



Deuteronomy Chapter 15b The Return of The Sacrifice!

Once again, I just want to say Shabbat shalom and welcome to another very important study concerning not just the book of Deuteronomy in of itself this morning... but a study that has everything to do with the whole of the Bible including our very salvation in these last days.

What I am about to share with you is something that the majority of professing Christians have no concept of. What I'm about to share with you only a few fringe portions of the Christian community are even aware of.

What you will hear from the Scriptures this evening is going to be monumental concerning your faith and your walk, and your understanding of end time prophecy.

It never ceases to amaze me how many people are wrongly going through all of the trouble to put together very alluring videos concerning Bible prophecy that are doing nothing but leading people astray because they do not have the fundamental foundation of the promise of Yehovah the Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob set firmly within their hearts and their minds.

Far too many prophecy teachers today reach over and under and around what the Scripture actually says in order to create for themselves an astounding story fit for the fanciful silver screen of Hollywood. And

they do these things because it creates a never ending cash flow from those who never read the Bible for themselves.

And this is exactly why it is with great pleasure that I bring this study to you this evening that comes directly from the Bible and the Bible alone.

This evening we will see things not from the book of Enoch, not from the Apocrypha, not from the writings of the rabbis or from the Pope of Rome.

This evening we're going to see how the 1000-year millennial reign of our Messiah is going to unfold in great detail. And were going to see the temple rebuilt, and were going to see the sacrifices reinitiated, and we're going to see our Messiah ruling over the nations of the earth with a rod of iron not according to myth or legend or imagination, but according to our God breathed Scripture and our God breathed Scripture alone.

And therefore... for those of you who have been with us throughout our study into the book of Deuteronomy, you already know that the book of Deuteronomy is all about Moses reminding the house of Israel of everything that they have been through and both the blessings and the curses of Yehovah God so that... so that... they might remember the commandment of Yehovah and do it.

And just as we have said last week during our study into the book of Deuteronomy, it's important to take a break now that we are about halfway through the book of Deuteronomy in order to understand as modern-day Christians, that what we see in the book of Deuteronomy is indeed going to come full circle upon the arrival of our Messiah who will bring us all back to his temple where he originally desired for us to be in the first place.

And one of the very first places that I want to start this evening is in Isaiah chapter 56, because Isaiah chapter 56 has everything to do with salvation not just for the original house of Israel... but also for the

extended and expanded house of Israel that will indeed stand at the end of the age. The house of Israel that will not only contain those who are related to Abraham by blood... but a house of Israel that will be expanded beyond measure with people not related to Abraham by blood but rather by the spirit.

What most modern-day Christians do not understand is that the house of Israel from the very beginning was always a conglomerate of a mixed multitude of people. Jacob whose name was changed to Israel has many descendants. But not all of them are the descendants of his physical body. Many of Jacob's descendants are the descendants of the spirit of Jacob that has reached out over the ages and touch the hearts and the minds of those who willfully and intentionally choose the one true Elohim of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob as their Father.

And we could get into a whole study concerning Romans chapter 11 of the New Testament or Galatians chapter 3 of the New Testament or the book of Hebrews or Revelation or really almost any of the 27 books that make up the New Testament concerning the grafting in of the Gentile into the house of Israel. And to be sure we have plenty of studies at our website at HolyImpactMinistries.com, and at our YouTube channel that address these biblical truths... but for this evening, I'd like to concentrate on the topic at hand which has everything to do with the law of Yehovah God coming full circle back to where it belongs in the heart of the Christian at the end of the age. And therefore, let us begin with **Isaiah chapter 56 verses one through eight E1**

Salvation for Foreigners

Isa 56:1 Thus says the LORD: "Keep justice, and do righteousness, for soon my salvation will come, and my righteousness be revealed."

Isa 56:2 Blessed is the man who does this, and the son of man who holds it fast, who keeps the Sabbath, not profaning it, and keeps his hand from doing any evil."

Isa 56:3 Let not the foreigner who has joined himself to the LORD say, "The LORD will surely separate me from his people"; and let not the eunuch say, "Behold, I am a dry tree."

Isa 56:4 For thus says the LORD: "To the eunuchs who keep my Sabbaths, who choose the things that please me and hold fast my covenant,

Isa 56:5 I will give in my house and within my walls a monument and a name better than sons and daughters; I will give them an everlasting name that shall not be cut off.

Isa 56:6 "And the foreigners who join themselves to the LORD, to minister to him, to love the name of the LORD, and to be his servants, everyone who keeps the Sabbath and does not profane it, and holds fast my covenant—

Isa 56:7 these I will bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer; their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be accepted on my altar; for my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples."

Isa 56:8 The Lord GOD, who gathers the outcasts of Israel, declares, "I will gather yet others to him besides those already gathered."

Here in Isaiah chapter 56, we find Yehovah our Father's promise to not only the physical descendants of Jacob... but also to those who are being grafted into the house of Israel here in the Old Testament. And yes... I said his promise to those who are not the physical descendants of Jacob here in the Old Testament.

It never ceases to amaze me how many modern-day Christians are ignorant of the fact that our Father in heaven was already grafting the Gentiles into the house of Israel clear back in the Old Testament.

These things are hardly ever taught within the confines of today's modern-day denominational church who has thrown away the law of Yehovah God and done away with all of his Old Testament commandments except... except... that old Levitical law of tithing 10% of your income to them. That old Levitical law they still believe in. Hmmm... I wonder why?

Right here in Isaiah chapter 56 verse one our Father in heaven tells us that soon his salvation will come and that his righteousness will be revealed.

Now, many will say "The prophet Isaiah lived thousands of years ago, so how could God say that his salvation was coming soon when Yeshua

Jesus did not come until much later on in history?” But we must remember that it is written in second Peter chapter 3 verse eight that one day is like a thousand years to our Father in heaven. Time for him does not work the same way that time for us does. And therefore, if we see prophecy unfolding in his time... it would only have been a couple of days before Yeshua Jesus in the Greek would have arrived on the world stage.

But he says more than this... he says “Let not the foreigner who has joined himself to Yehovah say “Yehovah will surely separate me from his people”; and let not the eunuch say “behold I am a dry tree.” And he goes on to tell us in Isaiah chapter 56 that the Gentiles who have joined themselves to Yehovah to minister to him and to love his name, and those who understand the biblical definition of the love of God found in first John chapter 5 verse three... will be brought to his holy mountain. And not only will they be brought to his holy mountain, but he shall make them joyful in his house of prayer where their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be accepted on his altar. And I want to stop and think about that for just a moment.

Are the Gentiles going to be making sacrifices at his altar according to our God breathed Scripture? The unequivocal answer to that question is a resounding yes! You’ve just read it here in Isaiah chapter 56 and therefore... it can no longer be refuted.

And I also want to stop right here for just a moment in order to let that sink in. My friends... once we read something within the confines of Scripture it no longer remains a question. Once we read something within the confines of Scripture it becomes fact, indisputable, unarguable, foundational fact. And therefore, the question has therefore been removed from the equation and replaced with scriptural fact that comes directly from our God breathed Scripture.

And therefore, since we know that it is an un-disputable fact that the Gentile will indeed be bringing burnt offerings and sacrifices to Yehovah

God's temple... we need to ask ourselves when and why this is going to take place.

In order to answer this question, we need to be biblically literate, and we must also examine the biblical facts that encompass the events of Gog and Magog. Who are Gog and Magog, and what is the purpose of the story of Gog and Magog, and what does Gog and Magog finally lead to according to Scripture and Scripture alone? We'll discuss these biblical events and more as we work through this study next week, but for now... we've got a lot of work to do in order to get to that major future event.

We are going to dive deeply into the biblical facts concerning the story of Gog and Magog, but before we do we need to understand what is going to take place concerning the return of our Messiah to the earth. And therefore in order to do that let's turn this evening to **Revelation chapter 20 and let's read verses one through six E2**

The Thousand Years

Rev 20:1 Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, holding in his hand the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain.

Rev 20:2 And he seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years,

Rev 20:3 and threw him into the pit, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he might not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were ended. After that he must be released for a little while.

Rev 20:4 Then I saw thrones, and seated on them were those to whom the authority to judge was committed. Also I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for the testimony of Jesus and for the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.

Rev 20:5 The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended. This is the first resurrection.

Rev 20:6 Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection! Over such the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him for a thousand years.

According to Revelation chapter 20 those who had been beheaded for the testimony of Yeshua during the tribulation period, are going to come to life and reign with our Messiah for a thousand years. And we can see this in Revelation chapter 20 verse four. Once again... this is not hearsay, not conjecture, not a maybe or a could be... but a fact according to Scripture.

Those who will be murdered during the tribulation period will indeed come to life and reign with our Messiah for 1000 years says our God breathed Scripture. From here I would like to go to Isaiah chapter 11 where we can clearly see the purpose and mission of Yeshua Jesus in the Greek from the perspective of the prophets. **Isaiah chapter 11 E3**

The Righteous Reign of the Branch

Isa 11:1 There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch from his roots shall bear fruit.

Isa 11:2 And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD.

Isa 11:3 And his delight shall be in the fear of the LORD. He shall not judge by what his eyes see, or decide disputes by what his ears hear,

Isa 11:4 but with righteousness he shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; and he shall strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips he shall kill the wicked.

Isa 11:5 Righteousness shall be the belt of his waist, and faithfulness the belt of his loins.

Isa 11:6 The wolf shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the young goat, and the calf and the lion and the fattened calf together; and a little child shall lead them.

Isa 11:7 The cow and the bear shall graze; their young shall lie down together; and the lion shall eat straw like the ox.

Isa 11:8 The nursing child shall play over the hole of the cobra, and the weaned child shall put his hand on the adder's den.

Isa 11:9 They shall not hurt or destroy in all my holy mountain; for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD as the waters cover the sea.

Isa 11:10 In that day the root of Jesse, who shall stand as a signal for the

peoples—of him shall the nations inquire, and his resting place shall be glorious.

Isa 11:11 In that day the Lord will extend his hand yet a second time to recover the remnant that remains of his people, from Assyria, from Egypt, from Pathros, from Cush, from Elam, from Shinar, from Hamath, and from the coastlands of the sea.

Isa 11:12 He will raise a signal for the nations and will assemble the banished of Israel, and gather the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

Isa 11:13 The jealousy of Ephraim shall depart, and those who harass Judah shall be cut off; Ephraim shall not be jealous of Judah, and Judah shall not harass Ephraim.

Isa 11:14 But they shall swoop down on the shoulder of the Philistines in the west, and together they shall plunder the people of the east. They shall put out their hand against Edom and Moab, and the Ammonites shall obey them.

Isa 11:15 And the LORD will utterly destroy the tongue of the Sea of Egypt, and will wave his hand over the River with his scorching breath, and strike it into seven channels, and he will lead people across in sandals.

Isa 11:16 And there will be a highway from Assyria for the remnant that remains of his people, as there was for Israel when they came up from the land of Egypt.

For those of you who do not know Jesse was the father of David. And the prophet Isaiah tells us that there would come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch from his roots shall bear fruit.

Clearly the fruit that Isaiah is talking about was indeed David the eighth son of Jesse whose throne our Messiah Yeshua now sits upon. And it is written right here in Isaiah chapter 11 verse three that his delight shall be in the fear of Yehovah and that he shall not judge by what he's sees or decide disputes by what his ears here, but with righteousness he shall judge the poor and decide with equity for the meek of the earth and that he will strike the earth with the rod of his mouth and with the breath of his lips he shall kill the wicked.

This my friends is exactly what's going to happen during the return of our Messiah when he strikes the earth with the rod of his mouth and with the breath of his lips he will indeed kill the wicked. Righteousness shall

be the belt of his waist and faithfulness the belt of his loins.

And because our Messiah is going to do this when he returns, the wolf shall dwell with the lamb and the leopard shall lie down with the young goat, and the calf and the lion and the fatted calf together, and a little child shall lead them.

But I want us to pay close attention to Isaiah chapter 11 verse 11 where we are told that the Lord will extend his hand yet a second time to recover the remnant that remains of his people from Assyria, from Egypt, from Patros, from Cush, from Shinar, from Hamath, and from the coastlands of the sea. It is written in verse 12 that he shall raise a signal for the nations and will assemble the banished of Israel and gather the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth and that the jealousy of Ephraim shall depart, and those who harass Judah shall be cut off, and that Ephraim shall not be jealous of Judah and Judah shall not harass Ephraim. And it is written in verse 16 that there shall be a highway from Assyria for the remnant that remains of his people as there was for Israel when they came up out of the land of Egypt.

In other words, our Messiah is going to gather his people back into Jerusalem once again to rule with him for a thousand years during his millennial reign on earth when the devil will be bound and held in a pit for that thousand years. And just as we read in Revelation chapter 20, those who have risen from the dead during the first resurrection will rule and reign with our Messiah over the nations of the earth for a thousand years according to Scripture.

And so, my question thus far is... are you with me so far? Do you understand what we've just read? And is what we've just read cemented in your heart and in your mind? Because it needs to be. This is what our God breathed Scripture says. We did not get this from a Bible commentator, or a rabbi, or a Pope, or a denominational essay written by some charter of men. The information that we have just read comes directly from your Bible and therefore is indeed... truth.

Keeping all of this in mind, I would like to turn to the topic of a third Temple.

Over the years I have heard many people speculating and the theorizing over whether there will actually be a third Temple built on earth or not. And over the years I have heard many people say that there doesn't have to be a third Temple that needs to be built. But... I would submit to you that the only reason that someone might say such a thing is because they have not read the Bible for themselves. Because as we read the Bible, and as we continue to study, that question is also removed from the equation. Will there be a third Temple upon the earth in the last days?

The answer to that question can be found in Ezekiel chapters 40 through 49. All of the prophets tell us very clearly that there will be a third temple built upon the earth. And not only do they tell us that there will be a third temple but there will also be sacrifices that will be made at that temple by both Jew and Gentile. And according to the prophets, this third temple will dwarf all of the other temples previously built. And I would like us to read about how the glory of Yehovah will fill that magnificent temple. We can find that in **Ezekiel chapter 43 verses one through 12 E4**

The Glory of the Lord Fills the Temple

Eze 43:1 Then he led me to the gate, the gate facing east.

Eze 43:2 And behold, the glory of the God of Israel was coming from the east. And the sound of his coming was like the sound of many waters, and the earth shone with his glory.

Eze 43:3 And the vision I saw was just like the vision that I had seen when he came to destroy the city, and just like the vision that I had seen by the Chebar canal. And I fell on my face.

Eze 43:4 As the glory of the LORD entered the temple by the gate facing east,

Eze 43:5 the Spirit lifted me up and brought me into the inner court; and behold, the glory of the LORD filled the temple.

Eze 43:6 While the man was standing beside me, I heard one speaking to

me out of the temple,

Eze 43:7 and he said to me, "Son of man, this is the place of my throne and the place of the soles of my feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the people of Israel forever. And the house of Israel shall no more defile my holy name, neither they, nor their kings, by their whoring and by the dead bodies of their kings at their high places,

Eze 43:8 by setting their threshold by my threshold and their doorposts beside my doorposts, with only a wall between me and them. They have defiled my holy name by their abominations that they have committed, so I have consumed them in my anger.

Eze 43:9 Now let them put away their whoring and the dead bodies of their kings far from me, and I will dwell in their midst forever.

Eze 43:10 "As for you, son of man, describe to the house of Israel the temple, that they may be ashamed of their iniquities; and they shall measure the plan.

Eze 43:11 And if they are ashamed of all that they have done, make known to them the design of the temple, its arrangement, its exits and its entrances, that is, its whole design; and make known to them as well all its statutes and its whole design and all its laws, and write it down in their sight, so that they may observe all its laws and all its statutes and carry them out.

Eze 43:12 This is the law of the temple: the whole territory on the top of the mountain all around shall be most holy. Behold, this is the law of the temple.

And so, here in the 40 third chapter of the book of Ezekiel verse 11 we hear that only those who are ashamed of all that they have done... get that my friends... only those who are ashamed of all they have done are allowed to see the design of the temple and its arrangement and its statutes and its laws so that they may observe all of its laws and all of its statutes and carry them out.

In other words, not everyone is going to see this temple. Not everyone is going to know that it is going to exist. The only ones that are going to know about this third temple are those who are ashamed of what they have done and have turned and repented. And to this very day I tell you the truth, this is why so many do not see this third temple, nor do they understand the importance of its return to the earth along with our Messiah.

The primary objection made by the church today concerning animal sacrifices returning during the millennial kingdom is that our Messiah has come and offered a perfect sacrifice for sin and there is therefore no need to sacrifice animals for sin. However... however... it must be remembered that animal sacrifice never remove the sin that spiritually separated a person from Yehovah. And we talked about this to some degree during our study last week. But before we get into that topic, I would like for us to read **Hebrews chapter 10 verses one through four**
E5

Christ's Sacrifice Once for All

Heb 10:1 For since the law has but a shadow of the good things to come instead of the true form of these realities, it can never, by the same sacrifices that are continually offered every year, make perfect those who draw near.

Heb 10:2 Otherwise, would they not have ceased to be offered, since the worshipers, having once been cleansed, would no longer have any consciousness of sins?

Heb 10:3 But in these sacrifices there is a reminder of sins every year.

Heb 10:4 For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.

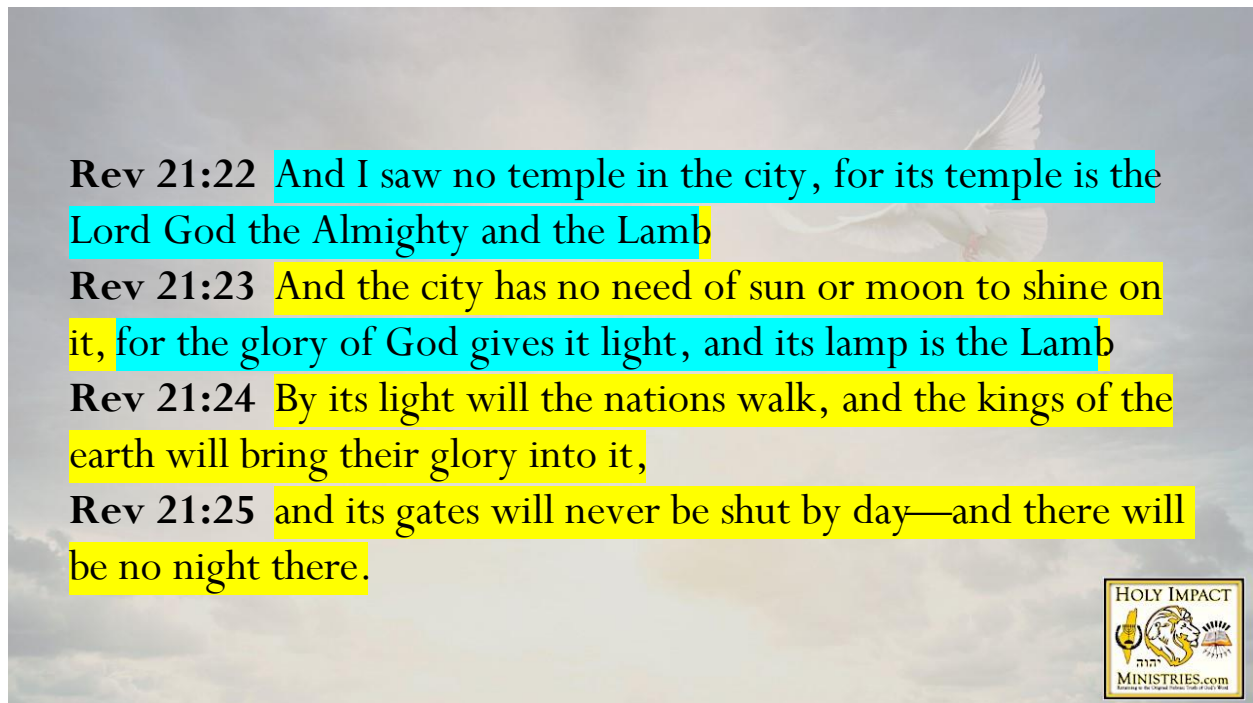
Heb 10:5 Consequently, when Christ came into the world, he said, "Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired, but a body have you prepared for me;

Heb 10:6 in burnt offerings and sin offerings you have taken no pleasure.

The church today who has replaced our Messiah with the misinterpreted teachings of the apostle Paul will object to a third temple and the sacrificial offerings to Yehovah being made because of what they read right here in Hebrews chapter 10 never understanding the greater picture of Hebrews chapter 10.

The first thing that I would like us to notice about Hebrews chapter 10 is verse one where it says that the law has but a shadow of good things to come. What are those good things to come? The good things to come do

not happen until after the millennial reign of our Messiah when Yehovah our Father does away with the heavens and the earth and creates a new heaven and a new earth and makes all things new again. This is when we will once again walk with our Father in heaven just as Adam did in the garden of Eden. **(scrn 1 show only)**



And according to Revelation chapter 21 verse 22... there will be no temple in the new Jerusalem at that time because Yehvoah himself who is the word of God and the Law... along with the Lamb of Yehvoah God will walk among his people just as he did with Adam in the beginning. And this is once again why we know that the prophets are not speaking about after the 1000-year millennial reign of our Messiah, but during the 1000-year millennial reign. Because after that 1000-year millennial reign there will be no Temple in the new Jerusalem.

But what we need to understand is that this new heaven and new earth and along with this new Jerusalem does not happen until after the 1000-year millennial reign of our Messiah on the old earth. Our Messiah must rule and reign on this earth that we are standing on right now for a

thousand years as he rules over the nations for those 1000 years so that every single solitary soul can be given the opportunity to choose who it is that they will ultimately serve. The new heaven and the new earth does not come until Revelation chapter 21 clear at the back of the book after the 1000 year millennial reign of our Messiah. Let's read that in **Revelation chapter 21 verses one through eight E6**

The New Heaven and the New Earth

Rev 21:1 Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more.

Rev 21:2 And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

Rev 21:3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God.

Rev 21:4 He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away."

Rev 21:5 And he who was seated on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." Also he said, "Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true."

Rev 21:6 And he said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. To the thirsty I will give from the spring of the water of life without payment.

Rev 21:7 The one who conquers will have this heritage, and I will be his God and he will be my son.

Rev 21:8 But as for the cowardly, the faithless, the detestable, as for murderers, the sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars, their portion will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulfur, which is the second death."

According to verse one, a new heaven and a new earth will be created and the first heaven and the first earth will pass away. And this is written about all throughout the Bible not just here in Revelation chapter 21. We are told very clearly that the heavens and the earth will be done away with by fire. This is after the 1000-year millennial reign of our Messiah. This is clear at the back of the Bible in the last two chapters of the book of Revelation that we find the revelation of this new heaven and this new

earth along with this new Jerusalem and this new beginning. But... once again we need to be clear... before this new heaven and this new earth and this new Jerusalem can be brought down to the earth... every single solitary human soul must have the opportunity to choose who it is that they will serve. Each and every single solitary human soul must have the opportunity to choose good over evil or... evil over good. And this is exactly what this 1000-year millennial reign of our Messiah is all about.

The last remaining people who are left alive upon the earth after the return of our Messiah who comes to kill the wicked and to smash these nations like clay pots will have an opportunity for this last thousand years to choose and to serve Yehovah their creator. And this goes right back to what we read from the prophet Zechariah in **Zechariah chapter 14 verses 16 through 19 (scrn 2)**

Zec 14:16 Then everyone who survives of all the nations that have come against Jerusalem shall go up year after year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Booths.

Zec 14:17 And if any of the families of the earth do not go up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, there will be no rain on them.

Zec 14:18 And if the family of Egypt does not go up and present themselves, then on them there shall be no rain; there shall be the plague with which the LORD afflicts the nations that do not go up to keep the Feast of Booths.

Zec 14:19 This shall be the punishment to Egypt and the punishment to all the nations that do not go up to keep the Feast of Booths.



Just as we read here from the prophet Zachariah, all the nations of the world at that point in time which has not happened yet... will be commanded to come to Jerusalem to worship the King who is Yehovah and to keep the feast of booths. And we must remember that our Father

in heaven is indeed the King of Kings. He is the most High Elohim over all Elohim. And this is exactly who our human King Yeshua came to bring us back to.

And if any of these nations of the earth do not go to Jerusalem to keep the feast of booths which is also known as the feast of Tabernacles or Sukkot... they will receive no rain which means that they will not eat.

And therefore, getting back to **Hebrews chapter 10 E5** again show **only**

We must remember that according to Hebrews chapter 10 verse three, in these sacrifices there is a reminder of sins every year. And I would like to stop and think about that for just a moment. Why would our Father in heaven want to remind the nations of the earth who had survived the battle against Israel of their sins every year?

The answer should be clear... because they are a sinful people! This is exactly why he wants them to remember their sins year after year. Especially in light of what is going to take place after this 1000 year

millennial reign when the devil will be loose and the armies of Gog and Magog will for the last time come against the house of Israel who will be at that time dwelling in peace without gates or walls.

Even after a 1000-year training course in how to love and serve their creator many of the people of the nations of the earth will once again join forces with the devil in order to attempt to erase Jerusalem the thrown of Yehvoah God from the earth. And it will be at that time that the very last attempt of the devil to kill the offspring of the human women and those who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Yeshua... will be burned alive and brought to nothing more than ashes before his body even hits the ground.

What must be understood is that the blood of bulls and goats never took away the sins of mankind. At least not on their own. The blood of bulls and goats was put into place in order to remind God's people of the ultimate sacrifice that had to be made by our Passover lamb who was the Lamb of God, the only begotten Son of God, the Son of David the Son of Abraham who Yehovah God chose because he was without blemish and without sin.

The nations will not be making sacrifices in order to be forgiven of their transgressions... they will be making sacrifices in remembrance of the sacrifice that has already been made for them and to remind them of what sin costs. Which was always the original intent of the animal sacrifice from the beginning. They will need to be re-taught just like the original house of Israel was taught.

You see, the church today is incapable of seeing the bigger picture. The church today has its own doctrines and its own dogmas and its own philosophies and its own man-made scientific hermeneutics that dictate what these charters of men believe as well as... what they don't believe.

And they don't believe what the Bible says because it makes them uncomfortable. What the Bible says does not scratch their itching ears.

What the Bible says does not leave them comfortably sitting in their own sin not having to participate in anything or to stand for or against anything.

The blood of bulls and goats will once again be a reminder to God's sinful people of the sacrifice that the Lamb of God willfully and intentionally provided for the remission of their sins. Listen closely to what David tells us in **Psalms chapter 51 verses 15-19 (scrn 3)**

Psa 51:15 O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise.

Psa 51:16 For you will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it; you will not be pleased with a burnt offering.

Psa 51:17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.

Psa 51:18 Do good to Zion in your good pleasure; build up the walls of Jerusalem;

Psa 51:19 then will you delight in right sacrifices, in burnt offerings and whole burnt offerings; then bulls will be offered on your altar.



Notice that David does not say that God does not delight in sacrifices made to him. This is once again a miss-representation of Scripture. Pay close attention to verses 18 and 19 where David tells us that once we do good to Zion and in his good pleasure then... then... you will delight in right sacrifices in burnt offerings and whole burnt offerings... then David says bulls will be offered on your altar.

And therefore, it's not a matter of weather or not God appreciates our gifts being left at his altar... it's a matter of gifts being let at his altar by a wicked and adulterous people. These are the gifts that he despises. And

this is exactly why Yehvoah God no longer accepted the gifts left at the alter by sinful Israel and this is why he allowed them to be over-run by their enemies and taken into bondage, and his Temple being brought to desolation.

This 1000-year millennial reign of our Messiah will indeed be the last opportunity for anyone who is left alive to turn and to repent. Consider what is written in **second Peter chapter 3 verses 10 through 13 (scrn 4)**

2Pe 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed.

2Pe 3:11 Since all these things are thus to be dissolved, what sort of people ought you to be in lives of holiness and godliness,

2Pe 3:12 waiting for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be set on fire and dissolved, and the heavenly bodies will melt as they burn!

2Pe 3:13 But according to his promise we are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.



All of the prophets, and even the apostles tell us that we are not just waiting for the return of our Messiah to the earth... but we are also waiting for a new heaven and a new earth to be created after the 1000 year millennial reign of our Messiah when the remnant of mankind will once again just like in the days of Noah... be given a new beginning, a third Exodus if you will... greater than the first two Exodus events by leaps and bounds where the remnant of mankind will finally be removed from the old earth and arrive where Yehovah God had originally intended mankind to be in a completely new redesigned world where

man will finally live in peace and security knowing without a doubt who his creator actually is. **E7 show only:**

Final Words

2Pe 3:14 Therefore, beloved, since you are waiting for these, be diligent to be found by him **without spot or blemish**, and at peace.

2Pe 3:15 And count the patience of our Lord as salvation, just as our beloved brother Paul also wrote to you according to the wisdom given him,

2Pe 3:16 as he does in all his letters when he speaks in them of these matters. There are some things in them that are hard to understand, which the ignorant and unstable twist to their own destruction, as they do the other Scriptures.

2Pe 3:17 You therefore, beloved, knowing this beforehand, take care that you are not carried away with the error of lawless people and lose your own stability.

2Pe 3:18 But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be the glory both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.

You see, just as the apostle Peter has told us, the writings of the apostle Paul are difficult to understand, and Peter warns us in second Peter chapter 3 verse 16 that Paul's writings are hard to understand and that the ignorant and the unstable would twist the writings of the apostle Paul to their own destruction as they do the other Scriptures.

But that's not the shocking part. The shocking part of what Peter tells us is found in verse 17 where Peter tells us that knowing this beforehand, we should take care that we are not carried away with the error of lawless people and lose our own stability.

And it is exactly for this reason that the church by and large today has lost its way. The denominational Christian church today who follows after Roman Catholicism and her first day of the week Sunday Sabbath and her Christ mass, and her Easter and continuously kicks dirt over the feast days and the appointments and the precepts and even the law of God has indeed become nothing more than an abomination. And it was for this very reason that God brought the first two temples to desolation.

Will there be a third temple built upon the earth? The Bible clearly says so, what say you?

Will sacrificial offerings be reinstated along with the law of God and the law of his temple during the 1000-year millennial reign of our Messiah? The Bible clearly says so, what say you?

Make no mistake about it, those who are left who have survived the battle against Israel during the 1000-year millennial reign of our Messiah will once again be making sacrifices for sin and bringing their gifts to the altar of Yehvoah at his Temple. And why? Because they obviously will need to relearn who their Messiah is and what he has done for them. They will need to be reminded of their sin year by year. They will need to be reminded of the fact that sin leads to death. And during this learning process that Yehovah God will bring them through... the hope is that many of these people during the 1000 year millennial reign of our Messiah that we will rule over with him will finally come to realize the importance of repentance and the blood of the lamb that leads to everlasting life.

Next week as we continue our study into the 1000-year millennial reign of our Messiah and the reinstatement of the temple and the temple sacrifices, we will examine what happens after the 1000 year millennial reign concerning the war of Gog and Magog and exactly who Gog and Magog actually are and what they represent according to Scripture and Scripture alone.

That and more next Wednesday evening at 7 PM Eastern standard Time as we continue our study into the book of not only Deuteronomy... but the very salvation of our people.

But for now, as we close the books for this week, I would like for us all to pray and reflect upon the information that we have been given here today because I tell you the truth, there are few who have the eyes to see

and ears to hear what we have just seen and what we have just heard.

As we have said so many different times before... there will only be a remnant of mankind that will make it through this oncoming tribulation that we are about to enter into. There will only be a remnant of mankind that will make it into the 1000-year millennial reign of our Messiah. And there will even be a fewer remnant of mankind that will make it through that 1000 years.

By the time the devil is loosed at the end of that 1000 years, and the wicked have joined together with the devil himself to come against what they think is an easy takeover of Jerusalem who will be living in peace at that time without any gates... there will only be left a third of mankind left to enter into the new heaven and the new earth.

I tell you the truth... A great sifting is indeed coming. And the very reason that Yehovah God is allowing the devil to sift his people is so that he can then take that sifted remnant and exalt that sifted remnant as his sons and daughters. At which time the devil and his minions will be completely burned up and destroyed and will be no more.

All of that and more, next week at 7 PM Eastern standard Time.

But until that time once again I will ask everyone within the sound of my voice to please take what you have heard here today to your own prayer closet. Bow your head and bend your knee, and face to hold the promise land of Jerusalem, and ask in the name of Yeshua Hamashiach if what you have heard here this evening be true or not.

Ask, seek, and knock on his door and on his door alone so that the proper door can be opened unto you. And if you will do that, and if you will stay the course to the end, you and I will surely walk through the gates of his soon coming kingdom together.
