## The Blue Chord Commandment

About two years ago on October 19<sup>th</sup> of 2017 we began to walk through our Fathers Torah beginning with the book of Genesis, and the blessings that have come from these studies have been absolutely priceless. People have come... blessings have been abundant... understanding has been given... prayers have been answered, and the spirit of Yah himself is continuing to be poured out upon his people to this very day through those very words that he had spoken in the very beginning.

The understanding of those who have been with us over the past two years has grown exponentially, but with that wisdom and with that understanding comes a great responsibility. Because a great work has been done in us, a great work is expected... from us.

We speak often about two very noticeable flaws that can be found within todays modern day version of Christianity when we present each one of our studies here at Holy Impact Ministries because these two flaws that can be found within todays modern day church are indeed abominations to the one true Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

The first flaw is the inept and repeated programing that todays denominational empires continually perpetuate that pre-programs their congregants to begin reading the bible from the book of Matthew rather than beginning to read reading it from the book of Matthew. This flaw in of itself completely and utterly hides the identity of both the Father and the Son, and his laws, precepts and appointments and blinds the reader from truly understanding the end of the age and what is coming because our Father tells us very clearly that he proclaims the end from the beginning. **Isaiah 46:8-13 (scrn 1)**

Isa 46:8 “Remember this and stand firm, recall it to mind, you transgressors,

Isa 46:9 remember the former things of old; for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me,

Isa 46:10 declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, ‘My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose,’

Isa 46:11 calling a bird of prey from the east, the man of my counsel from a far country. I have spoken, and I will bring it to pass; I have purposed, and I will do it.

Isa 46:12 “Listen to me, you stubborn of heart, you who are far from righteousness:

Isa 46:13 I bring near my righteousness; it is not far off, and my salvation will not delay; I will put salvation in Zion, for Israel my glory.”



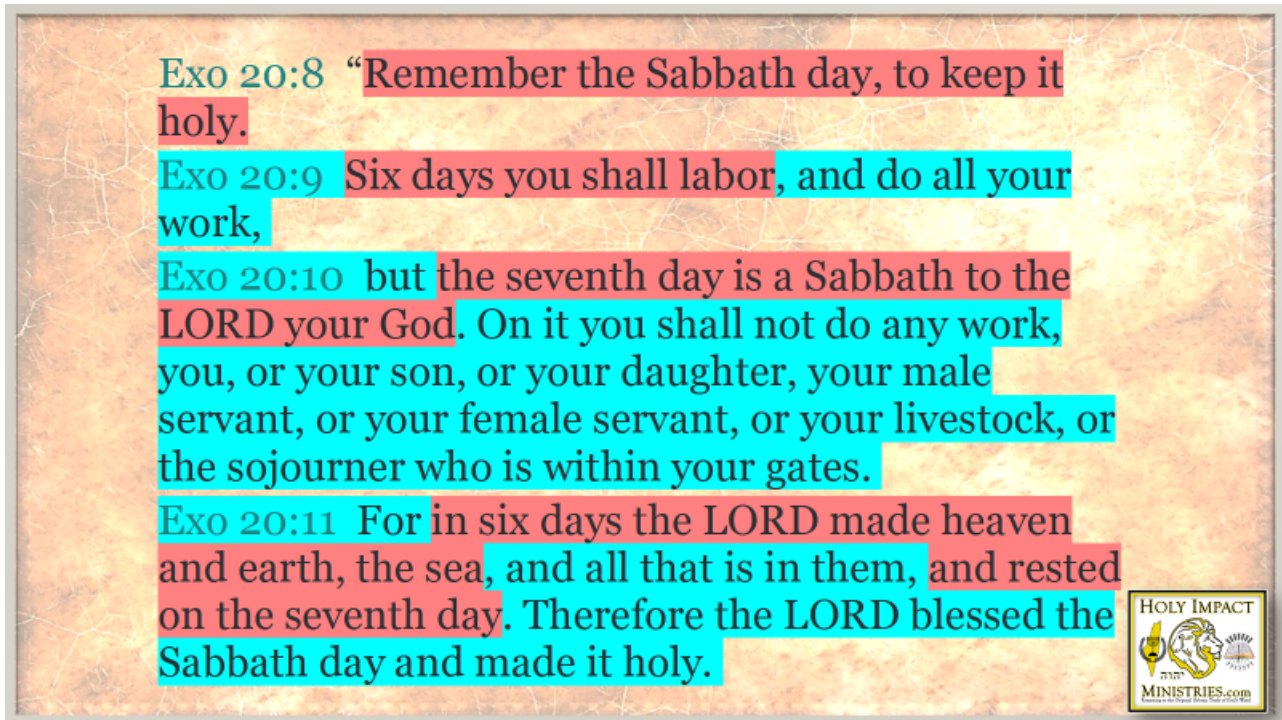
Proclaiming the end from the beginning... our Father clearly tells us that he will indeed put salvation in Zion for Israel his glory, and that promise is once again just as the Apostle Paul tells us in the 11<sup>th</sup> chapter of the book of Romans... irrevocable. And although salvation has indeed come to Zion through his only begotten Son... salvation has not permanently been put in Zion, nor will it be, until he returns, and that day when he returns... will be the day when salvation will truly be put in Zion forever. When the servant branch of David takes his rightful place on the throne of David in Zion here on earth... Zion will never be without salvation again.

Keeping this in mind... I must once again draw our attention back to what is written in the beginning of the book. Every story ever told has a beginning, but no story ever told has a beginning like the story of creation. The story of the beginning of the world is found in the book of Genesis. The story of the beginning of mankind is found in the book of Genesis. The Identity of both the Father and the Son are found in the book of Genesis. The unfolding plan of salvation is found in the book of Genesis. True hope, true faith, and true patient endurance, the law of Yahovah, and exactly how to conquer can all be found within the book of Genesis. And that my friends is simply one book out of the 66 books that we have in our Bibles today that must not only be read... but studied and understood.

What we will not find in the book of Genesis are today's man-made, man concocted roman rooted church doctrines, philosophical understandings, theologies and traditions. You see the book of Genesis along with the rest of the 66 books of our Bibles are void of these kinds of man-made teachings, and it is because they are void of these kinds of teachings... that we as true God fearing, cross bearing, Messiah following Christians should be rejecting these kinds of man-made-man traditions. But rather than rejecting them as we are commanded to... we stand guilty of trading the truth for a lie and a lie for the truth, and for trading what is sweet for what

is bitter, and what is bitter for what is sweet, because we have added these kinds of man-made sabbaths, and rituals and holidays to the word of Yahovah against his will.

There is only one 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath that has ever been commanded by anyone found anywhere in the Bible, and that 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath is indeed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day. **Exodus 20:8-11 (scrn 2)**



Today as true God fearing, cross bearing, Messiah following Christians, we ought to be smart enough to understand that it was from these very scriptures that we find in the Old Testament... that the noble Jews in Berea knew what the Apostle Paul was telling them about their Messiah was true and correct.

In the book of Acts chapter 17, we find that not all Jews rejected their Messiah. Many did indeed believe. And the very reason that they did believe was because of what they had read in what is known today as the “*Old Testament*”. **Acts 17:10-12 (scrn 3)**

**Act 17:10** The brothers immediately sent Paul and Silas away by night to Berea, and when they arrived they went into the Jewish synagogue.

**Act 17:11** Now these Jews were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they received the word with all eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so.

**Act 17:12** Many of them therefore believed, with not a few Greek women of high standing as well as men.



Clearly the false modern-day Christian narrative that all Jews rejected Yeshua during his time is nothing short of incorrect church doctrine. Many Jews did indeed accept their Messiah in his day, and many Jews knew exactly who he was because they had read the Torah, and the writings of the prophets and the Psalms which all prophesied about him. Not says I... but says the red-letter words of our own Messiah himself. **Luke 24:44 (scrn 4)**

**Luk 24:44** Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled."



The noble Jews of Berea knew that what the Apostle Paul was telling them was true and correct because they themselves had studied and read the Law of Moses, and the Prophets and

the Psalms that all point directly to our Messiah says our Messiah! And for those of our lost would be brothers and sisters out there who ignorantly believe that the Bereans were reading the “*New Testament*” in order to find our Messiah... you are in great error! The “*New Testament*” which consists of the writings of Luke and the Apostles was not even written at the time that Paul was visiting the Jews in Berea. The New Testament would not be written and canonized for another 90 years after the death, burial, and resurrection of our Messiah!

The noble Jews of Berea knew who their Messiah was because of the “*Old Testament*” not the “*New*”! And I would submit to you my friends that if you truly want to know who your Messiah truly is... you too... will read the Law of Moses, the writings of the Prophets and the Psalms because this my friends is where you will find the true birth of your Messiah being prophesied about long before he was ever born to a human woman by the name of Mary.

Most modern-day prophesying Christians today have no idea who their Messiah truly is or why he was destined to sit on the throne of David, or even what the throne of David even is, or why the throne of David was even founded. Why?... Because they have been wickedly pre-programmed not to read the book from the beginning, but to rather read it from the middle and cast aside the whole first half of the book as insignificant, and overwritten.

Shame on those who perpetuate such a demonically inspired notion. Shame on those who have added too... and have taken away from the word of Yahovah, for they will indeed answer for the wickedness that they have perpetuated, and the foul thing that they have done in hiding the commandments, feast days, precepts, Sabbaths and appointments of the one true Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob!

Today's modern day Christian denominational charters of men will often times proudly proclaim that the law is dead and that they are free from the law. Little do they know, that freedom from the law of Yah is bondage under sin which by definition... is indeed the transgression of the law itself.

They proudly proclaim that they are only bound by the moral law of God and only the moral law alone. But who is it that establishes, and sanctifies, and ordains what is “*moral*”? And is what is moral in the eyes of the church moral in the eyes of God? Not according to God.

**Deuteronomy 4:2 (scrn 5)**

**Deu 4:2** You shall not add to the word that I command you, nor take from it, that you may keep the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you.



**Proverbs 30:5-6 (scrn 6)**

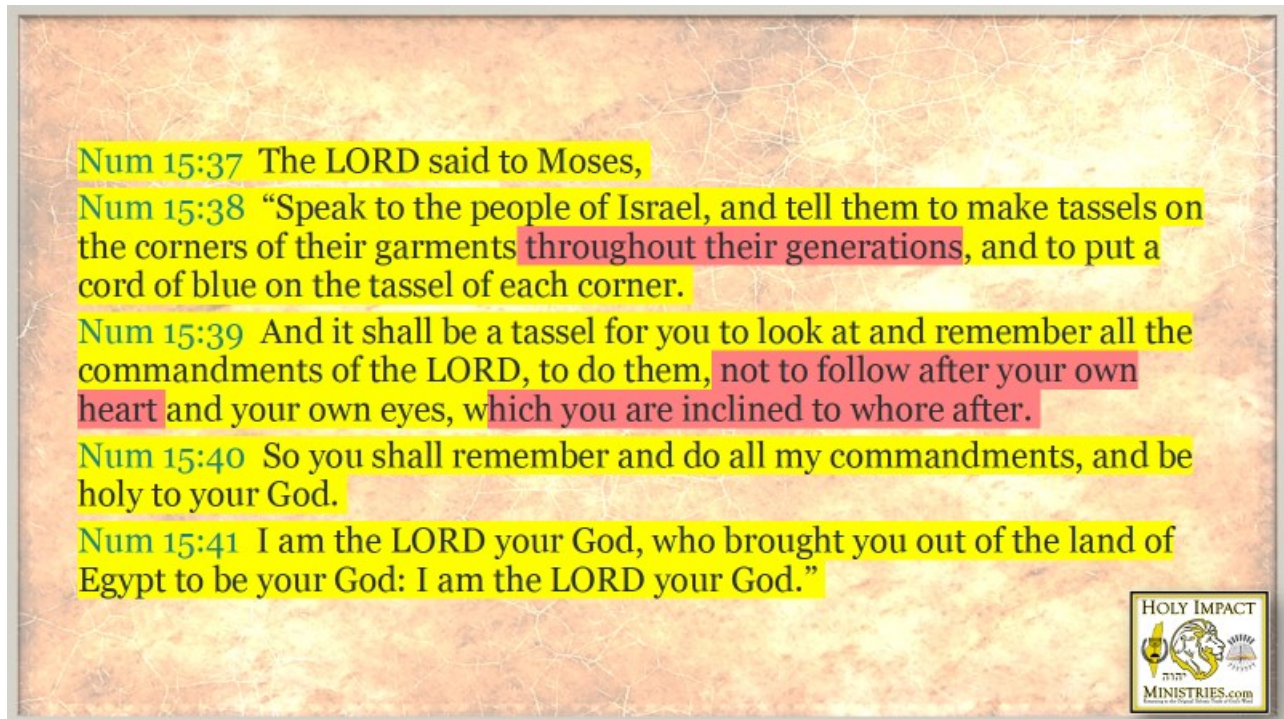
**Pro 30:5** Every word of God proves true; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.

**Pro 30:6** Do not add to his words, lest he rebuke you and you be found a liar.



Clearly our Messiah chastised the Pharisees and the Scribes for not keeping the Law of Moses (also known as the Torah). We hear our Messiah telling them over and over and over again that the Pastors, Priests, Bishops, and Popish leaders of his time were nothing more than a brood of vipers, hypocrites, blind fools, and even two-fold children of hell, and why?... Because they had added too.... and taken away from... his Fathers word. Just like todays modern day churches, and their denominational empires of dirt have done.

If indeed they are bound to what they call “*the moral law*” of God... then what about Numbers chapter 15? **Numbers 15:37-41 (scrn 7)**



Is this commandment then... “*immoral*”? Is it not “*moral*” to keep the commandment of Yah? Is it not “*moral*” to not follow after our own hearts and our own eyes which we are inclined to whore after? I would submit to you my friends that because the church today does not keep this moral commandment... they have indeed whored after their own hearts which they are inclined to whore after. Exactly what the scripture says here in Numbers chapter 15... they have done!

This very blue chord commandment is a commandment that would have surly aided in the protection of Yah’s word. This very blue chord commandment would have surly reminded them not to do what they have done! This very blue chord commandment would have surly stopped them from adding too... and taking away from... the word of Yah, but because they had rejected it... they themselves have become rejected!

And yet... I ponder whether even this blue chord commandment would have stopped them from overwriting the true word of Yahovah. We must remember that the scribes and the Pharisees did indeed keep this blue chord commandment and yet still... this blue chord commandment did not stop them from adding too, or taking away from the word of Yah. Never the less... it could have... if they would have been **doing** the law instead of overwriting it.

It’s one thing to study, and to know the truth... but it is an entirely different thing to **do...** what it is that we have studied and know to be the truth. All the study in the world will not save us if we do not **DO**... what the truth proclaims. And this is exactly what caused the Scribes and the Pharisees to fall. They had gone through great lengths to study and to even commit to

memory the scripture... but **doing** the scripture was found to be to much of a task for them.

And so there should be no doubt in our minds why it is that our Father in heaven commanded us to wear these blue chords on our hips. He commanded us to wear them on our hips throughout our generations so that we WOULD REMEMBER! It's all about remembering him, and putting him first. Seek first the kingdom of God and all things will be added unto you. But it was because this blue chord commandment had been written off by today's modern-day denominational empires... that they had nothing to remind them throughout the day not to whore after their own minds and eyes.

For anyone who has truly worn these blue chords on the corners of their hips for any real length of time... we know that these blue chords do indeed remind us. They hold us accountable. They cause us to be a peculiar, and a set apart people. These blue chords do indeed do the work that Yahovah himself has commanded them to do. The problem only comes when we stop using them for their proper purpose, and start using them to advance our own vanity and covetousness.

I want us to listen closely to what our Messiah warned us about these kinds of pious men who love their deeds to be seen by others. Listen to the red-letter words of our Messiah found in **Matthew 23:1-12 E1:**

**Mat 23:1** Then Jesus said to the crowds and to his disciples,

**Mat 23:2** "The scribes and the Pharisees sit on Moses' seat,

**Mat 23:3** so do and observe whatever they tell you, but not the works they do. For they preach, but do not practice.

**Mat 23:4** They tie up heavy burdens, hard to bear, and lay them on people's shoulders, but they themselves are not willing to move them with their finger.

**Mat 23:5** They do all their deeds to be seen by others. For they make their phylacteries broad and their fringes long,

**Mat 23:6** and they love the place of honor at feasts and the best seats in the synagogues

**Mat 23:7** and greetings in the marketplaces and being called rabbi by others.

**Mat 23:8** But you are not to be called rabbi, for you have one teacher, and you are all brothers.

**Mat 23:9** And call no man your father on earth, for you have one Father, who is in heaven.

**Mat 23:10** Neither be called instructors, for you have one instructor, the Christ.

**Mat 23:11** The greatest among you shall be your servant.

**Mat 23:12** Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted.



The Greek word for “fringes” here in verse 5 is the Greek word “*kras-ped-on*” which means “*tassel*”. Have you ever met a Jewish person who loves to wear their tassels long and very noticeable so that everyone can see them? Once again... our Messiah is warning us about even these men who do follow the blue chord commandment of Numbers chapter 15 and yet, use this commandment not to remind them of the word of Yah... but to gain favor in the eyes of others who think that they are more pious than they really are.

Beware my friends... of those who do not practice what they preach, those who make themselves appear holy, and righteous, and just, and yet are far from holiness, righteousness, and being just. We should be reminded daily of the false prophets that we were warned would indeed come in our time who would secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master who purchased them for a price. **2<sup>nd</sup> Peter 2: E2:**

**2Pe 2:1** *But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them, bringing upon themselves swift destruction.*

**2Pe 2:2** *And many will follow their sensuality, and because of them the way of truth will be blasphemed.*

**2Pe 2:3** *And in their greed they will exploit you with false words. Their condemnation from long ago is not idle, and their destruction is not asleep.*

**2Pe 2:4** *For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to chains of gloomy darkness to be kept until the judgment;*

**2Pe 2:5** *if he did not spare the ancient world, but preserved Noah, a herald of righteousness, with seven others, when he brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly;*

**2Pe 2:6** *if by turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah to ashes he condemned them to extinction, making them an example of what is going to happen to the ungodly;*

**2Pe 2:7** *and if he rescued righteous Lot, greatly distressed by the sensual conduct of the wicked*

**2Pe 2:8** *(for as that righteous man lived among them day after day, he was tormenting his righteous soul over their lawless deeds that he saw and heard);*

**2Pe 2:9** *then the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from trials, and to keep the unrighteous under punishment until the day of judgment,*

**2Pe 2:10** *and especially those who indulge in the lust of defiling passion and despise authority. Bold and willful, they do not tremble as they blaspheme the glorious ones,*

**2Pe 2:11** *whereas angels, though greater in might and power, do not pronounce a blasphemous judgment against them before the Lord.*

**2Pe 2:12** *But these, like irrational animals, creatures of instinct, born to be caught and destroyed, blaspheming about matters of which they are ignorant, will also be destroyed in their destruction,*

**2Pe 2:13** *suffering wrong as the wage for their wrongdoing. They count it pleasure to*

revel in the daytime. They are blots and blemishes, reveling in their deceptions, while they feast with you.

**2Pe 2:14** They have eyes full of adultery, insatiable for sin. They entice unsteady souls. They have hearts trained in greed. Accursed children!

**2Pe 2:15** Forsaking the right way, they have gone astray. They have followed the way of Balaam, the son of Beor, who loved gain from wrongdoing,

**2Pe 2:16** but was rebuked for his own transgression; a speechless donkey spoke with human voice and restrained the prophet's madness.

**2Pe 2:17** These are waterless springs and mists driven by a storm. For them the gloom of utter darkness has been reserved.

**2Pe 2:18** For, speaking loud boasts of folly, they entice by sensual passions of the flesh those who are barely escaping from those who live in error.

**2Pe 2:19** They promise them freedom, but they themselves are slaves of corruption. For whatever overcomes a person, to that he is enslaved.

**2Pe 2:20** For if, after they have escaped the defilements of the world through the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and overcome, the last state has become worse for them than the first.

**2Pe 2:21** For it would have been better for them never to have known the way of righteousness than after knowing it to turn back from the holy commandment delivered to them.

**2Pe 2:22** What the true proverb says has happened to them: "The dog returns to its own vomit, and the sow, after washing herself, returns to wallow in the mire."

Because I do wear blue chords from the corners of my hips, and do obey the blue chord commandment of Numbers chapter 15, I do know and understand the value that they bring to those who keep the commandments of Yahovah to do his will, and not chase after our own hearts and eyes. And it is because I do indeed keep this blue chord commandment that I am always careful to be on the lookout for these false prophets that are written about all throughout our God breathed scriptures, and even from the very red letter words of our Messiah who also warned us about them.

But I do not wear them as a façade of piety, nor do I wear them so that I should be honored at feasts or to obtain the best seats in the synagogues, or to be greeted in the marketplaces by being called "Rabbi", or "Great One" or someone's "master". I am no one's master, and I am no one's spiritual father. These blue chords that hang from the corners of my hips are for me and me alone. They are to remind me... not to follow after my own heart, or my own eyes... but to follow after my Father and to do what is right in his eyes not my own.

I can only speak the truth to those who will receive it as the truth. I have no power, or magic or divinic sorcery that can save anyone. And it is these blue chords that hang from the corners of my hips that constantly remind me of who I am, and what I have been called to. We... you and I... are indeed of one body, not two. We are one with each other, and we, are one with him.

But is this what today's modern day church believes? Do they believe that you can know the truth of Yah's word by simply getting down on your knees and reading Yah's word and asking him for his discernment? Or do they believe that you must graduate... from one of their man-made brick and mortar institutions with degrees in hermeneutics, theology, and philosophy?

Do they believe that you can know the truth of God's word without them? Do they believe that you can enter into his coming kingdom without the title of their denominational charter stamped across your forehead? Or do they believe... that they themselves are the door that you must pass through?... or that you must keep the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the week Sunday Sabbath that Roman Catholicism has created for you to keep?... or that you must bow your knee to their Roman rooted "*Good Friday*", "*Easter*", "*Christ-mas*", and "*All Saints Day* (also known as Halloween)".

These blue chords that I wear faithfully on my hips each and every day remind me that there is only one 7<sup>th</sup> Day Sabbath commanded by anyone within the confines of the 66 books of my Bible. And they remind me that my Messiah died on Passover Day and is my Passover Lamb who was raised up on First Fruits to wave the sheaf offering before his Father to signal the incoming new harvest. These blue chords remind me that the true Gospel begins in the book of Genesis, and not in the book of Matthew, and they remind me that it is not man, or man's denomination empires of dirt, or man's so called "*early church fathers*", or man's prestigious bible commentators that I serve.

These blue chords that I wear faithfully on my hips remind me that I am indeed a very small part of a much larger set apart people, who are indeed set apart for his will and for his purpose, because it was by his hand that we were created and given life.

These blue chords that I wear faithfully on my hips remind me that I have willfully and intentionally proclaimed the love of Yahovah and his only begotten Son publicly, and he has brought me to his doorpost and bored my ear with an awl so that I may be his slave forever and ever amen. A slave to his righteousness, a slave to his justice, and a slave to the obedience of his word and his word alone.

These blue chords speak volumes about not only who he is... but about who I am through him. They shout to the world and the little "g" god of this world that I am indeed the property of the one true Most High Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. These blue chords have indeed become the chords that bind. They are the chains that I have prayed for... unbreakable chains that I have begged my Father to bind me to him with. I am indeed free from the bondage of sin, and bound by the chains of righteousness, and not a righteousness of my own... but the righteousness of Yahovah himself.

Through the blood of my very Jewish Messiah... these blue chords lead me through the door that no man can shut, and they remind me constantly of his imminent return to collect not only

me... but all who are willfully and intentionally bound to him and to him alone. How grand a privilege it is to say... that I am one with the King of Israel. How grand a privilege it is to even say... that I even know him. How grand a privilege it is to be able to walk with him after all that I have said and done.

Amazing grace... how sweet the sound, that saved a wretch like me. I once was lost, but now am found... was blind but now I see.

The words that I speak against the church of today although may seem harsh and divisive are all that I have to shake the pillars of this world today. The words that I speak in truth are words that do indeed cut like a double edged sword, for the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and spirit, of joints and marrow, and discerning the thoughts and the intentions of the heart. And no creature is hidden from his sight... but we are all naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give an account.

And the only peace that I have, is knowing full well that we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weakness, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are... and yet... without sin.

Faith, hope, and love... the greatest of these is indeed love, and it is love that speaks the truth. And just as a double-edged sword, it is the love of the truth that is not often readily accepted because it condemns the wickedness that lives within us. But this double-edged sword can and will indeed separate us from that wickedness, and it can and will indeed send us to the watery grave of baptism to be buried there and yet raised up again a new creature. But we must go through that spiritual death so that we can go through the physical.

There are so many blessing that our Father has bestowed upon us just like the blue chord commandment that he has bestowed upon us in the book of Numbers. So many times that he has called out to us, and reminded us time and time and time again of who he is and why it is that he loves us the way that he does. But in order to even begin to understand who he is or why is it that where sin abounds, grace abounds more... we must begin to understand the beginning... that he proclaims the end from.

What we as true modern-day Christians need to know and accept is the fact that our Messiah did not come to bring peace upon the world. Those who are bellowing out "*peace and safety*" and inclusiveness, and toleration have no idea who their Messiah even is! Our Messiah did not come to bring peace and inclusiveness and toleration... he came to bring a sword. He came to set a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter in law against her mother in law. A person's enemies will be those of his own household, and he who loves father or mother more than him is not worthy of him. And he that loves son or daughter more than him is not worthy of him. And he who does not pick up his cross and follow him... is not worthy of him.

Picking up our cross and following him does not mean that we are to shrink back and become tolerant of the world, or to be inclusive with the world. Picking up our cross and following him means following in his footsteps and doing as he did. He raised up against them! He stood his ground against them! He pushed back against their man-made religious systems and their man-made laws, and philosophies and theologies. He did not mix and mingle himself with them. He spoke truth to power and he let the chips fall where they may.

Peace my friends... is not the absence of war... peace is the presents of justice. And there is no justice without the righteous justice of Yahovah the one true Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. The world and its religious leaders are as lost as the day is long because they seek their own power and their own glory. It's all about the church the church the church. It's all about what the church thinks of you, or how the church sees you, or about how you keep the traditions and rituals of the church. But the church itself has become the problem not the solution!

The church today is full of men who do not practice what they preach, they love to wear their expensive three-piece suits, and their spit shinned shoes... they love the place of honor at feasts, and the best seats in the church. They love the greetings in the market places and being called "*great ones or rabbis or fathers*" by others. The church today is full of hypocrisy, and greed, and envy, and yes even homosexuality and pedophilism. And just as Yah had sent his prophets into the world to protest against them in the days of Isaiah, and Jeremiah, and Ezekiel, and Hosea, and Jonah so too does he send his prophets into the world today to protest against them. And just like deaf ears fell upon the prophets of yesterday... so too do deaf ears fall upon those today who do not have the eyes to see or the ears to hear.

Let us pray... that the blue chord commandment of Yahovah would return to today's church, and that the truth of his word from the beginning of time is read about diligently in todays church. Let us pray... that todays wolves in sheep's clothing will be defrocked, and that the lion of Juda will replace them with those not afraid to speak the truth, and to stand for what is right in the eyes of the all mighty. Let us pray that the true coming kingdom of our Messiah is expanded in these last days, and that our voices do not fall on deaf ears. Let us pray that each of us may find at least one... one who would hear, one who would see... one who would care enough to say "*I will enter into the watery grave of baptism. I will pick up my cross, and I will bear it to the end*". And let us pray that after we plant that seed... that he who grows the seed would indeed grow it to stand firm in the deepest and richest of soil.

There is no point in preaching and teaching an empty gospel. There is no point in preaching and teaching a roman rooted sabbath. There is no point in preaching and teaching a false promise, or a false anniversary or a false death or a false birthday. These are things that are preached and taught from behind todays pulpits that come from the wisdom of men. And the wisdom of men is foolishness to the Elohim of Israel. **Jeremiah 17:5 (scrn 8)**

**Jer 17:5** Thus says the LORD: “Cursed is the man who trusts in man and makes flesh his strength, whose heart turns away from the LORD.



**Psalms 118:8-9 (scrn 9)**

**Psa 118:8** It is better to take refuge in the LORD than to trust in man.

**Psa 118:9** It is better to take refuge in the LORD than to trust in princes.



**1<sup>st</sup> Cor 3:16-23 (scrn 10)**

1Co 3:18 Let no one deceive himself. If anyone among you thinks that he is wise in this age, let him become a fool that he may become wise.

1Co 3:19 For the wisdom of this world is folly with God. For it is written, "He catches the wise in their craftiness,"

1Co 3:20 and again, "The Lord knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are futile."

1Co 3:21 So let no one boast in men. For all things are yours,


1Co 3:22 whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas or the world or life or death or the present or the future—all are yours,

1Co 3:23 and you are Christ's, and Christ is God's.



Today, as we continue our struggle in the pursuit of truth, and the furtherance of the true unadulterated Gospel message of our Messiah, let us always remember to teach those who would join us in our pursuit for the truth to begin by reading the Bible for themselves, and to read it from the beginning of the book, from the book of Genesis and not from the book of Matthew. And with that my friends... I will continue to hope and to pray that our endeavor to fulfill our Messiah's prophecy found in Matthew chapter 24 will indeed come to its fulfillment. **Matthew 24:14 (scrn 11)**



Mat 24:14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

These days are not the days that we should be shrinking back and falling in line with the inclusiveness and tolerance of today's church.
