

Matthew Chapter 27f The Burial, Tomb & Resurrection!

Once again before we get started into this most important topic of Scripture here this morning, I would just like to just say welcome and thank you so very much for sharing your time with us here this morning because what we are going to be talking about here this morning is extremely important concerning the very definition of faith and exactly what it is that we as true God fearing, Messiah following, cross bearing Christians believe in.

Today many Christian denominational empires toss around the word's "faith" and "belief" very nonchalantly and very haphazardly. Never really defining what faith is according to Scripture or what belief is according to Scripture.

According to them... both faith and belief simply require a repentant soul to confess with their lips that Jesus is the Son of God. And once this task is completed, your free ticket into the kingdom of heaven is punched and you are once saved always saved, because God loves you so much more than the prophets and so much more than the apostles, and so much more than his only begotten Son... that you don't have to be bothered with anything else. (scrn 1 show only)

Act 21:23 Do therefore what we tell you (Paul). We have four men who are under a vow;

Act 21:24 take these men and purify yourself along with them and pay their expenses, so that they may shave their headsThus all will know that there is nothing in what they have been told about you, (Paul) but that you yourself also live in observance of the law.

You see, you don't have to be bothered with keeping his commandments, because his commandments have all been made a curse by the church today who now claims that the very spoken word of God which is his word his Torah... has become null and void and was nothing more than a big mistake in the eyes of the apostle Paul who... who... the Bible tells us in Acts chapter 21 verse 24... always lived in observance of the law.

Isn't it interesting... how when we read the Bible for ourselves these extremely critical pieces of the puzzle leap off the pages to make themselves known to the one who is asking, and seeking, and knocking on his door and on his door alone. I hope and I pray that you see the difference between those who are asking him and seeking him and knocking on his door and those who seek after men and the writings of men.

The idea that all one has to do is to confess with their lips that he is Lord in order to gain a free ticket into his kingdom is nothing more than a man-made doctrine of demons that has been propagated for generations

by wolves in sheep's clothing who loves to dress themselves up as angels of light. Once again, and we talk about this all the time... Consider what our Messiah tells us in **Matthew chapter 7 (scrn 2 show only)**

Those Who Yeshua (Jesus) Does Not Know...

Mat 7:21 "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.

Mat 7:22 On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?'

Mat 7:23 And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.'

Right here in Matthew chapter 7 according to our Messiah's very own red letter words he tells us very clearly that not everyone who calls him Lord is going to enter the kingdom of heaven.


And he goes on to tell us in Matthew chapter 7 verse 21 that the only one who is getting into his Father's kingdom is the one who is doing the will of his Father who is in heaven. Which pretty much throws to the ground this whole man-made concept of the law of God (which is God's word by the way) becoming null and void and even a curse. And there are many other scriptures like these that we could point to that once again throw to the ground the doctrine of demons that the inept and feckless church today is teaching and preaching. And it is a sad state of affair that we must continuously mention these things before reading our Bibles because so many have been led astray because they do not read

their Bibles.

And there is much more to say about this topic which we have spoken about many different times and will continue to talk about, but this morning I'd like to stay on track concerning the actual burial and resurrection of our Messiah which took place exactly... and let me repeat that... exactly... as he prophesied that it would. And not only exactly the way that he prophesied that it would... but also, exactly as the prophets prophesied that it would.

We must remember my friends that our Messiah never said that he was going to be crucified on a Roman Catholic created Good Friday. You simply will not find that demonic nonsense anywhere within the confines of the 66 books of the Bible. Our Messiah makes no mention of a Friday, but what he does make mention of is his Father's Passover.

Matthew chapter 26 verse two (scrn 3)



Right here in Matthew chapter 26 our Messiah tells us that he will be delivered up to be crucified on Passover day.

Now... I would like for us all to stop and think about what our Messiah prophesied right here in Matthew chapter 26 that the church today flat out denies and calls a lie by trading the very anniversary of the death of our Messiah on Passover day... for a Roman Catholic created "Good Friday".

And this is exactly what I'm talking about when I tell you that the church today has become apostate and feckless. The church today has become full of abominations that will ultimately lead it to desolation. And why? Because just like the rabbinical Pharisees of our Messiah's time had done... the church today has its own oral law that has added to and taken away from God's law. The church today has made void the word of God in order to hold onto their own traditions. The church today honors him with their lips while their hearts are far from him and they almost all worship him in vain... why?... Because they are teaching as doctrines the commandments of men and not the commandments of God. (scrn 4 show only)

Mat 23:15 Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you travel across sea and land to make a single proselyte, and when he becomes a proselyte, you make him twice as much a child of hell as yourselves.

And as we have said so many different times before this is exactly why our Messiah called the rabbinical Pharisees of his time children of the devil who would cross over land and sea to make one follower and when they did, they would make that follower twice as much a child of hell as themselves.


You see, before we can ever even get into Matthew chapter 27 verses 57 through 66 which tells us about the burial and the tomb of our Messiah, we must have a complete understanding of the anniversary of his death and exactly what the anniversary of his death is according to Scripture. (scrn 5)



Because if we set ourselves within the pews of today's apostate and feckless churches, we will find ourselves worshiping another god. A god only found within the laws and the commandments and dogmas and the precepts of Roman Catholicism that has by and large swept all of today's protestant churches who no longer protest against anything... back under her wicked umbrella. (scrn 6)



Every pagan tradition and festival that the church keeps today is nothing more than propaganda that has been concocted and propagated by the Roman Catholic Church in order to do exactly what the prophet Daniel told us that this beast would do thousands of years ago. (scrn 7 show only)



Once again, the prophet Daniel warned us about this beast. And he warned us that this beast would think to change the times and the law of God. And if we know nothing else about Roman Catholicism... it is that this harlot has thought to change the times and the law of Yehovah God. And the protestant churches who no longer protest against anything... who have been infiltrated by the Roman Catholic Jesuit Army of the Pope of Rome who himself today is also a Jesuit... has done a brilliant job of bringing almost all of the original protestant denominational churches back under the umbrella of this harlot that rides the beast.

And therefore, as we read down through Matthew chapter 27 this morning, it's imperative that we understand who our example is. And to to be sure... our example is not, and I repeat not... the church. Our example was set by our Messiah who is the one and only mediator between God and man.

It's important that we understand this timeline of the death, burial, and the resurrection of our Messiah so that we are not led astray by being tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine and by human cunning and craftiness and deceitful scheme. (scrn 8 show only)

Eph 4:11 And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers,

Eph 4:12 to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ,

Eph 4:13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ,

Eph 4:14 so that we may no longer be children, tossed to andfro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes

And I want us to notice right here in Ephesians chapter 4 that it is written that he gave the apostles and the prophets and the evangelists and the shepherds and the teachers. But nowhere do you see the rabbi listed... and nowhere do you see the Pope of Rome listed. Why? Because neither the rabbinical Pharisee nor the Pope of Rome has anything to do with the truth and only the truth. (scrn 9 show only)

Mat 23:8 But you are not to be called rabbi, for you have one master (kathegetes), and you are all brothers.

Mat 23:9 And call no man your father on earth, for you have one Father, who is in heaven.

Mat 23:10 Neither be called masters (kathegetes), for you have one master (kathegetes), , the Christ.

Mat 23:11 The greatest among you shall be your servant.

Our very own Messiah tells us very clearly that we are not to be called rabbis for we have one master, and we are all brothers. And he tells us not to call any man on earth our spiritual father like the Roman Catholic priest do because we have one spiritual Father who is in heaven. And our Messiah goes on to tell us once again that we are no one's masters and that we all have one master who is the Messiah. (scrn 10)



The greatest among us must indeed be a servant and not... and I repeat not... a master sitting on a golden throne demanding the ignorant and unstudied to bow down and kiss our golden ring.

You see, there is a truth that has been handed down by Yehovah God the Creator of the heavens and the earth. But that truth that has been handed down by him has been maliciously disconnected, trampled upon, and made a mockery of... by those who love to dress themselves up as angels of light in order to fool if possible even the very elect. (scrn 11 show only)

God Says:

"For this commandment that I command you today is not too hard for you, neither is it far off. It is not in heaven, that you should say, 'Who will ascend to heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, 'Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' But the word is very near you. It is in your mouth and in your heart, so that you can do it.

Yeshua (Jesus) Says:

The Pharisees, who were lovers of money, heard all these things, and they ridiculed him. And he said to them, "You are those who justify yourselves before men, but God knows your hearts. For what is exalted among men is an abomination in the sight of God. "The Law and the Prophets were until John; since then the good news of the kingdom of God is preached, and everyone forces his way into it. But it is easier for heaven and earth to pass away than for one dot of the Law to become void.

Deu 30:11-14

Luke 16:14-17

Man Says:


The Law has been done away with and you cannot keep it, and if you do you are under a curse!

Who's Right And Who's Wrong? Choose this day whom it is that you will serve...



When we take a look at the Old Testament, we see that our Father in heaven tells us that his commandment is not too hard for us. Our Father in heaven tells us in the book of Deuteronomy chapter 30 that we can do his law because it's in our mouth and in our hearts so that we can do it. And in the New Testament our Messiah tells us once again in the book of Luke just as he did in the 23rd chapter of the book of Matthew... that it is what is exalted among men that is an abomination in the sight of God. And I want us to think about that for just a moment.

What does our Messiah say is an abomination in the sight of God? Our Messiah says that it is what is exalted among men that is an abomination in the sight of God according to Luke chapter 16. And so we must ask ourselves... what is being exalted among men today? (scrn 12 show only)



Christ mass, and Easter, and all saint's day, tooth fairies and cupids and Roman Catholic toy god's and demonically inspired Krampus elves, all... all... are being exulted by men today. And I tell you the truth... these things that are being exulted by men today in our time are indeed just as our Messiah tells us in the sixteenth chapter of the book of Luke an abomination in the sight of Yehovah God. And why?

Because once again, they honor him with their lips while their hearts are far from him. They worship our Messiah and our Father in heaven in vain. And why? Because they are teaching as doctrines the commandments of men and not the commandments of Yehovah God the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. And just as our Messiah tells us in Luke chapter 16, it is easier for heaven and earth to pass away than for one dot of the law to become void. And I tell you the truth... the ignorant and the unstudied will indeed pass away like dust from the earth for it is written... that God's people are destroyed for lack of knowledge because they have rejected knowledge.

Keeping all of these things in mind, let us now turn to Matthew chapter

27 verses 57 through 66 so that we can read the truth about the burial and the tomb of our Messiah who did indeed die for our transgressions on Passover day just exactly as he prophesied that he would in Matthew chapter 26 verse two. Let's read for ourselves **Matthew chapter 27** verses 57 through 66 E1

Jesus Is Buried

Mat 27:57 When it was evening, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who also was a disciple of Jesus.

Mat 27:58 He went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. Then Pilate ordered it to be given to him.

Mat 27:59 And Joseph took the body and wrapped it in a clean linen shroud

Mat 27:60 and laid it in his own new tomb, which he had cut in the rock.

And he rolled a great stone to the entrance of the tomb and went away.

Mat 27:61 Mary Magdalene and the other Mary were there, sitting opposite the tomb.

The Guard at the Tomb

Mat 27:62 The next day, that is, after the day of Preparation, the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered before Pilate


Mat 27:63 and said, "Sir, we remember how that impostor said, while he was still alive, 'After three days I will rise.'

Mat 27:64 Therefore order the tomb to be made secure until the third day, lest his disciples go and steal him away and tell the people, 'He has risen from the dead,' and the last fraud will be worse than the first."

Mat 27:65 Pilate said to them, "You have a guard of soldiers. Go, make it as secure as you can."

Mat 27:66 So they went and made the tomb secure by sealing the stone and setting a guard.

(scrn 13)



What's important to understand is the timeline of the death, the burial, and the resurrection of our Messiah who was indeed in the earth for three days and for three nights just as he once again prophesied that he would be. And we have many studies concerning this biblical timeline including studies that we have done here in the book of Matthew earlier on. And therefore, if you have never sat down and mapped out the timeline of the death, burial, and resurrection of our Messiah who would have been crucified on a Thursday and not on a Friday... you really do need to take the time to go back and view those video studies and to cross-reference them with the Scripture found in your Bible. Because once again my friends, those who will be destroyed for lack of knowledge will not be destroyed because they were not given knowledge... but they will be destroyed because they have rejected the knowledge that was given to them. **E1 show again**

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And so, here we have a disciple of our Messiah by the name of Joseph from Arimathea boldly going before Pilate and asking for the body of Yeshua which would have been a big deal back in that day.

We must remember that the very reason that they just crucified our Messiah was because that he said that he was the king of the Jews and the only begotten Son of God, Son of David, Son of Abraham.

And therefore, for Joseph of Arimathea to have come before Pilate that Thursday afternoon in order to request the body of a man that people were worshiping as the Son of God and the King of the Jews could have very well gotten Joseph of Arimathea himself hung on a cross for even having anything to do with this man.

And so, I don't want us to think that what Joseph of Arimathea did was some small matter. Joseph of Arimathea put his life on the line to go before Pilate and ask for the body of Yeshua so that he could honor Yeshua by putting him in his own tomb.

It's important that we make note of the fact that the remains of an executed criminal back in those days were often times left unburied or at best put in a dishonored place in a Poppers field. But in order for the Scripture to be fulfilled, what Joseph of Arimathea was doing had to come to fruition. Let's take a look at a couple of very important Scriptures from the Old Testament that literally qualify our Messiah to be our Messiah. Once again, Yeshua Jesus in the Greek can only be the only begotten Son of God if he has fulfilled the word of God in the Old Testament concerning him.

All of the qualifiers that qualify our Messiah to be our Messiah are found in the Old Testament not in the New Testament and we must always remember this. It is these Old Testament prophecies that qualify our Messiah to be our Messiah and identify him without question. (scrn 14 show only)

Luk 24:44 Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled."

Luk 24:45 Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures,

Luk 24:46 and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead

Luk 24:47 and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from

And this is exactly why our Messiah told us here in Luke chapter 24 that everything written about him in the law of Moses and the prophets, and the Psalms must... and I repeat must... be fulfilled. Not says I... but

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says our very own Messiah in his very own red-letter words.

And therefore, once again, as we have just said before, so we now say again... everything that we find in the law of Moses and written by the prophets and in the Psalms must be fulfilled by this man who claims to be the only begotten Son of God because what was written in the law of Moses and by the prophets and in the Psalms are indeed God-given qualifiers that our Father in heaven gave to us in order to properly identify this offspring of a human woman that would come to crush the head of the serpent.

And therefore, in order for our Messiah to be our Messiah, what was taking place here in Matthew chapter 27 by Joseph of Arimathea needed to take place so that the prophecy may be fulfilled and so that we can acknowledge the God-given fact that Yeshua Hamashiach is indeed the only begotten Son of God, the Lamb of God, who died as our sacrificial lamb on Passover day exactly as he prophesied that he would be. Let's take a look at a couple of Old Testament Scripture here this morning. And I'd like to start with **Deuteronomy chapter 21 verses 22 and 23 (scrn 15)**

Deu 21:22 "And if a man has committed a crime punishable by death and he is put to death, and you hang him on a tree,

Deu 21:23 his body shall not remain all night on the tree, but you shall bury him the same day, for a hanged man is cursed by God. You shall not defile your land that the LORD your God is giving you for an inheritance.

You see, the very reason that they had to get our Messiah down off of that cross (that was made out of a tree) was because it was commanded that if any man committed a crime punishable by death and he was hung on a tree, his body could not remain all-night on the tree and the commandment was that they had to bury him that same day. And therefore... anyone else who teaches anything different is indeed in great error. And I have heard many ignorant and unstudied people attempting to proclaim that it was okay to bury our Messiah after sundown the next day. This once again is nothing but man-made hooey and tomfoolery.

Our Messiah had to be taken down off of that tree and he had to be buried that same day according to Hebrew law which is once again the spoken word of Yehovah God that does indeed stand even to this day.

And I also want us to notice that it is written in Deuteronomy chapter 21 verse 23 that a hanged man, who was hanged on a tree is cursed by God. And I want us to also think about this for just a moment because I would also submit to you that this is just another qualifier that qualifies our Messiah to be our Messiah. **Isaiah chapter 53 verses nine and 10 (scrn**

HOLY IMPACT

Isa 53:9 And they made his grave with the wicked and with a rich man in his death, although he had done no violence, and there was no deceit in his mouth.

Isa 53:10 Yet it was the will of the LORD to crush him; he has put him to grief; when his soul makes an offering for guilt, he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.



Once again here in Isaiah chapter 53 we find another two very important qualifiers that qualify our Messiah to be our Messiah. The first qualifier is that they made his grave with the wicked and with a rich man in his death even though he had done no violence and there was no deceit in his mouth. And the second qualifier is indeed that it was the will of Yehovah God to crush him and to put him to grief so that his soul could make an offering for guilt.

Once again, Joseph of Arimathea was being used as an instrument to fulfill Isaiah chapter 53. They did indeed make our Messiah's grave with the wicked and with the rich man in his death.

We must remember that Joseph of Arimathea belonged to the Council that had our Messiah crucified. Although he himself did not agree with the Council in having our Messiah crucified, he was indeed part of that wicked counsel. And therefore, the fulfillment of Isaiah chapter 53 verse nine was indeed fulfilled by Joseph of Arimathea who was clearly part

of the wicked counsel that had crucified him when Joseph had taken his body and placed it in his own tomb.

And just as we read in Isaiah chapter 53 verse 10... it was indeed the will of Yehovah God to crush our Messiah and to put him to grief so that his soul could make an offering for guilt. (scrn 17 show only)

2Co 5:20 Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ be reconciled to God.

2Co 5:21 For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.



We must remember above all things that our Messiah was a human man. And according to second Corinthians chapter 5 verse 21, although he knew no sin... he became sin so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

And therefore, as we read down through Matthew chapter 27 it is indeed imperative that we understand what it is that we are reading and why these things had to take place in the exact time frame and in the exact order that they did. **E1 show again**

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
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Mat 27:66 So they went and made the tomb secure by sealing the stone and setting a guard.

And I also want us to once again notice that even the chief priests and the Pharisees who gathered before Pilate in order to have the tomb guarded knew full well that our Messiah had said that he would be in the earth for three days and for three nights. Not two days and two nights from Friday to Sunday, but for three days and for three nights. Which once again destroys a Good Friday crucifixion that has been concocted once again by the apostate church of Rome. (scrn 18)



Our Messiah died just as he prophesied that he would on Passover day because he was, is, and always will be our Passover lamb according to first Corinthians chapter 5 verse seven and not our Easter ham according to Roman Catholicism. Which means that according to the Scripture and the Scripture alone our Messiah would've died on a Thursday afternoon which would have been day one. He was put in the tomb before dark that day which would have been day one and night one Thursday night.


Because that Thursday would have been preparation Day in preparation for the Passover meal and the feast of unleavened bread which followed immediately after, Friday would have been a high Sabbath day when no work was to be done which is different from the Sabbath day. (scrn 19 show only)

Lev 23:6 And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the Feast of Unleavened Bread to the LORD; for seven days you shall eat unleavened bread.

Lev 23:7 On the first day you shall have a holy convocation you shall not do any ordinary work.

Lev 23:8 But you shall present a food offering to the LORD for seven days. On the seventh day is a holy convocation you shall not do any ordinary work."

According to Leviticus chapter 23 verses six through eight once the feast of unleavened bread begins that first day would have been a high Sabbath when no work was to be done and then also on the seventh day at the end of the feast of unleavened bread you had another high Sabbath when no work was to be done. (scrn 20)



And therefore, that Friday would have been a high Sabbath, and this was another reason why they had to get our Messiah down off of that tree and into the tomb before sundown. This was not only commanded in Deuteronomy chapter 21 verse 23 concerning a man who is hanged on a tree, but it was also commanded in Leviticus chapter 23 verses six through eight because that next day Friday would have been what was known as a high Sabbath day. **John chapter 19 verse 31 (scrn 21)**

Joh 19:31 Since it was the day of Preparation, and so that the bodies would not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (for that Sabbath was a high day), the Jews asked Pilate that their legs might be broken and that they might be taken away.



And so, according to the Apostle John... the very next day after preparation Day which was in preparation for the Passover meal that was to be eaten at twilight... was indeed a high Sabbath day not the seventh day Sabbath mind you... but what was known as a high Sabbath when no work was to be done.

Once again my friends when you understand the Passover, and you understand God's feast days and what they represent and who they point to, and when you understand that our Messiah was being crucified at the exact same time that the Passover lambs were being slaughtered at the temple that day... and that it is written in the New Testament in first Corinthians chapter 5 verse seven that our Messiah is indeed our Passover lamb, and that our Messiah was referred to by John the Baptist in John chapter 1 verse 29 as the Lamb of God who came to take away the sins of the world... you find a very different truth than the fraudulent truth that the apostate and feckless church today is teaching.

And it really doesn't take that much to figure out that the snake oil that they have been selling us is indeed snake oil. Think about it for just a

moment. Does your wedding anniversary fall on the same day of the week every year? Does your baptism anniversary fall on the same day of the week every year? Of course not. And so why then would we believe for a second that the anniversary of the death of our Messiah would fall on a Friday every year?

And therefore, I ask you plainly... is it the writings of men that we should be bowing down to? Is it the church that is our example or is it our Messiah that is our example? Is it the law of the church that we should be following and is it the law of the church that should be written across our hearts and in our minds, or is it the law of God that we should be following and is it the law of God that should be written across our hearts and in our minds as we are told in both Jeremiah chapter 31 of the Old Testament and again in Hebrews chapter 10 of the New Testament?

I tell you the truth my friends, we are living in the last days, and we don't have time to play games with the word of Yehovah God. We don't have time to dance with the devil in the pale moonlight. And the last thing that we should be doing this season is to be facilitating the mockery of the birth of our Messiah according to Roman Catholicism and it's demonically inspired devilish traditions that that have traded for the truth of God's word.

My hope and my prayer this day is that you will stand on the truth that is the word of Yehovah God. My hope and my prayer this day is that you will build your house upon the rock that is the truth of God's word and not in the sandbox of men.

There is a choice that needs to be made. There is a way that seems right to a man that leads to death. And then there is the right way that has been cut by our Messiah. A very narrow path that leads few of us back to the tree of life that we were banished from in the garden of Eden. But the choice is ultimately up to us.

We were created in the image of God which means that we just like our

Father in heaven were not created autonomously as robots. Each and every one of us has been given free will and freedom of speech and free choice to choose whom it is that we will serve. And I tell you the truth, we are not all going to heaven. There will be a rather small remnant of mankind that will enter into his holy kingdom. And there will be many more who will be destroyed for lack of knowledge because they have rejected knowledge than there will be those who have asked and seeked and knocked on his door and searched for his truth and his truth alone.

In the end the choice is ours. But we must always remember that the choice that we make not only affects ourselves, but it also affects our children and our children's children.

Once again my friends this is not a game. This is literally the difference between blessings and curses, life and death. And therefore, I will leave you with one last Scripture this morning that I hope and pray may help you to understand what the whole duty of man is and always has been from the beginning. Ecclesiastes chapter 12 verse 13 (scrn 22)

Ecc 12:13 The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man.

And with that being said I will once again ask everyone within the sound of my voice please take what you have heard here this morning to your own prayer closet. Bow your head and bend your knee and face the holy promised land of Jerusalem and ask in the name of Yeshua Hamashiach if what you have heard here this morning be true or not.

Ask, seek, and knock on his door and on his door alone so that the proper door can be opened unto you. And if you will do that, and if you will stay the course to the end, you and I will surely walk through the gates of his soon coming kingdom together.
