




Matthew Chapter 27e

The Lonely Death of The Lamb

Once again, I'd just like to say welcome to everybody this morning and thank you for sharing your time with us as we move into the fifth part of Matthew chapter 27 concerning the death, and the burial of our Messiah Yeshua (also known as Jesus in the Greek).

Over the past month or so we've talked in some detail about the political wrangling and the unlawful court system that our Messiah was forced to endure before he could ever even get to the cross itself. And we made mention of the false high priests who were running the temple at that time and the Pharisees who were the pastors and the priests of his time who were indeed the children of the devil who wanted nothing more than to outright murder our Messiah in cold blood. And before we ever even get started in our study this morning into Matthew chapter 27, I would like for us to once again concentrate on the very **first verse of Matthew chapter 27 (scrn 1)**



Mat 27:1 When morning came, all the chief priests and the elders of the people took counsel against Jesus to put him to death.



Once again, according to the very first verse of Matthew chapter 27 these chief priests and these elders of the people had no interest in a fair and just hearing or a fair and just court of law. These false priests and these wicked elders of the people were not interested in getting to the bottom of whether or not Yeshua was the Messiah or not. All that they were interested in was putting him to death.

And I want us to think about that for just a few moments because once again I would submit to you that nothing has changed today in our time.


Often times when someone stands up and speaks the truth, our society today brands and labels them as conspiracy theorists or claims that the person speaking the truth is attempting to take away their personal rights and therefore, they should not be allowed to speak. And this is exactly what was going on in our Messiah's time.

These vanity filled high priests and elders of the people who were really no high priests at all once again were trying as diligently as they could to cover up the truth.

I cannot tell you how many times throughout history that people who were speaking the truth were silenced by either being jailed, tortured, or outright murdered. During the dark ages whole societies of people were tortured and murdered for speaking the truth about the Bible during the Roman Catholic inquisitions when the devil's army of Christians were doing the exact same thing that the chief priests and the elders were doing right here in Matthew chapter 27 in trying to silence those who were speaking the truth of God's word.

And I want to be very clear here this morning; the truth is the truth is the truth. I don't care if it's political truth, I don't care if it's theological truth, I don't care if it's historical truth, the truth belongs to Yehovah. And no matter what truth is being spoken, you can be guaranteed that that truth is directly tied to the creator of the heavens and the earth who is... truth.

When we tell a lie of any kind, when we try to silence the truth or distort the truth... when we try to hide the truth, when we speak anything other than the unadulterated truth... we find ourselves serving the creature and not the creator. And it doesn't matter once again whether it is political truth, or whether it is theological truth, or whether it's the truth concerning UFOs, or the truth about the birth of our Messiah and his birthdate, or the truth about Moses and the law of Yehovah God. The truth is the truth is the truth and anything short of the truth is indeed... a lie and qualifies as "sin" **first John chapter 3 verse four (scrn 2)**




1Jn 3:4 Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.



And this is extremely important for us to understand as Christians today in our time because once again... we are living at the end of the age. There are already and have been many false “anointed ones” who have made their way onto the world stage. Nation has been rising against nation and kingdom against kingdom and these wars and rumors of wars have grown exponentially in both strength and number as the world has grown smaller and smaller through man’s newfound religion of science and technology that clearly brings us all closer together for better or for worse.

Many of us have already been delivered up to be afflicted and to be killed for the name of our Messiah just as he prophesied that we would be. And the devil who is the Prince of the air is right now in our time diligently working with rulers and with authorities and with cosmic powers over this present darkness and along with spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places... to put us all to death because he knows that his time is short (**scrn 3**)



Rev 12:12 Therefore, rejoice, O heavens and you who dwell in them! But woe to you, O earth and sea, for the devil has come down to you in great wrath, because he knows that his time is short!”

You see, all of this has to do with Matthew chapter 27 and the death of our Messiah. The devil had clearly thought that by putting Yeshua to death he had finally murdered the human man that God said was going to crush his head in Genesis chapter 3 verse 15.

But what he didn't realize is that by murdering this human man who was the Lamb of God, that human man who was born of a human woman spoken of in Genesis chapter 3 verse 15 had just crushed his head.

You see the only weapon that our adversary has is sin. And if you remove the power of sin from the serpent, the serpent is no longer a serpent. The power of the great serpent which is “sin” that he uses to destroy a man was taken away from him upon the death of the Lamb of Yehovah God who served as a single sacrifice for the sins of all of mankind. Or at least those who would repent and return to the creator who is our Father in heaven.

Nevertheless, the world has indeed had the opportunity to repent. The olive branch of Yehovah God the creator was sent by Yehovah God in


order to fulfill his unfolding plan of salvation for mankind and we need not make any mistake about that. But... the point that needs to be seen here is that nothing has really changed between the time of our Messiah and our time. And this is crucial to understand. The very same deception is alive and well today in our time.

During the days of the chief priests and the Pharisees they were doing exactly the same thing that our mainstream news media and government officials and intelligence agencies are doing today concerning the truth.

If... back in our Messiah's day someone were to stand up and say, "stop! You've got it all wrong, Yeshua Jesus is the only begotten Son of God! The powers that be back in that day would have silenced that person by putting that person who was speaking the truth in a jail cell or worse. That person himself may have even found himself hanging on a cross next to our Messiah because of the truth that they had spoken.

You see, this is the danger of allowing others to dictate to us what the truth is and what disinformation is.

When we allow others to force us into believing what they believe, we no longer have the God-given free will of choice. Our ability to make up our own minds concerning the truth has been stolen from us. And there is absolutely no difference between what the priests and the elders were doing when Pilate offered up Barabbas instead of Yeshua by convincing the crowd to choose Barabbas instead of Yeshua... and what today's pastors and priests and politicians are doing. **Matthew chapter 27 verse 20 (scrn 4)**



Mat 27:20 Now the chief priests and the elders persuaded the crowd to ask for Barabbas and destroy Jesus.



The chief priests and the elders were those who were in charge, they were those who are in authority. What are those who are in charge and in authority doing today by manipulating the mainstream news media and literally putting words and phrases into their mouths? They are again persuading the crowds just like the chief priests and the elders were persuading the crowds to believe something that was indeed... a lie.

My friends, what we see here in Matthew chapter 27 is still going on today in our time. The truth is being traded for a lie and a lie for the truth. What is sweet is being traded for what is better and what is better for what is sweet. Make no mistake about it... when we relinquish our right to choose what we believe between good and evil, truth and deception, we are literally resigning ourselves as slaves to darkness.

Man knows in his heart of hearts the difference between good and evil. The only reason that man chooses evil is because it is what he loves. It is what his flesh wants. And it is for this reason that those who make themselves friends of the world make themselves enemies of God.

And once we resign ourselves to allowing others to think for us... and to tell us that their version of the truth is true because they say so...we wind up making ourselves friends of the world just like the crowds did that shouted for Barabbas instead of Yeshua.

I cannot tell you how dangerous the world has become through this wicked deception of truth versus disinformation according to Silicon Valley and today's mainstream news media all of which are owned and operated by evil men with evil intentions for the human population of the earth.

If we can teach nothing else here in Matthew chapter 27, it is indeed the difference between the truth and a lie and how important the truth is to seek out and to find and the God-given ability that we have been given in order to distinguish the difference between the truth and a lie if... if... And there's that humongous word again "if"... we truly seek knowledge by asking and seeking and knocking on his door and on his door alone.

And my friends let me be clear... the truth is not behind every door. Far too many human beings today believe that the truth can only be found within the mainstream news media that is ruled over by an emerging one world order to come. Far too many human beings today believe that their elected officials are their god's and that they would never lie to them. Far too many human beings believe that their doctors could not possibly be wrong about the drugs and the witches brew that their superiors command them to serve up on a daily basis. Never stopping to think about the clean and the unclean, or the commandment of Yehvoah God not to even touch what he has long ago designated as filthy and unclean abominations to him.

You see, there is no difference between the disinformation that was being spread as the truth by the chief priests and the Pharisees of our Messiah's time... and the disinformation that is now being spread as the truth by our mainstream news media and intelligence agencies of the world today in our time. All of them... all of them... are essentially

commanding us to choose... Barabbas.

The God-given right to search the Scripture and to seek the face of Yehovah God that he may give us his discernment and his truth is completely forbidden by far too many social media giants today in our time. You see, whatever they say is truth now, because you're too stupid to decide for yourself. And because you're too stupid to decide for yourself, just like the chief priests and the Pharisees of our Messiah's time... we are persuaded all the day long by the self-proclaimed wise... to choose... Barabbas.

And I would like us to keep these things in mind as we read down through the 27th chapter of the book of Matthew this morning and see exactly what it was that our Messiah died for because I tell you the truth... our Messiah died for... the truth. Our Messiah died to bring us the truth. The truth that man would not have. The truth that those in power would not have. The truth that many pastors and priests and bishops and popes and rabbis... do not have. The truth that many presidents and prime ministers and kings and queens of the earth do not have. And when we put our trust in these pastors and priests and bishops and popes and rabbis and presidents and prime ministers and kings and queens of the earth, and those who make billions of dollars off the backs of the poor... we willfully and intentionally put not only ourselves but our children and our children's children back into the chains of bondage that our Messiah came to free us from. **(scrn 5)**

Pro 18:13 If one gives an answer before he hears, it is his folly and shame.

Pro 18:15 An intelligent heart acquires knowledge, and the ear of the wise seeks knowledge.


Rom 1:21 For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened.

Rom 1:22 Claiming to be wise, they became fools,



How many people today will far too easily bow the knee to the mainstream news media and whatever they hear on TV without hearing both sides of the story? How many people today are doing their homework considering the matter and seeking out knowledge versus simply buying the snake oil that they see on TV? And how much money are these main stream media outlets raking in by deceiving people in matters that may even cost them their very lives?

Even today's modern-day pastors and priests and bishops and popes and rabbis and evangelists who all claim to be wise have indeed become... fools. And why? Because they are teaching the commandments of men and not the commandments of Yehovah God. You see the goal for them is to get you to choose... Barabbas. **First Thessalonians chapter 5 verses 20 through 22 (scrn 6)**



1Th 5:20 Do not despise prophecies,
1Th 5:21 but test everything; hold fast what is good.
1Th 5:22 Abstain from every form of evil.



My friends, no matter how outlandish an idea might sound... no matter how ridiculous a thing might seem... no matter how impossible something may be to believe... we must first acquire knowledge, we must first hear both sides of the story, we must first judge righteously concerning the matter for if we do not... not only is it a folly and ashamed for us, but it could also be the very end of our salvation and the salvation of our children and our children's children because we did not hear and we did not seek knowledge.

Once again it is written that God's people are destroyed for lack of knowledge because they have rejected knowledge. Not because they weren't given knowledge... but because they had rejected the knowledge that they had been given.

And therefore, as we read down through the 27th chapter of the book of Matthew it's important that we reflect on the dangers of allowing others to dictate to us what truth is and what truth is not. Disinformation can only be disinformation if the information is not true. And who is it exactly that decides and distinguishes the truth from disinformation? Is it

Silicon Valley? Is it NBC, or ABC, or CNN, or Fox or the FBI or the CIA or the DOJ? Is it a Doctor or a Priest, or a Pastor or a politician? Will you believe the chief priests and the majority leaders like the crowds did that chose Barabbas? Or will you first hear both sides of the story? Will you seek out the facts, and listen to those who are far more qualified in order to righteously distinguish the truth? Will you pray for the discernment of your Father in heaven and his only begotten Son so that you may know that you've made the correct decision? Will you test the spirits before making a decision in a matter?

Clearly... the crowds standing before Pilot... did not.

Our ability to hear and to decide and to weigh the evidence in a matter is a God given right not a man ordained right. And therefore... we as true God-fearing Messiah following cross bearing Christians ought not to look to the wisdom of men when making our decisions concerning anything... but the wisdom of Yehovah. And when we think that we know the answer concerning the truth of a matter... we ought to measure what we think that we know to our God breathed Scripture and test it through prayer and supplication.

Keeping all of this in mind I would like us to now turn this morning to Matthew chapter 27 verses 32 through 44 so that once again we can know exactly what it says and just as importantly, what it does not say.
Matthew chapter 27 verses 45 through 56 E1

The Death of Jesus

Mat 27:45 Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land until the ninth hour.

Mat 27:46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

Mat 27:47 And some of the bystanders, hearing it, said, "This man is calling Elijah."

Mat 27:48 And one of them at once ran and took a sponge, filled it with sour wine, and put it on a reed and gave it to him to drink.

Mat 27:49 But the others said, "Wait, let us see whether Elijah will come to save him."

Mat 27:50 And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice and yielded up his spirit.

Mat 27:51 And behold, the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. And the earth shook, and the rocks were split.

Mat 27:52 The tombs also were opened. And many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised,

Mat 27:53 and coming out of the tombs after his resurrection they went into the holy city and appeared to many.

Mat 27:54 When the centurion and those who were with him, keeping watch over Jesus, saw the earthquake and what took place, they were filled with awe and said, "Truly this was the Son of God!"

Mat 27:55 There were also many women there, looking on from a distance, who had followed Jesus from Galilee, ministering to him,

Mat 27:56 among whom were Mary Magdalene and Mary the mother of James and Joseph and the mother of the sons of Zebedee.

One of the first things that we see here in Matthew chapter 27 verse 45 is that it is written that from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land until the ninth hour which would have been from noon until 3 PM. And about the ninth hour (at about 3 PM in the afternoon) Yeshua cried out with a loud voice saying, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" And I would once again like to stop right here so that we can reflect upon exactly what was taking place at about 3 PM that very afternoon.

Matthew chapter 27 verse 46 is tectonically important to properly understand. Because those who do not understand the words that our Messiah spoke before he gave up his spirit will never truly understand who our Messiah was, and the prophecy that he was fulfilling at that exact moment in time. A prophecy that has everything to do with Yehovah God his Father crushing his only begotten Son by allowing him to be afflicted and to be wounded for a greater purpose. **Isaiah 53 verses 10 through 12 (scrn 7)**

Isa 53:10 Yet it was the will of the LORD to crush him; he has put him to grief; when his soul makes an offering for guilt, he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the LORD shall prosper in his hand .

Isa 53:11 Out of the anguish of his soul he shall see and be satisfied ; by his knowledge shall the righteous one, my servant, make many to be accounted righteous, and he shall bear their iniquities .

Isa 53:12 Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many , and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors .



Once again, when we read in Matthew chapter 27 verse 46 that our Messiah cried out, “Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?” that is, “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?” what we need to understand is that Yehovah God was no longer with Yeshua Jesus at that point in time. Yehovah left the human man Yeshua to die on his own accord for the sins of those he loved. And this is exactly why it is written that it was the will of Yehovah God his Father to crush him and to put him to grief.

And that word “crush” in the Hebrew language is the word “khaw-law” (challah) which means to be robbed or worn or afflicted, to grieve, to be put to pain, or to be wounded. This was something that our Messiah needed to endure alone in order to become the propitiation for the sins of his brothers and sisters.

Let there be no mistake about it, according to Scripture and Scripture alone, Yehovah God did indeed forsake his only begotten Son in order that just as we are told here in Isaiah chapter 53, his servant Yeshua, (Jesus and the Greek) could make many to be accounted righteous. In order for God’s servant “Yeshua” (Jesus) to make many be accounted righteous... he needed to bear their iniquities alone on that cross. And just as we are told in Isaiah chapter 53 verse 12... it was because he poured out his soul unto death and was numbered with the transgressors and because he bore the sin of many... he was able to make intercession for the transgressors that is... you and I and our children, and our children’s children.

There is no Trinity God here my friends. There is just the man Yeshua

Jesus hanging upon a tree. There is just a Father... and a Son. Who just like Abraham when he took Isaac to the top of Mount Moriah to sacrifice him for Yehovah God... was empowered by the love of God. And make no mistake about it, it was the sacrifice of Abraham the fact that Abraham was willing to give up his only begotten son Isaac who was chosen to be the blessed descendent of Abraham... that God knew that the heart that he had created within man was indeed created... perfectly.

At the moment that Abraham raised up his knife to plunge into the chest of Isaac his son upon that altar, Yehovah God knew at that moment in time without a doubt... that he had created a perfect heart within mankind. And even though Yehovah God stopped Abraham from sacrificing his only begotten son Isaac... Yehovah God would do for mankind what he would not allow mankind to do for him. For he so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever would believe in him would not perish but have eternal life. And Yehvoah allowed his human Son to willfully and intentionally lay down his own life without saying a word so that this perfect unblemished lamb of God could bear the sins of many.

“Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?” that is, “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”. These very words that our Messiah spoke once again qualified him to be the only begotten Son of God. These very words that our Messiah spoke once again qualified him to be our Passover lamb. These very words that our Messiah spoke once again qualified him as John the Baptist had said in John chapter 1 verse 29... “The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!”

And for those of you who do not understand the qualifications that our Father in heaven had put forth in order to qualify the Son of David to be the Messiah, I would like us to read about those qualifications once again in the Old Testament in **Psalms chapter 22 E2**

Why Have You Forsaken Me?

Psa 22:1 To the choirmaster: according to The Doe of the Dawn. A Psalm of David. My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me, from the words of my groaning?

Psa 22:2 O my God, I cry by day, but you do not answer, and by night, but I find no rest.

Psa 22:3 Yet you are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel.

Psa 22:4 In you our fathers trusted; they trusted, and you delivered them.

Psa 22:5 To you they cried and were rescued; in you they trusted and were not put to shame.

Psa 22:6 But I am a worm and not a man, scorned by mankind and despised by the people.

Psa 22:7 All who see me mock me; they make mouths at me; they wag their heads;

Psa 22:8 "He trusts in the LORD; let him deliver him; let him rescue him, for he delights in him!"

Psa 22:9 Yet you are he who took me from the womb; you made me trust you at my mother's breasts.

Psa 22:10 On you was I cast from my birth, and from my mother's womb you have been my God.

Psa 22:11 Be not far from me, for trouble is near, and there is none to help.

Psa 22:12 Many bulls encompass me; strong bulls of Bashan surround me;

Psa 22:13 they open wide their mouths at me, like a ravening and roaring lion.

Psa 22:14 I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint; my heart is like wax; it is melted within my breast;

Psa 22:15 my strength is dried up like a potsherd, and my tongue sticks to my jaws; you lay me in the dust of death.

Psa 22:16 For dogs encompass me; a company of evildoers encircles me; they have pierced my hands and feet—

Psa 22:17 I can count all my bones— they stare and gloat over me;

Psa 22:18 they divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots.

Psa 22:19 But you, O LORD, do not be far off! O you my help, come quickly to my aid!

Psa 22:20 Deliver my soul from the sword, my precious life from the power of the dog!

Psa 22:21 Save me from the mouth of the lion! You have rescued me from the horns of the wild oxen!

Psa 22:22 I will tell of your name to my brothers; in the midst of the

congregation I will praise you:

Psa 22:23 You who fear the LORD, praise him! All you offspring of Jacob, glorify him, and stand in awe of him, all you offspring of Israel!

Psa 22:24 For he has not despised or abhorred the affliction of the afflicted, and he has not hidden his face from him, but has heard, when he cried to him.

Psa 22:25 From you comes my praise in the great congregation; my vows I will perform before those who fear him.

Psa 22:26 The afflicted shall eat and be satisfied; those who seek him shall praise the LORD! May your hearts live forever!

Psa 22:27 All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the LORD, and all the families of the nations shall worship before you.

Psa 22:28 For kingship belongs to the LORD, and he rules over the nations.

Psa 22:29 All the prosperous of the earth eat and worship; before him shall bow all who go down to the dust, even the one who could not keep himself alive.

Psa 22:30 Posterity shall serve him; it shall be told of the Lord to the coming generation;


Psa 22:31 they shall come and proclaim his righteousness to a people yet unborn, that he has done it.

Notice that here in Psalms chapter 22 verse one we find exactly what our Messiah was thinking. “Why are you so far from saving me, from the words of my groaning?” Clearly, our Messiah the man Yeshua Jesus the descendent of David died alone on that cross. Like a worm he was scorned by mankind and despised by the people. They mocked him and they wag their heads at him casting lots for his clothes before him.

And I want us to notice in Psalms chapter 22 verse nine that is written that Yehovah God took him from the womb and made him trust God his Father. And notice in Psalms chapter 22 verse 10 it is written, and I quote, “On you was I cast from my birth and from my mother’s womb you have been my God.”

My friends there is no pagan Trinity God found here in Psalms chapter 22. There is one Father, and one Son who the Father gave just like Abraham was about to give Isaac... so that... whoever believes in him would not perish but have eternal life.

Let's be clear here, let's come to the knowledge of the truth so that we are not destroyed for lack of knowledge... there is no pagan Trinity God here within the confines of these God breathed Scripture. There is only a Father and his Son who was given by his Father so that whoever believes in him would not perish but have eternal life. And anything short of that is nothing more than blasphemy against the Father who gave his only begotten Son and the Son who willfully and intentionally laid his life down for the love of his brothers. **John chapter 15 verses 13 through 15 (scrn 9)**



And so the question then becomes, what have we learned here this morning? What have our eyes seen and our ears heard from these God breathed Scripture that speak nothing but... the truth?

I tell you the truth, it's time to audit our faith. It's time to ask ourselves why we believe what we believe. It's time to ask ourselves whether or not we are adding to God's word or taking away from God's word which is a sin according to Yehvoah God himself. It's time to test the spirits.

It's time to make our paths straight for the return of the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world.

It's time.

Let us not be destroyed for lack of knowledge because we have rejected knowledge. And let us not shrink back and be destroyed because we have allowed the oil in our lamps to run dry. Let us not be found sleeping so that at his return we will be wide-eyed and awake and at the ready. For we are not in darkness brothers for that day to surprise us like a thief, for we are all children of the light, children of the day, and we are not of the night or of the darkness. And therefore, let us put on the breastplate of faith and love and for a helmet the hope of salvation. For I tell you the truth... our redemption is closer now than when we first believed.

Let us test... everything.

And with that being said, and with all of this knowledge under our belts, I will once again ask everyone within the sound of my voice to please take what you have heard here this morning to your own prayer closet. Bow your head and bend your knee, and face the holy promised land of Jerusalem, and ask in the name of Yeshua Hamashiach if what you have heard here this morning be true or not.

Ask, seek, and knock on his door and on his door alone so that the proper door can be opened to you. And if you will do that, and if you will stay the course to the end... You and I will surely walk through the gates of his soon coming kingdom together.
