and the knowledge that we ought to have by now.

And I would submit to you that this is exactly why we need to go back and to brush off that dusty old Bible and turn to page 1 so that we can allow our Father in heaven to reintroduce himself to us and the plan of salvation that he has laid out from the first page of his Bible to the last page of his Bible which is indeed... God breathed.

And with that being said my friends as we close this session into Matthew chapter 24, we will pick up where we left off next seventh day Sabbath at 11 AM Eastern standard Time.

Until then I will once again ask everyone within the sound of my voice to please take what you have heard here today to your own prayer closet. Bow your head and bend your knee and face the holy promised land of Jerusalem and ask in the name of Yeshua Hamashiach if what you have heard here today be true or not.

Ask, seek, and knock on his door and on his door alone so that the proper door can be opened to you. And if you will do that, and if you will stay the course, you and I will surely walk through the gates of his soon coming kingdom together.
