The Fall Feast Days Explained 2020

The first thing that I'd like to do is to once again welcome everybody to today's study where we are going to be explaining the fall feast days of our Father in heaven and why it is that every 21st-century Christian should be paying close attention to these feast days and appointments and precepts that have been outlined for us by our Father in heaven. Especially today in our time.

There is so much to understand about the feast days that it is literally impossible to understand everything that needs to be understood in one sitting. And that's why this teaching will be divided into a two-part series of studies rather than trying to cram it all into one session here today.

In order to properly understand the feast days of our Father in heaven that he says are to be forever and kept throughout all of our generations... reading the whole Bible from the beginning truly is a prerequisite, because if we have not read the whole book from the beginning of the book, there truly is absolutely no way that we are going to understand the incredible blessings that are bestowed upon us through these feast days and these appointments and these precepts that have been laid out from the beginning of the book by our Father in heaven.

We often times talk about what a tragedy it is for today's modern-day pastors and priests and bishops and popish leaders to wrongfully and shamefully encourage people to read the back half of the book starting with the book of Matthew instead of reading it from the beginning like any other book. This shameful instruction has done God's people no service. And I daresay that Christians are the only fools who go to a bookstore and purchase a perfectly good brand-new Bible and only read half of it because they have been preprogrammed by their spiritual leaders not to read the first half of the book.

Who buys a book off-the-shelf of a bookstore... takes it home... and only reads the back half of it? Christians do. Christians are the only ones foolish enough to buy into the idea that they only have to read half of the book in order to know what's in the book. And my friends, that has been a shame for us for generations... and still to this day I continuously hear pastors tell their congregants that they only have to read the back half of the book starting with the book of Matthew. What a shame this is.

After today's study, if you never heard these things before, I think that you will agree with me that it is not only important... but that it is commanded that we read this book that we call

the Bible **from the beginning**.

These are God breathed scriptures and God breathed words that come from the very breath of the Creator of the heavens and the earth himself. What in the world makes us think that we don't have to hear them and that we don't have to obey them? The answer to that question is simply "*wolves in sheep's clothing*". And I would submit to you that wolves do not look like wolves. Wolves in sheep's clothing are dressed in sheep's clothing so that they will look like sheep. They will have patent leather shoes, they will have leather bound Bibles, they will have hundred-dollar haircuts, many of them will have three-piece suits. Some of them will be kindly old men, some of them will be our friends and our neighbors. The devil loves to dress himself up like an angel of light. And this is something that we as Christians have unfortunately long forgotten.

And so, the first thing that I want to talk about here this morning is the fact that these feast days and appointments, and these precepts that we find in what many call the "*Old Testament*" do not belong to the Jews.

I cannot tell you how many times that I have heard modern-day 21st-century Christians tell me that they don't have to read the beginning of the book because the beginning of the book is only for the Jews. All of these feast days, and all of these commandments are only for the Jews. As far as most Christians are concerned today, the first 39 books of the Bible have nothing to do with them. What a shame this is.

And so, the first thing that I'd like us to do this morning is to turn to Leviticus chapter 23, and I'd like us to read the first two verses of Leviticus chapter 23. **Leviticus 23:1-2 (scrn 1)**

These Are Yahoval's Appointed Feasts!

Lev 23:1 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying,

Lev 23:2 "Speak to the people of Israel and say to them, These are the appointed feasts of **the LORD** that you shall proclaim as holy convocations; they are **my appointed feasts**."



And so, here we have from the very breath of Yahovah himself, his very own proclamation proclaiming that these appointed feasts belong to him... not the Jews. And just to be very, very clear here... I want all of our listeners to understand that the English word “*LORD*” here found two different times in Leviticus chapter 23 verses one and two, is a blooper in your Bible. It is a massive blooper in your English translated Bible. The translators completely dropped the ball when they translated God’s name as “*LORD*” in our English translated Bibles. And yes, that does indeed include your King James version of the Bible.

Our Father in heaven wrote his name in his God breathed Scripture over 6519 times, and man has covered up the very name of God with the word “*LORD*”. Why is this important for us to understand? It’s important for us to understand this because our Father in heaven has stamped his signature on Leviticus chapter 23 verses one and two along with many other Scripture. Our Father in heaven is not leaving the door open for us to think that these feast days belong to just any old “*LORD*”. Just as we are told in first Corinthians chapter 8 verse five... there are many gods and many lords that can be found within the Scripture. In Psalms chapter 82 our Father in heaven calls his divine counsel “*god’s*”. Moses was called a “*god*” to Pharaoh and his brother Aaron his profit. The devil himself is even called the “*god*” of this world. And our Messiah is even called a “*god*” by his Father in Hebrews chapter 1. Even the pagan gods are called “*gods*” in the Bible. And the word “*Lord*” is also not the name of God. Many people are called “*Lord*” in the Bible. Sarah called Abraham her husband “*Lord*” David was called “*Lord*”. Both the words “*God*” and “*LORD*”, have absolutely nothing to do with the personal name of the one true Most High God of Israel. Just so that we can cement this in our minds, I’d like us to turn to **Exodus 3:15 (scrn 2)**

This Is My Name FOREVER!

Exo 3:15 God also said to Moses, “Say this to the people of Israel: ‘The LORD (YEHOVAH), the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you.’ This is my name forever, and thus I am to be remembered throughout all generations.”



Now, I want us to understand that this is not what some denominational pastor says. This is not what some Pope says. This is not what some early church father says. This is not what some prestigious Bible commentators says. This is what Yahovah the one true Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob says. This is what your God breathed Scripture says in the very beginning of the book. Why is this important?

This is important because when we read Leviticus chapter 23 which is where we find the commanded feast days and the appointments of our Father listed in the Bible... it should be understood, that according to Yahovah himself... these feast days belong to no other than him. These are Yahovah's feast days. These feast days do not belong to the Jews, they do not belong to any other Lord, they do not belong to any other god, they belong to Yahovah who is indeed the Creator of the heavens and the earth. Do we not think that this is important to understand? Because I would submit to you that the most important thing that you can possibly understand or take away from today's teaching, is that these appointed times and feast days and sabbaths all belong to Yahovah who is the creator of the heavens and the earth. They belong to no man. They belong to no charter of men. They belong to know counsel of men. They belong to no other gods, they belong to no other lords, they belong personally... to Yahovah.

And so, we need to understand this critical point before we ever even get started here this morning. And I want to be very clear here this morning. The Jews are only one tribe out of the 12 tribes of the house of Israel. Yahovah's word does not belong only to one tribe out of the 12 tribes of the house of Israel (even though that one tribe may like us to think so, but will get into that later).

Many modern-day Christians who will hear this teaching here this morning will realize that they have been blatantly lied to by their denominational pastors and priests and bishops and popish leaders. And when they go back... and when they begin to read the beginning of the book... they will often times wrongly assume that they need to become Jewish in order to truly be able to take advantage of the free gift of salvation that their Jewish Messiah has brought them. And because our Messiah was Jewish, and because our Messiah came from the seed of Abraham according to Matthew chapter 1 verse one... and Galatians chapter 3 verse 16, and was created from the very body of David according to second Samuel chapter 7, and Matthew chapter 1 verse one, and Revelation chapter 22 verse 16... our Messiah was indeed a Jew who came from the house of David and the tribe of Judah. And if we are all one in him... then it is fair to say that we have all become Jewish. Not says I, but says our God breathed Scripture. Let's read **Galatians 3:27-29 (scrn 3)**

You Are All One In The Messiah!

Gal 3:27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

Gal 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

Gal 3:29 And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise.



And so, if our God breathed Scripture is true, then we must understand that we have become one with a Jew. And therefore, when someone asks me if I am Jewish because they see the blue cords hanging from the corners of my hips, I cannot deny the fact that I am part of my very Jewish Messiah who came once again from the house of David and the tribe of Judah. However... However... I do not practice “Judaism”. Let me say that again... I do not practice the religion of “Judaism”. Why? Because even though my Messiah was a Jewish man who came from the house of David and the tribe of Judah, our Messiah hated the religion of Judaism.

Our Messiah railed against the religion of Judaism. And a good place to go for a reference as to exactly how much our Messiah hated the religion of Judaism... we can go to Matthew chapter 23. Our Messiah railed against the Babylonian rabbis who had come up out of Babylon teaching this newfound religion of Judaism and he called them and I quote, “*a brood of vipers, whitewashed tombs beautiful on the outside but full of dead men’s bones on the inside, blind guides, children of hell, hypocrites, and blind fools.*” And these were just a few of the pet names that our Messiah had for these Babylonian rabbis who had come up out of Babylon and were teaching this man-made religion called “*Judaism*”.

According to the Talmud, which is seen as authoritative even over the spoken word of God according to many of today’s Babylonian rabbis... our Messiah is boiling in human excrement. This is the same exact garbage and trash that the Pharisees and the scribes who were the Babylonian “*rabbis*” of our Messiah’s time had taught. They taught that our Messiah was a heretic. They illegally tried him and found an innocent man guilty and then handed him over to the Gentiles to be crucified because they were indeed as our Messiah has already told us... sons of the devil himself who is also a liar who cannot tell the truth because it’s not in his character

to tell the truth. Listen closely to what our Messiah told the Babylonian rabbis of his time in the book of **John 8:39-47 E1**

Joh 8:39 They answered him, “Abraham is our father.” Jesus said to them, “If you were Abraham's children, you would be doing the works Abraham did,

Joh 8:40 but now you seek to kill me, a man who has told you the truth that I heard from God. This is not what Abraham did.

Joh 8:41 You are doing the works your father did.” They said to him, “We were not born of sexual immorality. We have one Father—even God.”

Joh 8:42 Jesus said to them, “If God were your Father, you would love me, for I came from God and I am here. I came not of my own accord, but he sent me.

Joh 8:43 Why do you not understand what I say? It is because you cannot bear to hear my word.

Joh 8:44 You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

Joh 8:45 But because I tell the truth, you do not believe me.

Joh 8:46 Which one of you convicts me of sin? If I tell the truth, why do you not believe me?

Joh 8:47 Whoever is of God hears the words of God. The reason why you do not hear them is that you are not of God.”

Now why do I bring this all up when were supposed to be talking about the feast days of our Father in heaven? I bring this to your attention so that you will know not to go running into the arms of Judaism the way that many of our lost brethren have done to their own destruction. Our Messiah tells us very clearly that strait is the gate and narrow is the path, and few there be that find it. Our Messiah is very clear that many are called but only few are chosen. Why? Because there is a **narrow path** between today's false version of Christianity, and today's false version of Judaism. There is a narrow path in between these two man-made religions wherein lies... the truth. And if you were to do a word study on “*the truth*” you would find that Yahovah's spoken word is “*truth*”. There is no other truth. It doesn't matter what religion man decides to invent for himself, it doesn't matter what some early church father says, it doesn't matter what some rabbinical Sage says, it doesn't matter what the Pope says, all that matters is “*the truth*” and the truth according to the Bible is “*Yahovah's spoken word*”. And for time sake, I will let you do a word search in your own Bible concerning “*the truth*” so that we can continue on in our study here this morning. But we must always remember that the spoken word of Yahovah the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob is the biblical definition of... “*the truth*”.

So, what have we established so far? We have established that the feast days, and the appointments, and the precepts of the Creator of the heavens and the earth belong solely to the Creator of the heavens and the earth. These feast days do not belong to any group of people, or

to any one individual. They belong to Yahovah the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. And we have also established that the religion of Judaism was detestable to our Messiah and therefore we as modern-day 21st-century Christians should not be running into the arms of Judaism.

We have also established the very name of God that he commanded that he would be known by forever and throughout all of our generations. And according to the Hebrew language his name is not “*Lord*” is not “*God*” it is not “*Adoni*”, it is not “*Hasham*”, it is none of those things. Those things are offices just like being a plumber or a teacher or an accountant or a musician. “*Lord, God, Adoni, Hasham*” and all the rest of those words are offices they are not names. And just as we have already seen in Leviticus chapter 23 verses one and two, these feast days belong to Yahovah personally.

And I want us to also realize that you will not find a rabbi anywhere in the Old Testament. Why won't you find rabbis in the Old Testament? Because there were no such thing as rabbis in the Old Testament. The title of “*rabbi*” came up out of Babylon. The house of Judah was taken captive under the bondage of Babylon. And while in servitude under Babylon, the house of Judah invented for themselves what they called “*rabbis*” which essentially means “*great one*”. Our Messiah commands us in the New Testament not to call anyone “*rabbi*” or “*father*”, or “*master*”. And for good reason. **Matthew 23:8-11 (scrn 4)**


DO NOT BE CALLED RABBI!!

Mat 23:8 But you are not to be called rabbi, for you have one teacher, and you are all brothers.

Mat 23:9 And call no man your father on earth, for you have one Father, who is in heaven.

Mat 23:10 Neither be called masters, for you have one instructor, the Christ.

Mat 23:11 The greatest among you shall be your servant.



Here we have a red-letter commandment not to be called “*rabbi*”, and not to be called “*father*” and not to be called “*masters*”. But what does rabbinical Judaism call themselves? And what does Catholicism call itself? Do rabbinical Jews not call themselves “*rabbis*” blatantly breaking the red-letter commandment of our Messiah? And the priests of Catholicism not call

themselves “*fathers*” blatantly breaking the red-letter commandment of our Messiah?
Ephesians 4:11-14 (scrn 5 Don’t read just show while teaching)


The Two Fold Reason For Teachers:

Eph 4:11 And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers,

Eph 4:12 to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ,

Eph 4:13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ,

Eph 4:14 so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes.



In Ephesians chapter 4 we are told that he gave us apostles and prophets and evangelists and pastors and teachers for two very specific reasons. The first reason was for building up the saints for the work of ministry. And the second reason was so that we would not be carried away by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness and deceitful schemes. Those are the two reasons that he gave us apostles and prophets and evangelists and pastors and teachers. But notice in Ephesians chapter 4, that we do not see the titles of “*rabbi*” or “*fathers*”, or “*masters*”. You might want to remember that the next time your pastor wants you to buy him a personal jet.

And so, it’s important for us to understand who our teachers truly are. Just as we are told by our Messiah in Matthew chapter 23 verse 11, the greatest among you... shall be your servant. Not your rabbi, not your father, not your master... but your servant. And I would submit to you that both rabbinical Judaism and today’s modern-day version of Christianity have both not only forgotten this most important biblical principal... But they have completely erased this most important biblical principle in order to gain their own authoritative power over God’s people today. (scrn 6... don’t read just show while teaching)

You Are All One In The Messiah!

Gal 3:27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

Gal 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

Gal 3:29 And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise.



As we've already seen in the book of Galatians chapter 3, there is no Jew and there is no Gentile. (That's what a Greek was... a Greek was a Gentile who was not borne by blood into the house of Israel.) And so, there is neither Jew nor Gentile, there is neither slave nor free, there is not even a male and a female because we are all one in our Messiah Yeshua. And not only that... but if we are the messiahs... then we are Abraham's offspring and heirs according to the promise. Why do I bring this up again?

I bring this to our attention again so that we will understand as modern-day 21st-century Christians we have been grafted into the seed of Abraham which is the house of Israel. If we truly believe in our Messiah Yeshua Hamashiach (Jesus and the Greek) as being the only begotten Son of Yahovah... then because we are one with him... we are indeed Abraham's offspring. And to get an even better understanding of this, I would encourage you to go read Romans chapter 11 if you have not already done so, because the apostle Paul clearly describes the grafting in of a true believer into the house of Israel. And... that many of the unbelieving Jews have been broken out of the house of Israel because of their unbelief. Why is this important?

This is important because as 21st-century Christians we need to understand who we are and what we have been grafted into. We need to understand that when our Father speaks to the house of Israel in the Old Testament, he is speaking to those of us who have been grafted into the house of Israel as well.

Our Father in heaven has not thrown out the apple of his eye which is the house of Israel in order to replace the house of Israel with some newfound Gentile country club called "*the church*". This once again is a blasphemous and disgusting man-made demonically inspired

doctrine of demons that comes directly from many of today's modern-day Christian denominational charters of men who shamefully proclaim that their newfound Gentile country club church has replaced the house of Israel. This is called "*replacement theology*" and is once again a doctrine of demons. Not says I... but says our God breathed Scripture.

And I would submit to you that the only reason that this "*replacement theology*" doctrine of demons has been brought forth is to give these denominational charters of men power and authority that they have not been given by the hand of Yahovah. They are usurping not only God's true people... but the spoken word of Yahovah by adding to... and taking away from... his spoken word which is once again designated by Yahovah as "*sin*". According to first John chapter 3 verse four the biblical definition of "*sin*" is the transgression of the law. And the biblical definition of the "*law*" is the Torah, also known as the spoken word of Yahovah. When you transgress the spoken word of Yahovah, you are guilty of "*sin*" because you have transgressed his law... therefore... if there is no more law... then there can be no more "*sin*" because sin is the transgression of the law. And I assure you my friends, the world is full of sin.

Do you see how foolish and ridiculous and self-serving it is to proclaim that the law... which is the spoken word of Yahovah... is done away with? In Matthew chapter 5, our Messiah tells us very clearly that he did not come to abolish the Law or the Prophets, but that he came to do them as an example to us so that... that we would also do them. And he tells us that not the crossing of a "t" or the darting of an "i" will pass from his Father's law until two very important things happen. Number one... heaven and earth both have to pass away, and number two... all things have to be accomplished. And my friends, I would submit to you that we are still standing on the earth today, and we can look up and see the heavens today in our time, and all things are certainly not accomplished. In fact... we are right now today standing at the end of the age watching things that have not been accomplished as of yet... become accomplished. Heaven and earth does not pass away and all things are not accomplished until clear at the back of the book in Revelation chapter 21. Therefore... those who proclaim that the law of God is dead... have no idea what they are talking about when it comes to the spoken word of Yahovah and the God breathed Scripture that they hold in their very hands.

Many of our lost brethren will proclaim that the apostle Paul did away with the law in his teachings. But I would submit to you my friends, that the apostle Paul himself always lived in observance of the law. Not says I... but says our God breathed Scripture. **Acts 21:23-24 (scrn 7)**

Paul Always Lived In Observance of The Law

Act 21:23 Do therefore what we tell you. We have four men who are under a vow;

Act 21:24 take these men and purify yourself along with them and pay their expenses, so that they may shave their heads. Thus all will know that there is nothing in what they have been told about you, but that you yourself also live in observance of the law.



Clearly, James and the elders at Jerusalem knew full well that the apostle Paul always lived in observance of the law. And we see the apostle Paul going to the temple and making the sacrificial offerings for these four men in the book of Acts, doing exactly what the law commanded and required. (scrn 8)

Rom 2:13 For it is not the hearers of the law who are righteous before God, **but the doers of the law who will be justified.**

Rom 3:31 Do we then overthrow the law by this faith? By no means! On the contrary, **we uphold the law.**

Rom 6:1 What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound?

Rom 6:2 **By no means!** How can we who died to sin still live in it?

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Rom 7:12 So **the law is holy**, and the commandment is holy and righteous and good.

Rom 8:7 For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, **for it does not submit to God's law;** indeed, it cannot.

Rom 8:8 Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

Rom 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from **the law of sin and death.**

And I don't want to get into a long drawn out teaching about why the law does still stand today in our time, because we have many thorough teachings about this very biblical fact at our website at HolyImpactMinistries.com, and also at our YouTube channel where we have over

500 different video teachings that will help explain why today's modern-day church is in error and why so many people are now coming back to the truth of the spoken word of our Father in heaven. But I do want to make it extremely clear before we ever even get into this study of the fall feast days why it is that every modern-day 21st-century Christian should indeed be concerned with these fall feast days.

It does us no good to explain the fall feast days to our would-be brothers and sisters if today's modern-day Christian think that they are exempt from these fall feast days because of the teachings of some man standing behind some denominational pulpit. It must first be made clear that if we believe in the only begotten Son of Yahovah who is Yeshua Hamashiach... we are indeed grafted into the house of Israel which is the seed of Abraham, because we have become one with the seed of Abraham who is Yeshua Hamashiach. Not says I... but says our God breathed Scripture as we have already shown. When our Father in heaven speaks in what they call the "*Old Testament*", he is speaking to the house of Israel that we have been grafted into.

And my friends, you can kick your pulpit, you can rent your clothes, you can throw yourself on the ground and act like a child, or you can come... to the truth. You can stand on the shoulders of your denominational forefathers, or you can stand on the rock that is the only begotten Son of Yahovah... the cornerstone that Yahovah placed in Zion that he already told us would be a stumbling block for many.

As for me and my house, we will not stand on the shoulders of our denominational forefathers, we will indeed stand on the rock who has very clearly proclaimed to us that his Father's law does indeed still stand to this very day. And this is exactly why we need a Messiah, because God's law does still stand. If God's law no longer stands, then you no longer need a Messiah. You no longer need a ransom for your sin. You no longer needed a church... you no longer need a pastor... and you no longer need a Bible... so you might as well just throw the whole thing in the trash and walk away. And this is exactly what the devil wants us to believe, and this is exactly how the devil wants us to act. Think about it!

What we as 21st-century Christians need to understand is that not all of our Father's appointments are technically feast days (**scrn 9**)

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As we can see here listed on this chart, we have the spring Moedim or appointments, and we have the fall Moedim or appointments. Not all of these appointments are technically feast days (scrn 10)

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As we can see here listed in red, only three of these appointments are technically feast days where a feast is commanded. And what is important for us to understand by looking at this chart

is that our Messiah has already fulfilled the first four feast days of the spring when he came the first time. Our Messiah did not die on a Roman Catholic created “*Good Friday*”. Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John all proclaim that our Messiah died on Passover day. This is why he is called our Passover lamb. **First Corinthians 5:7-8 (scrn 11)**

Let Us Celebrate The Festival!
Says Paul

1Co 5:7 Cleanse out the old leaven that you may be a new lump, as you really are unleavened. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.

1Co 5:8 Let us therefore celebrate the festival, not with the old leaven, the leaven of malice and evil, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.



Right here in first Corinthians chapter 5 we have the apostle Paul speaking to the assembly at Corinth identifying our Messiah as our “*Passover lamb*”. Why? Because our Messiah is our Passover lamb who died on Passover day. At the exact same time that the Passover lambs were being slaughtered at the temple, our Messiah was being slaughtered upon the cross in order to be our ransom, our Passover lamb, and the propitiation for the sins of all men... who would have faith in him and pick up their crosses and follow him and walk as he walked.

And I want us to notice something else extremely important here in first Corinthians chapter 5. The apostle Paul tells the assembly at Corinth to celebrate the festival! Why does the apostle Paul tell the assembly of Corinth to celebrate the festival of Passover and unleavened bread? He tells them to celebrate the Passover and the feast of unleavened bread because our Messiah became our Passover lamb, our Messiah was the unleavened sinless bread of life, who was resurrected on firstfruits to waive the sheave offering before his Father signaling the new incoming harvest. And it was at our Messiah’s request that the Ruach Hackodesh the Holy Spirit of Yahovah was given to mankind on Shavuot (also known as the day of Pentecost).

And so, you see... in order for us to properly understand the fall feast days, we must understand that our Messiah has already fulfilled the spring feast days. And I want to ask you a question.

Because our Messiah fulfilled the spring feast days... does the apostle Paul now tell the assembly at Corinth not to celebrate the festival... or does he tell them to... celebrate the festival? If the word “*fulfill*” which is the Greek word “*Pleru*” means to abolish or to do away with... and our Messiah fulfilled the spring feast days... then this would mean that the feast days were abolished would it not? But what does Paul tell the assembly at Corinth? He says and I quote “*let us therefore celebrate the festival, not with the old sin, the old leaven, of malice and evil, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.*”

The apostle Paul clearly tells the assembly at Corinth to continue to celebrate the festival of the Passover and the feast of unleavened bread with sincerity and truth continuously remembering what their Messiah had done for them by becoming their Passover lamb and the firstfruits of the resurrection. Just as we have already seen in Acts chapter 21... the apostle Paul is still living in obedience to the law of Yahovah the exact same way that his Messiah did.

And our Messiah was also raised up on firstfruits... signifying that he himself is the first fruit of the resurrection. Our Messiah was not raised up on some Roman Catholic concocted pagan Easter morning. He was raised up on firstfruits to waive the sheave offering before his Father signaling the new incoming harvest and this is exactly why our Messiah is known as... and I quote, “*the first fruit of the resurrection*”. **Leviticus 23:9-11 (scrn 12)**

The Commandment of The First Fruits

Lev 23:9 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,

Lev 23:10 “Speak to the people of Israel and say to them, When you come into the land that I give you and reap its harvest, you shall bring the sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the priest,

Lev 23:11 and he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, so that you may be accepted. On the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it.

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And so it was, that our Messiah who is our High Priest in the order of Melchizedek (according to Hebrews chapter 7 verses 13 through 17)... was resurrected on the day after the Sabbath just as we are told here in Leviticus chapter 23 verse 11... which is Saturday according to the spoken word of Yahovah... and so our Messiah would have been resurrected on a Sunday morning after the Passover... after the Saturday Sabbath... . . . And this is why our Messiah is

also called the “*first fruit*”. And I want to be very clear here. Roman Catholic Easter Sunday morning does not fall on firstfruits. The Roman Catholic Easter Sunday morning is a pagan holiday that was followed by pagans not by Christians. **First Corinthians 15:20-24 (scrn 13)**

Our Messiah, The First Fruit

1Co 15:20 But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep.

1Co 15:21 For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead.

1Co 15:22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive.

1Co 15:23 But each in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ.

1Co 15:24 Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power.



How important is it for us to understand that our Messiah fulfilled the spring feast days? I would submit to you that it is extremely important for us to understand that our Messiah fulfilled all of the spring feast days because if we understand that our Messiah has already fulfilled the spring feast days when he came the first time... it should be clear to us that our Messiah will fulfill the last three fall feast days when he returns the second time. One of the things that you will learn by reading the beginning of the book is that our father in heaven always teaches us through patterns and these patterns (just like the spoken word of Yahovah) are unbreakable. **(scrn 14)**

THE MOEDIM:

Feast Days In Red

Spring Moedim:

Appointed Times

Passover (Pesach)

Unleavened Bread (Chag HaMatzot)

First Fruits (Reishit Katzir)

Pentecost (Shavuot)

Fall Moedim:

Appointed Times

Trumpets (Yom Teruah)

Atonement (Yom Kippur)

Tabernacles (Sukkot)

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Once again concentrating on the first four spring appointments listed here on the left of this chart... Our Messiah died on Passover day to become our Passover lamb. He was the unleavened sinless bread of life that he tells us we must consume in order to be one with him. He was raised up on firstfruits to be our High Priest in the order of Melchizedek to waive the sheave offering before his Father in order to signal the new incoming harvest. And it was because of the request of our Messiah to his Father, that his Father delivered his Ruach Hackodesh... His Holy Spirit to all who truly believe in him by picking up their cross and following him and doing as he did.

We're going to take a short break here for just a couple of moments, and when we come back we're going to fulfill talk about what's left for our Messiah to fulfill and... exactly how we expect him to fulfill these fall feast days. And we are going to line up the Scripture side-by-side in order to see the picture that our Father in heaven has already painted for us concerning the second coming of our Messiah which I would submit to you my friends... is indeed closer now than when we first believed. Stay with us... We'll be back in just a couple minutes. **(BREAK HERE)**

Knowing and understanding these things, we must now ask ourselves what is left? The fall feast days are still left. The day of trumpets falls on the first day of our Father's new month. And this is not according to our modern-day Gregorian calendar. This is according to Yahovah's calendar. And according to Yahovah's calendar... each one of his months starts with a new moon. Let's read the commandment for the day of trumpets so that we can read it for ourselves


and know exactly what it does say and just as importantly... what it does not say. **Leviticus 23:23-25 (scrn 15)**

The Day of Trumpets
Yom Teruah!

Lev 23:23 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,

Lev 23:24 “Speak to the people of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you shall observe a day of solemn rest, a memorial proclaimed with blast of trumpets, a holy convocation.

Lev 23:25 You shall not do any ordinary work, and you shall present a food offering to the LORD.”



When we read this commandment early on in the book of Leviticus chapter 23, it doesn't really seem to give us a lot of detail concerning what it really means, or what it really points to. And I can assure you that most of the house of Israel back in the days of Moses had no idea what it meant or what it pointed to. But you and I who now are standing at the end of the age are blessed with the knowledge of the unfolding plan of salvation that our Father in heaven has already given us by knowing and understanding that our Messiah has already arrived the first time. And we know that our Messiah is going to arrive a second time. Our Messiah has already fulfilled all of the first spring feast days upon his first coming, and we can expect our Messiah to fulfill the last fall feast days at his second coming. And what is the first fall feast day? It is the Day of Trumpets also known as Yom Teruah. It is a day that is to be a solemn day of rest and a day that the trumpets are sounded, and today that the moon will not give its light. Why?

There should be no doubt in any Christians mind, that the reason that this is a day when we are to stop doing what we are doing and to sound the trumpets is because this will be the day of the return of our Messiah when he returns in order to fulfill the fall feast days in the pattern that his Father has laid out before us.

And I know what a lot of people are already thinking because I was thinking the same thing myself. You may be thinking... “*no man knows the day or the hour according to Scripture*”, and you would be correct because it is written that no man knows the day or the hour. But knowing and understanding that our Messiah will return on the day of trumpets still does not

tell us which day and it certainly does not tell us which hour. Our Messiah could return on any day of trumpets that his Father wants him to, and we still do not know which Day of Trumpets he will return. But we expect him to return on The Day of Trumpets because this would indeed fulfill not only prophecy, but would also fulfill the pattern that our Messiah has already laid out before us by fulfilling the spring feast days with his first coming.


Something else that I want us to understand... is what the day is going to be like when our Messiah does return to the earth. What does it say that the day our Messiah returns to the earth is going to be like? You know? Let's turn to **Matthew 24:29-31 (scrn 16)**

The Day of The Return!

Mat 24:29 “Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.

Mat 24:30 Then will appear in heaven the sign of the Son of Man, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

Mat 24:31 And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.



Three extremely important things to notice here in Matthew chapter 24 about the day of the return of our Messiah is number one... that neither the sun nor the moon will give its light. And number two... is that a loud trumpet call will be heard right before our Messiah gathers his elect from the four winds from one end of heaven to the other. And number three... is that all of this will happen immediately after the tribulation of those days. (Which pretty much annihilates the man-made pre-tribulation rescue doctrine that Hollywood has benefited from for years). **(scrn 17)**

The Day of The Return:

- After the Tribulation
- No light from the sun or the moon
- A trumpet call will be sounded
- He will **then**... gather his elect



And so, let's break this down. We know that our Messiah is not going to return until after the tribulation. We know that when our Messiah returns neither the sun nor the moon will be giving its light. We know that there will be a trumpet call. And we know that he will then gather his elect. But we know even more than this when we examine the last three feast days that arrive in the fall.

What do we know about The Day of Trumpets exactly? Well, we know that The Day of Trumpets according to Leviticus chapter 23 tells us that this appointment is to be kept in the seventh month which means that this appointment called The Day of Trumpets is to be kept on the seventh new moon of the year. The number seven always representing the number of God or something that has been completed. And I want us to think about that for just a moment. Why is it important for us to understand that The Day of Trumpets (also known as Yom Teruah) is to be kept in the seventh month? It's important for us to understand this so that... we will not be deceived by what the Jews call their "*Rosh Hashanah*" (which means the beginning of the new year).

Rosh Hashanah is once again a demonically inspired man concocted event that came up out of Babylon. And this is exactly where the rabbis today have gotten this concept of "*Rosh Hashanah*". The day of trumpets is not the Jewish new year as they so proudly and shamefully proclaim. This is nothing short of Babylonian tradition. Clearly... as written in Leviticus chapter 23... this is not the first month of the year.. This is the seventh month of the year. Not says as I... but says our God breathed Scripture.

There is no such thing as "*Rosh Hashanah*" for either a true Jew or a true Christian. And they can cackle all they want and they can say whatever it is that they want because Yahovah gives

them the freedom to cackle and to deceive, and to add to... and to take away from... his word but he also tells us all very clearly that this is **sin** and that the wages of **sin** is indeed death for those who do not accept the truth that his only begotten Son has already come to proclaim. And we must remember that the biblical definition of “*truth*”... Is the spoken word of Yahovah’s Father which our Messiah also kept diligently. And this is why we are to also walk in the same way in which he walked. Let’s turn very quickly to the book of **Exodus 12:1-3 E1**

Exo 12:1 The LORD said to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt,

Exo 12:2 “This month shall be for you the beginning of months. It shall be the first month of the year for you.

Exo 12:3 Tell all the congregation of Israel that on the tenth day of this month every man shall take a lamb according to their fathers' houses, a lamb for a household.

Right here in the book of Exodus chapter 12, we have our Father in heaven establishing his Passover that he says is his Passover in Exodus chapter 12 verse 11. And right here in the spring, when the barley is ripe and a new moon is hanging dark in the sky, is what our Father in heaven says is the beginning of months and the first month of the new year for us.

My friends you do not have to be a rocket scientist to know and to understand that the seventh month on the Day of Atonement cannot be the Jewish new year. The only way that the seventh month on the Day of Atonement can be the Jewish new year is if the Jewish people accept the lie of the Babylonian rabbis who have come up out of Babylon.

Do you see... do you understand why it is important for us as modern-day Christians not to run into the arms of Judaism! Do you see that there is a narrow path where the truth can be found? My friends the truth is not embedded in today’s modern-day version of Christianity. And the truth is not embedded in today’s modern-day version of rabbinical Judaism. Strait is the gate and narrow is the path and few there be that find. Where is it? It is in the truth. And what is the truth? The truth is the spoken word of Yahovah. There is no other truth, there is no other way, and there is no other religion. And only those that speak the truth of the word of Yahovah... have the truth. If you are reading or studying something about Rosh Hashanah, turn it off, throw it away, put it in the trashcan, and get away from it! And if your pastor or your teacher is not preparing you for the work of ministry, and if he is not protecting you from every wind of doctrine and human cunning and human craftiness and deceitful scheme... then you need a new pastor or teacher. Getting back to the day of trumpets: **(scrn 17)**

The Day of The Return:

- After the Tribulation
- No light from the sun or the moon
- A trumpet call will be sounded
- He will then... gather his elect



Once again, we know through our God breathed Scripture spoken of by the red-letter words of our Messiah found in Matthew chapter 24 tell us, that the day of his return will not come until after the tribulation. We also know that no light from the sun or the moon will be shown. We also know that a trumpet call will be sounded, and we also know that it will be at this time... **after the tribulation**... after the sun and the moon do not give its light... after the trumpet call... that our Messiah will then... gather his elect.

Now... I want us to examine once again the Day of Trumpets which we already know falls on our Father's seventh month which would be the seventh new moon from his first new moon that arrives in the month of Passover. So, let's compare what our Messiah tells us about the day of his return in Matthew chapter 24... and what we are told about the Day of Trumpets in the book of Leviticus. (**scrn 18**)

The Day of The Return:

Day of Return

- After the Tribulation
- No light from the sun or the moon
- A trumpet call will be sounded
- He will **then**... gather his elect

Day of Trumpets

- 7th Month (the number 7 = complete)
- No Light from the sun or the moon
- A trumpet call will be sounded



Do you see any similarities here between the day of the return of our Messiah and the day of trumpets? Because I would submit to you my friends that they are exactly the same. We know that our Messiah fulfilled the first spring feast days, and because he did fulfill the first spring days, we expect him to fulfill the last fall feast days much the same way. This indeed does fit the pattern that Yahovah has laid out before us. We also know that the Day of Trumpets is in the seventh month and the number seven in the Bible always points to being a number of completeness.

We also know that on the day of trumpets because it falls on a new moon, that the moon will be hanging dark in the sky. And I want to make sure that we understand that a new moon is different than a full moon. A full moon is when the moon is full and shining brightly. This does not happen until our Messiah comes to tabernacle with us which happens on the last fall feast day which is during the feast of Tabernacles (also known as Sukkot). But on the day of atonement the moon, is not giving its light.

And so, the point I'm trying to make is that a new moon is when the moon is hanging dark in the sky which is why the Day of Trumpets is established on the day when the moon is not giving its light. Now you might say that the sun will be giving its light on the day of atonement, but I would submit to you that it will not be giving its light after sundown. After sundown on that day neither the sun nor the moon will be giving its light. And I also would submit to you that even if our Messiah does come during the daylight, the sign of the Son of Man written about in the 24th chapter of the book of Matthew most likely will cover up and block the light from the sun. Either way you look at it, neither the sun nor the moon will be giving its light on the Day of Atonement that he returns on.

I would also like to comment on those who keep the sliver of the moon. There are some of our brethren who will wait until they see the sliver of the moon in order to establish the new moon. My answer to this doctrine is once again... that no such commandment is ever found within the 66 books of your Bible. No such doctrine is found in the Bible that says that you must wait three days to see the sliver of the moon. In fact, the Bible actually speaks the opposite of this man-made doctrine in first Samuel chapter 20 when we find Saul trying to kill David at the feast of the new moon which is held when the moon was hanging dark in the sky. And this is why David had to hide for three days until the sliver of the moon could verify that the new moon had already taken place three days earlier.

The new moon feast was not held on the sliver of the moon according to first Samuel chapter 20. The feast was held when the moon was hanging dark in the sky. The sliver of the moon simply verified that the new moon had already taken place. And David knew before hand when the new moon was going to be according to first Samuel chapter 20, and this is why David hid for three days from King Saul until the new moon feasts were over and he no longer had to be present at the feast next to King Saul.

And so, those who say that the moon will not be dark on the Day of Atonement because they are standing around waiting for the sliver of the moon are indeed again in error according to the spoken word of Yahovah. Waiting for the sliver of the moon once again breaks the pattern that Yahovah has put forth in his God breathed Scripture. Darkness always comes first then light. Man is born into darkness and then comes to the light. Our Messiah will come in darkness, and he will bring light. A day begins at sundown in darkness, the day then brings light. Yahovah does not say wait for the sliver of the moon, Yahovah says and I quote, “*on the new moon*” not “*on the sliver of the moon*” which he could very well have easily said. There are indeed words in the Hebrew language for “*the sliver of the moon*” which he did not use. Once again, adding to... and taking away from... the word of Yahovah always leads to deception.

And I would like to once again touch on the fact that no one knows the day or the hour. This once again is true but... just because we know the season that our Messiah will come, does not mean that we know the exact Day of Trumpets that he will come on. I want us all to understand that our Messiah will not come like a thief in the night to us. Our Messiah will come like a thief in the night to the world... but he will not come like a thief in the night to us. Why? Because we will be awake and sober, we will be watching, we will be reading the spoken word of his Father which Is the truth, and we who have been chosen will indeed understand his Father’s patterns, and we will know the season that he will indeed return. Not since I... but says our God breathed Scripture. Let’s turn to first **Thessalonians 5:1-10 E2**

1Th 5:1 Now concerning the times and the seasons, brothers, you have no need to have anything written to you.

1Th 5:2 For you yourselves are fully aware that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night.

1Th 5:3 While people are saying, “There is peace and security,” then sudden

destruction will come upon them as labor pains come upon a pregnant woman, and they will not escape.

1Th 5:4 But you are not in darkness, brothers, for that day to surprise you like a thief.

1Th 5:5 For you are all children of light, children of the day. We are not of the night or of the darkness.

1Th 5:6 So then let us not sleep, as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober.

1Th 5:7 For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk, are drunk at night.

1Th 5:8 But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation.

1Th 5:9 For God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,

1Th 5:10 who died for us so that whether we are awake or asleep we might live with him.

You see, our Messiah will not return like a thief in the night to us. Our Messiah will return like a thief in the night to the world who is not watching for him, who is not studying the spoken word of his Father, who does not understand his Father's patterns, and who is not remaining sober in the spoken word of Yahovah.

What is the world teaching and preaching today? Is it not teaching a pre-tribulation rescue? Is it not preaching and teaching once saved always saved? Is it not preaching and teaching peace and security for those who believe? When the whole time our Messiah is telling us that because the world hated him, they will hate us, and because they persecuted him, they will indeed persecute us also? Our Messiah tells us over, and over, and over again in every one of the seven letters that he wrote to the seven assemblies in the book of Revelation... that we must conquer over evil even unto death in order to receive the crown of life. It will be those who conquer who will receive the crown of life. It will be the one who endures to the end... who will receive the crown of life.

Do you see the difference between being sober and being drunk on the word of man and being drunk on the deceptions of the Dragon who is the god of this world, the prince of the air, the cosmic power over this present darkness, and the spiritual force that we have been warned is now warring against us as we speak because he knows his time is short?

Before we close the first part of our study here this morning, I want to also show you a great resource that you can use to know when a new moon, or a full moon is going to arrive in the sky. You can do this through calculation, but you can do it much more quickly by simply going to moongiant.com (**scrn 19**)



Once again, this calendar is brought to you compliments of moongiant.com, and we can clearly see here that our Father's new moon, which is indeed the seventh new moon from the Passover, arrives on September 17 in 2020. Which is this coming Thursday. However... we must remember that our Father's days do not run from midnight to midnight like our modern-day Gregorian calendar does. Our Father in heaven... according to his calendar dictates that his days run from sundown to sundown. Therefore... the Day of Atonement will begin at sundown Wednesday evening the 16th, and will run until sundown Thursday the 17th of this next week. Therefore... there will be no Bible study this coming Wednesday evening but... there will be a fellowship this coming Wednesday evening on the 16th because we are commanded in Leviticus chapter 23 to not only rest on this day, but we are also commanded to have a holy convocation with a blast of trumpets.

And so, I would like to invite everybody to grab your shofars or your trumpets or your noisemakers or whatever you might have that makes noise... and to join us Wednesday evening at 8 PM Eastern standard Time for our Day of Atonement convocation. And again, if you would like to join us for that fellowship all you have to do is email me at pastorv@holyimpactministries.com... That's pastorv@holyimpactministries.com, and just put the word "*fellowship*" in the subject line of your email and we will send you an invitation for fellowship this coming Wednesday evening and also every Saturday from 3 to 6 PM Eastern standard Time when we have our regular Holy Impact Ministries fellowship. As for now, we will close the books for this Sabbath, and pick up where we left off next seventh day Sabbath when we begin to see the unfolding pattern of the Day of Atonement that comes 10 days later after the Day of Trumpets. This is the day that we expect that Yahovah will indeed make war against the ungodly, it is a day of affliction, we see it as a representation of the great and terrible day of the Lord that will leave the carcasses of the dead heaped upon the horizons. It is written that on that day, it will take Israel seven months to bury the dead, and the birds of prey will come to feast and gorge themselves upon what's left of Kings and princes and on what's left of those who have rejected the only begotten Son of Yahovah and his free gift of salvation.

In closing, I would like to once again reiterate how important it is to understand these things as we are now standing at the end of the age today in our time. If you think that these things have no relevance, if you think that these things are just done haphazardly, if you think that everything that our Father does he does for no apparent reason... I would encourage you to stay with us for our next Sabbath study as we explain in more striking detail... the fall feast days (which are not all doom and gloom I might add).

Until then, I will as I always do ask everyone within the sound of my voice to please take what you have heard here today to your own prayer closet. Bow your head, and bend your knee, and face the holy promised land of Jerusalem, and ask in the name of Yeshua Hamashiach if what you have heard here today be true or not. Ask, seek, and knock on his door and on his door loam and the door will be open to you. And if you will do that, and if you will stay the course to the end, you and I will surely walk to the gates of his soon coming kingdom together.
